

7 new features in Windows 10 Fall Creators Update

In the Build 2017 conference, Microsoft has released many updates as well as new features of Windows versions. In this article, TipsMake.com will help readers better understand 7 new features in Windows 10 Fall Creators Update version that will be released later this year.

We have a first look at the next major update of Windows 10 operating system in Seattle - where the annual meeting of Microsoft takes place this year.

A surprising topic is Microsoft's goal of letting the desktop operating system work with non-Microsoft devices like the iPhone and Android. However, this new visual design of Microsoft has also caused a big buzz.

Often users will probably wait until the operating system is released later this year, but technology enthusiasts can sign up for the Windows Insiders program to take a look at the preliminary version. No matter what type of user you are, you should quickly grasp the top new features that will be available in this version of Windows 10 Fall Creators Update.

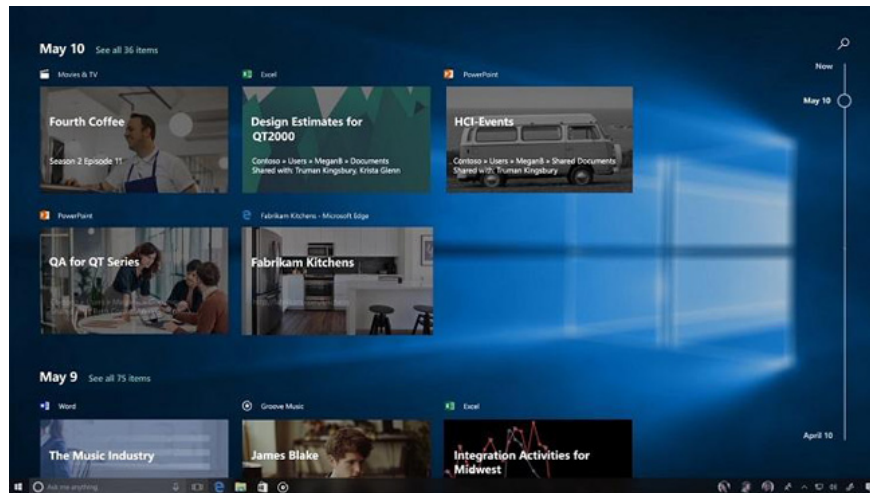

Fluent Design System

Refreshing this interface not only adds transparency to Windows but also adds features like lighting, depth, motion, materials, scale and typography. This not only makes the Windows interface more beautiful, but also helps users to use computers more efficiently. For example, depth effects, similar to Bokeh in photography, allow users to focus on ongoing work. Microsoft also supports new ways of interacting with computers such as touch and pen.

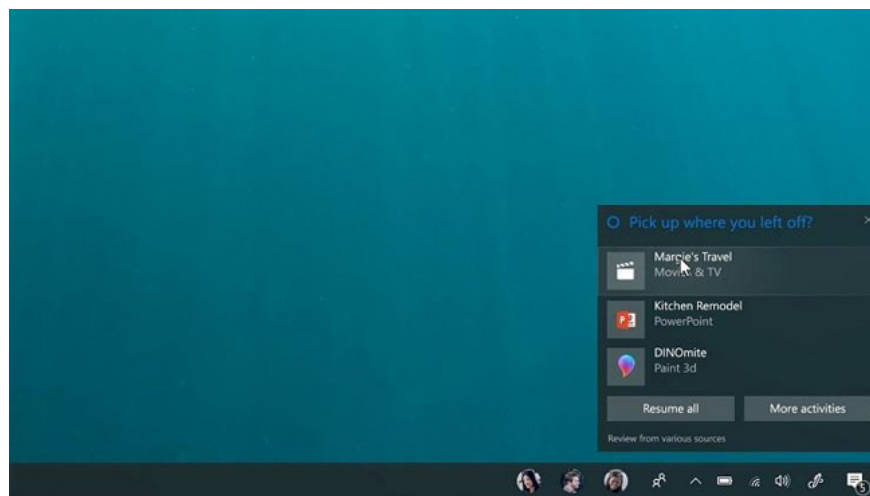
Timeline

This feature will appear on the screen showing recent and past activities, like some of the new features of Fall Creators, this feature will work on users' mobile devices. Android or iOS devices include applications that tell Microsoft Graph, then inform the computer about the activity that users want to return to, helping users recover their work both on the phone and the device. count.



Cloud-Powered Clipboard

Similar to Timeline, the new Clipboard allows users to work between Windows and non-Windows devices such as copying content on a computer and then pasting it into an Android or iOS smartphone. For example, the Swiftkey keyboard and Word Flow are Graph-aware from Microsoft, so if you enter text on your computer, you just need to paste it where you enter the text on your phone. The Office app will also have a smart Clipboard table, can even display previously copied images.

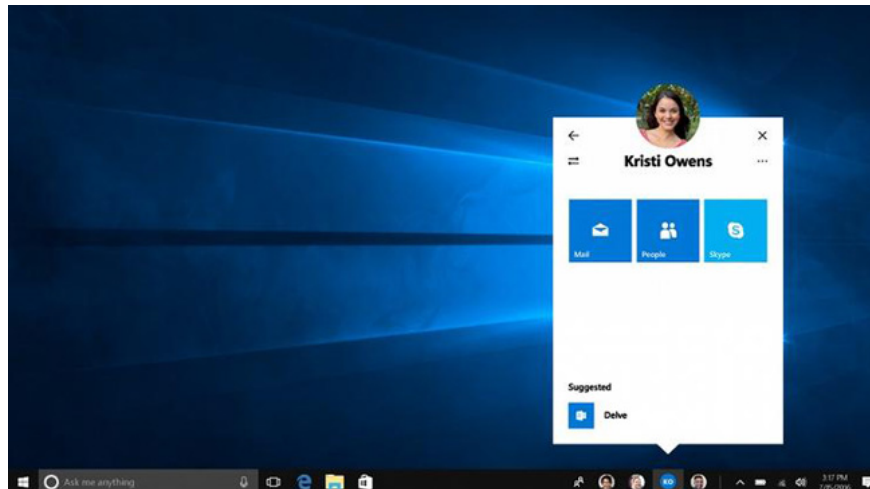


Pick Up Where You Left Off

The name tells everything. However, note that this is cross platform and uses Cortana virtual assistant. For example, if you are working with a Word document on an iPhone or Android or a web browser, Cortana may pop up a message asking you to confirm your work on the computer and vice versa. This feature also works with applications and websites. Microsoft even added the top-level icon in the Settings app to help users get this mobile integration activity.

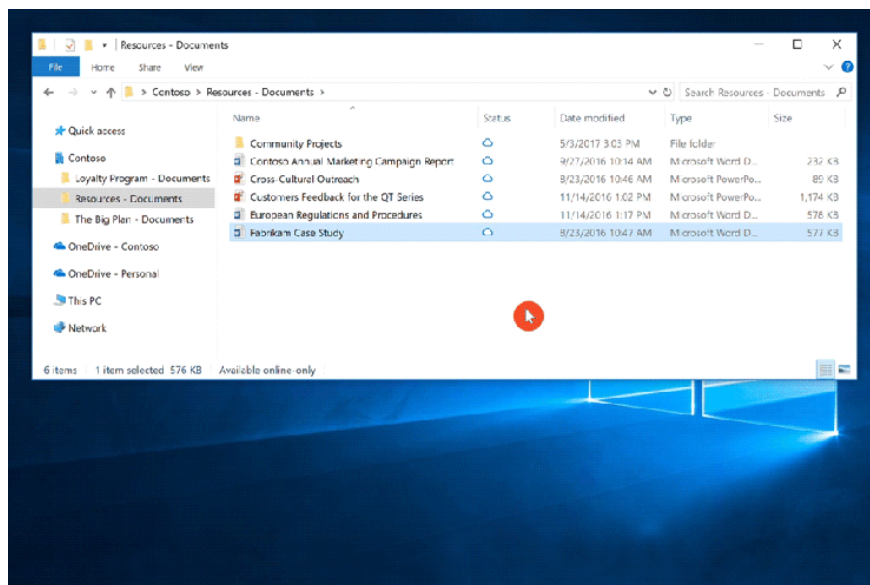
My people

This feature was first announced for the original Creators Update last summer, but that's not the final version. The final update will be released with Fall Creators Update, allowing users to pin icons to favorite contacts for easy sharing and communication across multiple channels and applications.



OneDrive Files on Demand

This feature addresses one of the controversial topics among Microsoft observers. In earlier versions of Microsoft, OneDrive presented things called placeholders in File Explorer, for each file stored in OneDrive. In the most recent versions, users must select the correct folders to synchronize. With Fall Creators Update, Microsoft has launched more powerful, integrated waysholders, which means users can access files on OneDrive without downloading them like previous versions.



OneDrive on Demand files will display all files in File Explorer, but they will be marked with status icons indicating where they are. Therefore, the file that is only in the logical cloud will display the cloud icon, while the synced file will show a green tick. This feature is similar to some online backup services but is further integrated into the system.

Story Remix

This is not really a built-in Windows feature, but a new application that shows some of the features of Fall Creators Update. Story Remix can create a smart video program using Microsoft Graph. This application allows users to perform actions such as changing videos to one of the contacts or adding 3D objects from Remix3D.com. Story Remix also allows users to write on top of the video, the written text can follow an object in the movie.
