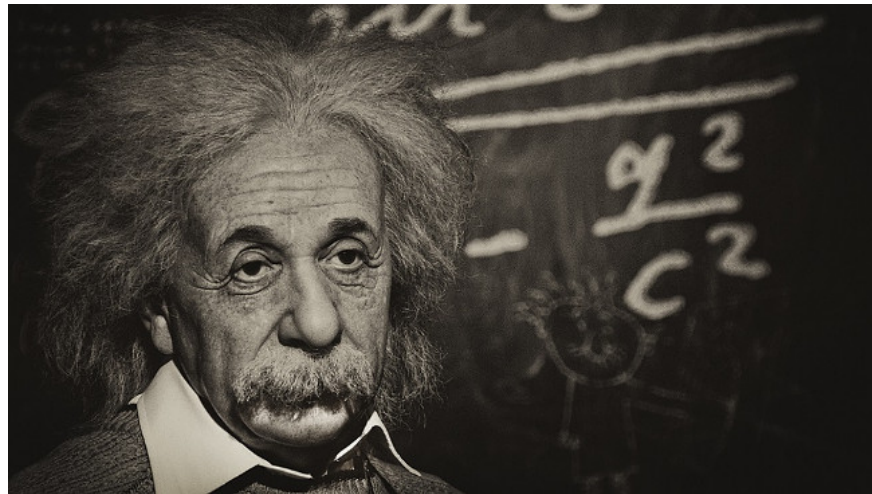


7 valuable life lessons from Albert Einstein

"It's not that I'm smart, it's just that I understand the problem longer than everyone else."

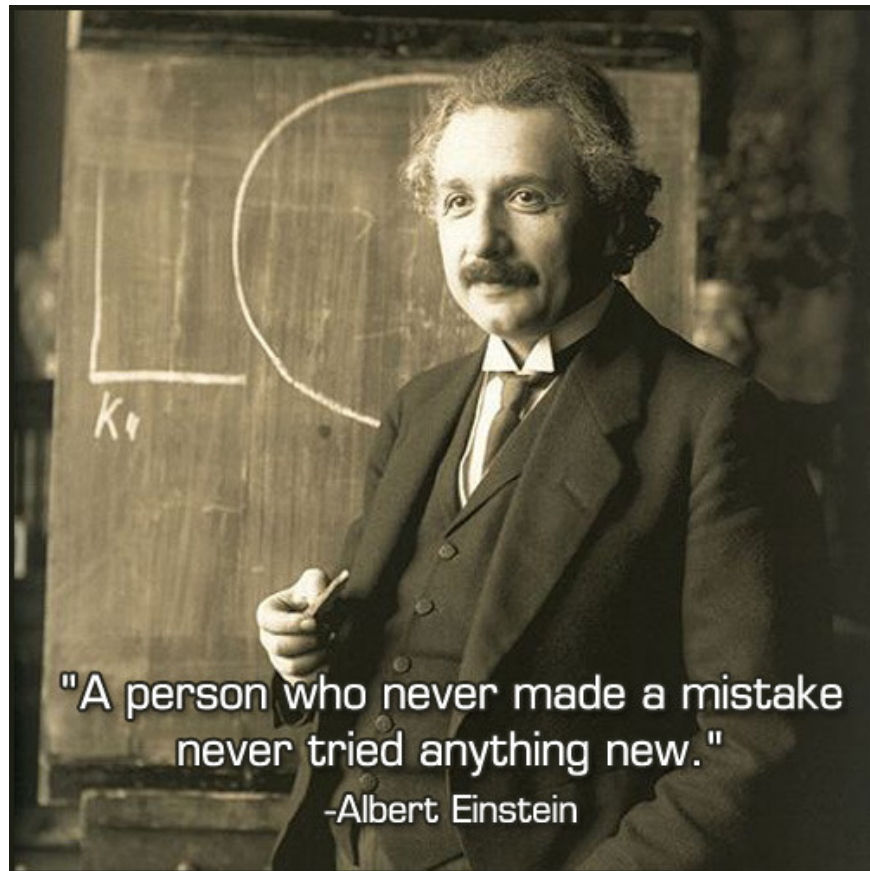

3. Pham is wrong

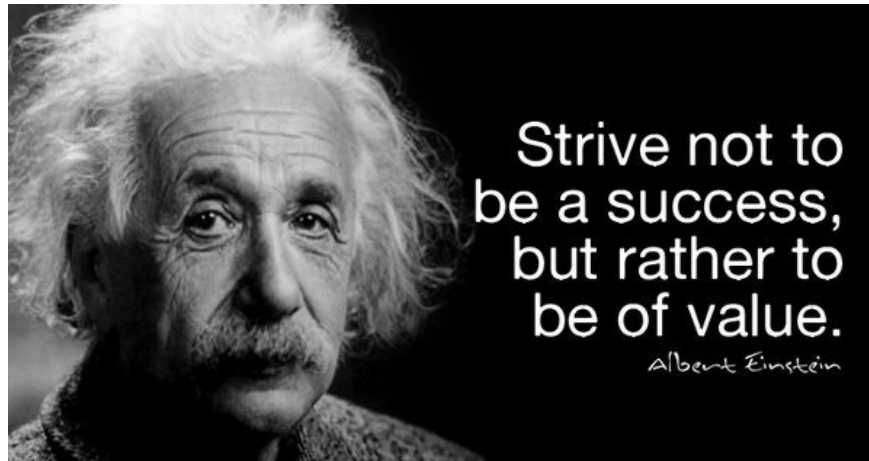


"A person who never makes a mistake is someone who never tries to do something new."

4. Create value

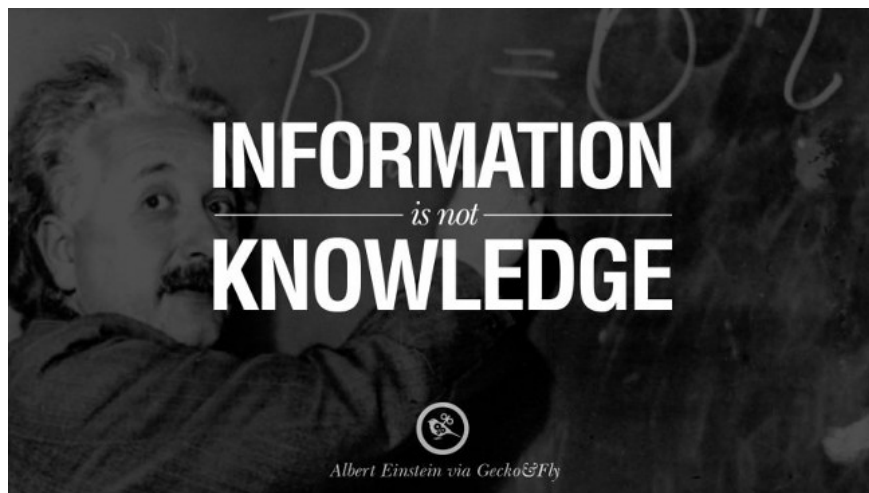


"Instead of trying to be successful, create value."
