Samsung Galaxy Watch 5

This 44 mm version is IP68 waterproof rated and can run for up to 50 hours on a single charge.

One minor annoyance is that there's no USB-C charger here (you get a micro-USB charger included instead), although the watch is compatible with wireless charging, so this might not be too inconvenient.

It features an always-on 1.2-inch display and an ultra-rugged design to keep up with your outdoor activities. Thanks to solar charging, the battery life of the Fenix 7S is excellent. You can expect around 14 days of regular use, or about 38 hours in GPS mode, perfect for downloading the latest maps and looking up routes, even tracking the scores of the matches.

Fitbit Versa 4



The Fitbit Versa 4 Fitness smartwatch is great for anyone looking to work out or stay in shape. It has a 1.4-inch display, 6 days of battery life, and is water resistant up to 50 meters. The Fitbit Versa 4 also comes with over 40 different exercise modes built in.

Compatible with Fitbit Pay, Google Wallet, and Maps, and built with Alexa, the Fitbit Versa is a versatile fitness tracker for Android (and iOS) users. Its advanced stats and 24/7 heart rate monitoring are great for helping you keep an eye on your fitness regimen and giving you the motivation to do it.

Ticwatch Pro 5 Android Smartwatch

Google Pixel Watch

Another useful feature on the Google Pixel is Emergency SOS, which can instantly alert a trusted contact if you feel unsafe outside. Great for fitness tracking, Google apps, and safety features, the Google Pixel Watch is an alternative worth considering. HUAWEI Watch GT 3



HUAWEI is doing great things in making affordable and accessible smartwatches. And the HUAWEI Watch GT3 smartwatch is a clear example of this. It has a 1.32-inch circular always-on display, compatible with both Android and iOS.

Naturally, to get the most out of this smartwatch, it should ideally be paired with a HUAWEI smartphone. While compatible with both Android and iOS, Fossil Gen 6 is more suitable for Android users as it allows you to answer calls and text messages directly with your watch, which is a feature not available to iOS users. It is water resistant at 3 ATM and supports fast charging (reaches 80% in 30 minutes). Standard battery life is about 24 hours. It has NFC for payments and works well with apps like Spotify for music on the go.
