In life, many times you encounter a situation where you struggle to know how to open the lid of a plastic or glass bottle that is screwed too tight despite your best efforts. TipsMake.com.com has compiled tips for opening plastic/glass bottle caps that are too tight, please refer to them.

Increase friction



For bottles, glass jars or plastic bottles with lids that are too tight, find a piece of rough cloth and place it under the palm of your hand, then wrap the bottle cap tightly to increase friction and use your strength to twist again. The bottle cap will open.

In addition to a piece of rough cloth, you can also use other available items such as a dry towel, silicon pad, elastic band, rubber gloves. to increase friction and open the bottle cap easily.

Tap on the lid

Use a spoon, the back of a knife or any hard object to tap lightly in a circular motion along the lid, then twist slightly, the lid will open immediately.

Use heat



Using a hair dryer and drying around the lid, pouring hot water on the lid of a bottle or jar, or turning the bottle or jar upside down and soaking the lid in a bowl of hot water. are effective ways to use high temperatures to open tightly screwed lids. Remember to use a cloth or pad and then screw on the lid to avoid burning your hands.

Hit the lid

For bottles, jars, or jars with lids that are stuck or screwed too tight, if you have tried tapping on the lid but it still doesn't work, hold the bottle upside down and smash the edge of the lid on the ground lined with a cloth. several times thick. If the 'click' is clogged, you can open this stubborn lid.

Use a hard object to open the lid

With metal bottle and jar lids, especially those used to store food, because the air pressure inside is much lower than the air pressure outside, it is very difficult to open. In this case, you can use a stainless steel spoon to gently pry the edge of the bottle cap to let air in, making the air pressure inside and outside equal. So opening the bottle cap will become easy.

Smash the bottom of bottles and jars

Simply turn the unscrewable bottle upside down and let it sit for a while. Finally, use your hand to gently tap the bottom of the bottle to reduce the air pressure in the bottle. When you hear a small sound, you can easily open the lid.
