1. Keep It Short

There is a saying that beauty resides in brevity. With brevity, you convey something, but much of it you keep in the air, and that elevates the level of interest. The same goes for video editing. 2. Learn The Shortcuts

3. Add Music Or SFX

If you provide it externally, it attains a dimension to the overall video. Add sounds that aptly fit your visuals.

4. Cover It Up In Doubt

Suppose you are editing an interview where the personality tells some story. If you think that the story seems to drag, it's best that you keep it interesting by adding some B-rolls or A+B rolls and see the change. Make sure that you keep every part or section interesting, but at the same time, you must also ensure the grip is strong enough. An interesting example can be given here:

Mr x: If you are talking about the specifics of this sedan, we have made it comfortable. Styling...um...you know we are working on this.

Simply cut this "um" because it becomes repetitive. That's how you do it.

5. Spacing It Out For Some Dramatic Effect

While you are editing some scenes with increasing pace, you can call it dramatic, don't rely too much on the cuts. This unnecessarily creates some disturbance and, in a way, distracts the entire flow of the work.

Instead, you add a breather before an impactful statement. This holds or filters the intensity levels rather than holding things tight. You keep that breather alive before you prepare for something highly dramatic. This is one adjustment that makes a huge difference.

6. Stabilize It

If your video contains some poor-quality audio, coupled with some shaky footage, this will definitely make things much more difficult for you. There are different plugins and tools that help you stabilize your footage better.

This helps create good video editing. There are different areas where you need some merciful cuts. You might use some stabilizer like that Adobe offers. They are highly effective in catering to your needs.

7. Learn To Use Colors

You must learn how to use colors intelligently. Different scenes and different modes require some different coloring. You just simply add color to some scenes. Suppose there is an intense scene; you can add a mixture of black and pink to keep the drama of the scene. This is a highly interesting subject and needs a lot of learning.
