How to shut down your computer using the keyboard for various versions of Windows.

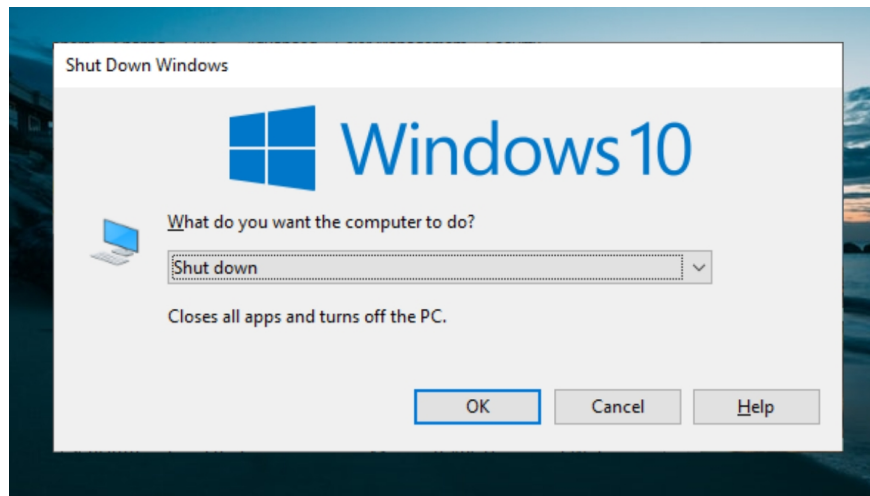
Step 1: First, you need to press the Windows + D key combination to return to your computer's desktop screen. Note that you won't need to do this step if your laptop is already on the home screen.

How to shut down your computer using the keyboard in Windows 11.

How to shut down your computer using the keyboard in Windows 10 and Windows 8.

How to shut down your computer using the Windows 7 keyboard.

How to shut down your computer using the keyboard while still listening to music.

1. Method 1: Put the device into Sleep mode.

Step 1: On the Taskbar, go to Start and click the power button icon.

1. Method 2: Close the screen while the computer is still running.

Step 1: Select Start from the Taskbar and click on Control Panel.

Step 2: Next, click on Hardware and Sound and then select Power Options.

Step 3: Click on "Choose what closing the lid does" or "Choose what the power buttons do" on the left side of the screen.

Step 4: In the "When I Close the lid" section, change "Sleep" to "Do nothing" for both "Plugged in" and "On battery". Then, click "Save changes" to save the changes.
