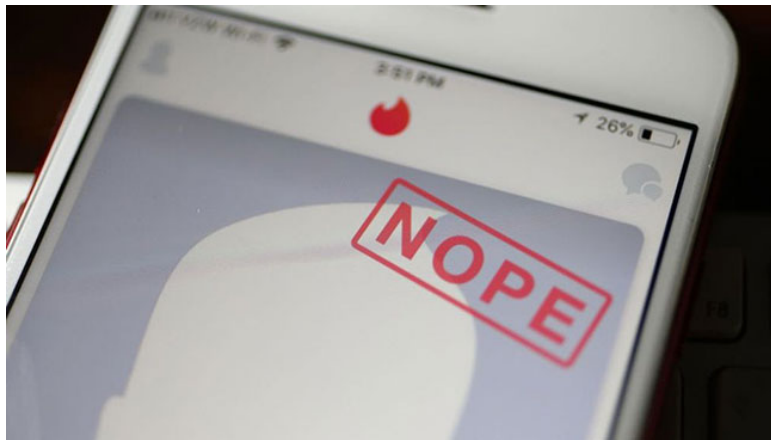

1. Believe in fake Tinder profile

Tinder can be a great place to find a romantic partner, but users also encounter fake profiles. Fake profiles are often used by bots and scammers on Tinder.

2. Sharing too much personal information on Tinder

Although Tinder no longer seems to be showing friends on Facebook, there are other profiles that can be linked to the dating app. For example, you can link your Instagram account and Spotify playlist to Tinder, for example.

However, if you are not careful about what you link, you may share too much personally identifiable information with strangers. Reverse image search, location tags, and other common tools can be used to identify you.

Although you should include some information about yourself, you should take care to protect your privacy on Tinder. Stop sharing your home address, company address, or other personal information with the paired people.

3. Choose the wrong profile picture on Tinder

Many users surf quickly on Tinder. They don't necessarily have to spend time looking at your photos and résumé unless your first photo is impressive. Therefore, you need to make sure that the first picture in your profile is the best one.

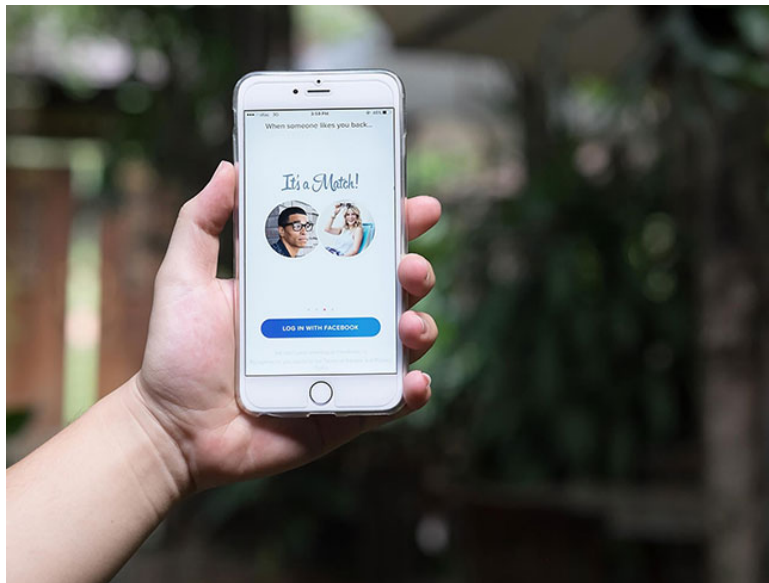
You should also avoid group photos. Group photos make it unclear who the profile really belongs to and make people want to see all of your photos.

Some other major profile picture errors you should avoid are:

1. The image contains a face obscured by sunglasses or a hat
2. Remote shot (makes it hard for viewers to see you clearly)
3. The photos don't have you in them, such as memes or pictures of animals
4. Images that you do not laugh

You can include these types of images elsewhere in your profile, but if you include them as the main image, you're less likely to attract the right subjects.

You should also make sure to use your real name on Tinder or at least a nickname. You don't want someone to suspect you if they find out you used a fake name on the app, right?

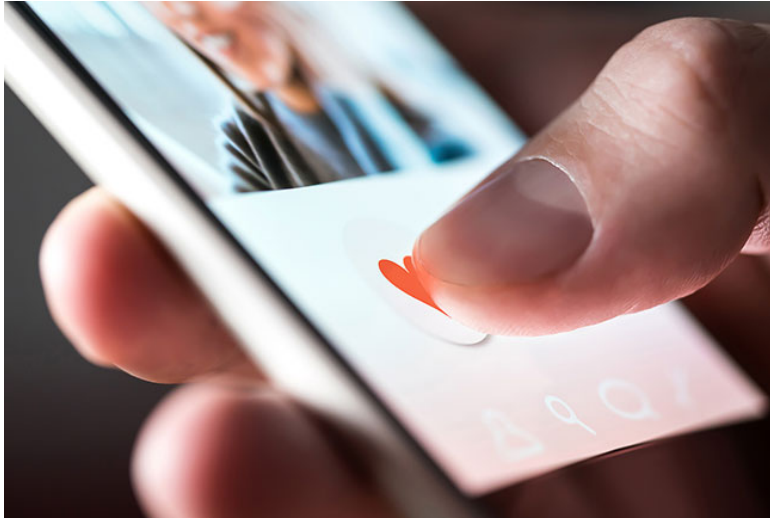
7. Do not check the actual age of the object on Tinder

Vebuu is limited to users 18 and older. Although the application tries to prevent underage users from accessing the service, this is not always possible.

Moreover, people can hide their age on Vebuu with Tinder Plus accounts. There are also users who do not disclose their actual age on the application.

When scheduling an appointment, you should make sure to check the audience's actual age on Tinder.

8. Swipe right too much or too little on Tinder

The way Tinder algorithm works is not entirely clear. Reports from Tinder users on Reddit claim that swiping right on too many profiles (to show you like someone) reduces the number of matching audiences. However, Tinder also recommends on the Swipe Life blog that you should not limit the likes to only 1% of the profile you see.

In fact, swiping right on every profile can clearly reduce the quality of matching objects that Tinder can provide. After all, the Tinder algorithm can't figure out your interests if you show nothing.
