1. Kyocera Card Keitai KY-01L



The basic phone, exclusively distributed by Japanese carrier DoCoMo, is aimed at customers who prefer minimalism. It is only sold in Japan and is described as giving owners freedom, freeing the owner from tying up with smartphone apps. DoCoMo is currently selling this Kyocera Card Keitai KY-01L for about 295 USD (equivalent to 6.8 million VND).

2. Sony Xperia SO-04E Hatsune Miku Limited Edition



Hatsune Miku is a virtual singer in Japan, a vocal synthesis software, also known as Vocaloid, developed by Crypton Future Media. However, this virtual pop star still has a large fan base. In response to fan requests, in 2012, Sony launched a Hatsune Miku-themed smartphone. A total of only 39,000 Sony Xperia SO-04E Hatsune Miku Limited Edition were produced.

3. Sharp SH-M02-EVA20



The Sharp SH-M02-EVA20 is targeted at fans of the manga and anime series Neon Genesis Evangelion. Launched 5 years ago, on the occasion of the 20th anniversary of the Neon Genesis Evangelion series, Sharp SH-M02-EVA20 is now outdated in terms of specifications. However, it is still worth collecting with otaku.

4. Samsung Galaxy A80 Blackpink edition



If Japan has manga or anime-based smartphones, Korea has many special smartphones aimed at K-pop fans. The Samsung Galaxy A80 Blackpink edition is a prime example of this trend. Comes with Galaxy A80 Blackpink also has a set of black pink accessories including Galaxy Watch and Galaxy Buds. Exclusive content from Blackpink is also included in the Galaxy A80. Because it was recently launched, the Samsung Galaxy A80 Blackpink edition has both value and use.

Recently, Samsung has continued to launch the Galaxy S20 Plus BTS Edition.

5. Pyongyang 2425



Pyongyang 2425 is unique in that its product competes directly with the Korean iPhone. This smartphone has the same design as the iPhone, running a special software version developed by North Korea. And of course, it is only sold in North Korea, only connected to North Korea's Mirae mobile network, cannot connect to mobile networks as well as WiFi abroad.

6. Huawei Enjoy 7 Plus KFC Edition



In 2017, to celebrate the 30th anniversary of entering the Chinese market, KFC cooperated with Huawei to produce Huawei Enjoy 7 Plus KFC Edition smartphone. Only 5,000 units have been made available, so it is difficult to buy one at this time. This smartphone has the legendary Colonel logo on the back of the device and comes pre-installed with KFC application.

7. Infinite Red Vivo V7 Plus Manish Malhotra



The smartphone is a collaboration between Vivo and Indian designer Manish Malhotra. Notorious for being a special edition, the Infinite Red Vivo V7 Plus Manish Malhotra has nothing but red paint and some yellow accents.
