This app consumes battery because it requires background app optimization to be turned off. Therefore, it is best to use it only in low light conditions.

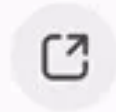
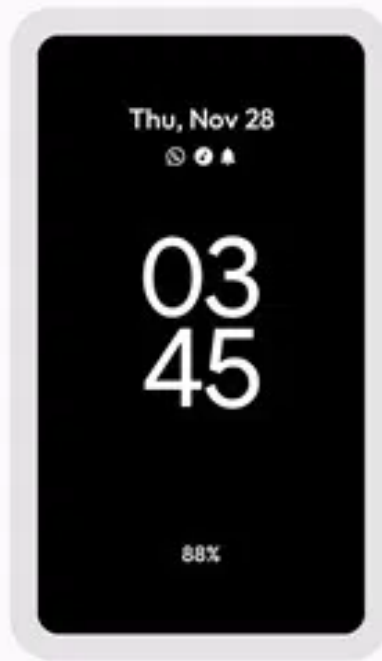
## **2. AOD Flow**


