

7 'yellow' notes for those who haven't upgraded to iOS 11.3

iOS 11.3 was officially launched by Apple last week for iPhone and iPad users who are eligible for upgrades. If you are planning to update, take note of the following to avoid becoming a white mouse.

However, for some reason, many users are still not interested in updating to this version. If you are also hesitant about whether to upgrade to iOS 11.3 and if you want to update, you should consider what to avoid to become "white mouse"? Please follow the article below.

1. Take time to learn more about iOS 11.3

Before deciding whether to upgrade iOS 11.3 or not, take a moment to learn about the most prominent new features in iOS 11.3. This is the latest iOS version to continue to fix outstanding bugs on iOS 11, while bringing many Animoji for iPhone X users and most notably allowing to disable the feature to slow down the machine when the old battery used to cause much controversy. Interestingly, after updating iOS 11.3, you will be able to monitor battery health in detail to know when to change the battery.



2. Exploring information from application developers

To support in the work as well as the learning process, entertainment, daily entertainment, each of us is equipped for iPhone, iPad one or more important applications. Meanwhile, new iOS upgrades are likely to cause software conflicts with the application. Therefore, before updating iOS 11.3, you should thoroughly understand the information recommended by the application developers through the App Store.

3. Search for feedback from other users

iOS 11.3 has been released for several days and officially allows users to download the experience. Certainly a lot of iFan have conducted this update for their iPhone and iPad. So this is a good time for you to poll, feedback from users who have updated before you. You can refer to that information on technology sites such as Network Administration, or on YouTube channels specializing in iPhone, iPad, and video updates very quickly and there are many Facebook groups on iOS.



4. Select iOS 11.3 download method

Similar to previous versions, Apple has always allowed users to choose multiple methods to download iOS updates on their iPhone, iPad or iPod. Of course, iOS 11.3 is no exception, you can update via OTA protocol but keep in mind to keep the device at least 50% battery. Or choose to update via iTunes and need to prepare a full connection cable.

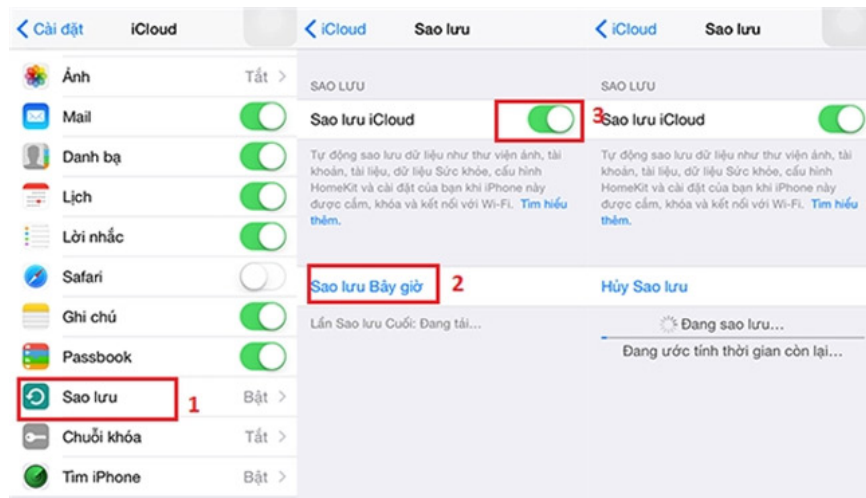
5. Prepare full login information to the account

This note will help you avoid unnecessary trouble after the upgrade ends. Because, as you know the completion of the download process and installing iOS 11.3, your iPhone / iPad will require you to log back into the Apple ID and iCloud accounts in parallel with entering the password. Therefore, please find these accounts and passwords before intending to update iOS 11.3 so that the upgrade is not interrupted.



6. Don't forget to back up information before updating

Backing up data is something we often recommend to users before performing an operating system upgrade, because no one can confirm that 100% of the process will be "smooth" and without risk. Therefore, make sure you back up your important personal information via iTunes or iCloud before deciding to upgrade to iOS 11.3 update.



7. Feel free to experience because you can completely downgrade

In a short time, Apple will allow users after upgrading to iOS 11.3 to downgrade to iOS 11.2.6. So, this is your chance to enjoy the iOS 11.3 experience if you want and then downgrade if you feel unstable or find an error. However, you need to downgrade quickly if you are not satisfied with this version, because Apple usually locks the sign without notice.
