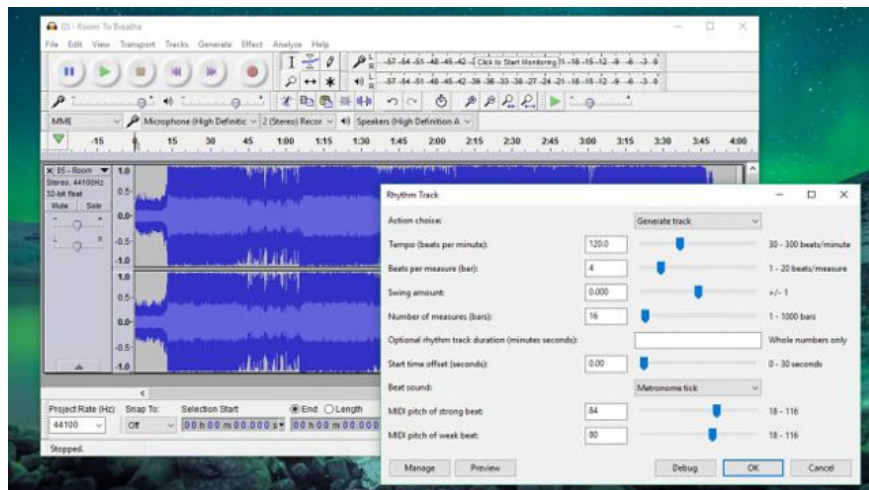

Flexible and powerful - the best free audio editor

Advantages:

Available for many desktop platforms, Audacity is the leading free music editor on this list. This is a powerful tool, which makes some paid products feel embarrassing and although the original interface is not very eye-catching, it is easy to use even for beginners.

Audacity is equipped with a set of built-in tools, allowing editing of pre-recorded files, receiving audio through the attached microphone, or even listening to music and podcasts. The software supports a wide range of audio formats for both audio input and output.

There is also a great option that third-party plug-ins make the software more flexible (one of Gsnap's favorite add-ons, for Drake's effects) and a tutorial Overall usage helps you to grasp the program neatly in the palm of your hand.

2. Ocenaudio

A powerful audio editing software, but easier to master than Audacity

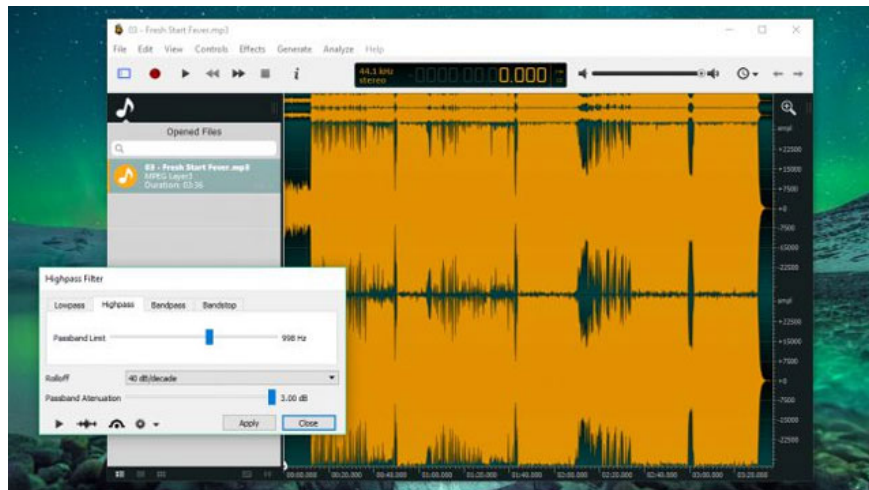
Advantages:

You can use Ocenaudio for files stored on your computer or even open online storage servers. The uncomplicated interface of this audio editing software also makes users quickly get used to the shortcuts.

Ocenaudio offers many good effects with additional features like plugins and even has the option to export audio files as ringtones for iPhone.

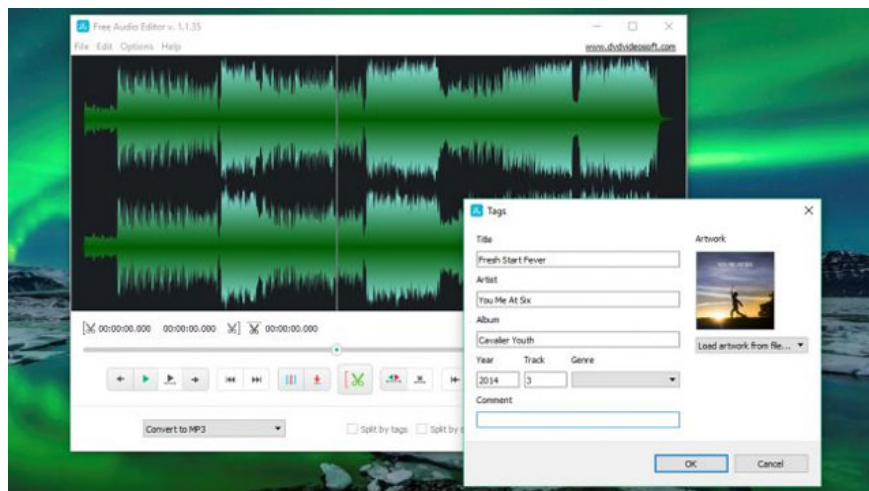
3. DVDVideoSoft Free Audio Editor

There are a number of programs called Free Audio Editor, which is understandable because developers want their software to rank well on Google but not useful, especially for users. Here we are referring to a software created by experts at DVDVideoSoft rather than FAEMedia's tool.

Unlike Audacity, this software will not create sound recordings or remove background noise because this is not its purpose. With Free Audio Editor, you can easily cut and convert audio files, even for those who have never used a previous audio editing program.

The interface of Free Audio Editor is simply not confusing for users. The most outstanding feature of this software is the simple cutting tool, but Free Audio Editor also includes an excellent metadata editor for music files (with covers) and a number of audio file output formats. to be able to store songs with different purposes.

4. mp3DirectCut

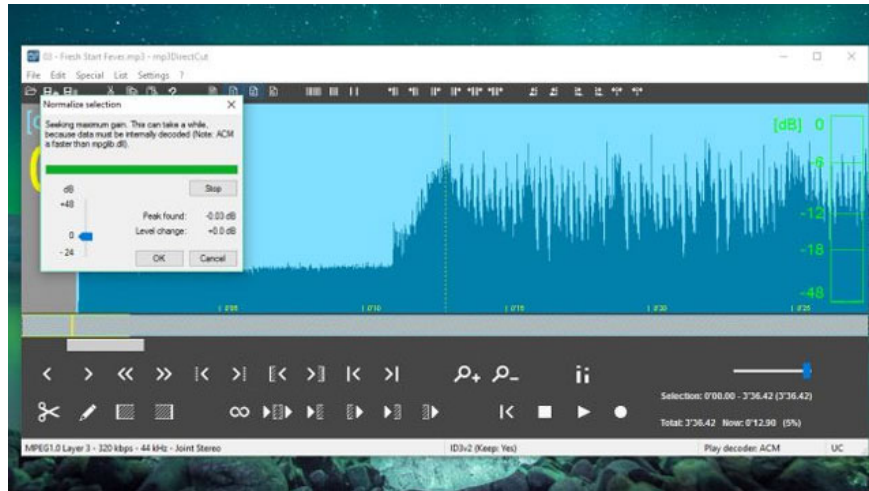
Advantages:

Defect:

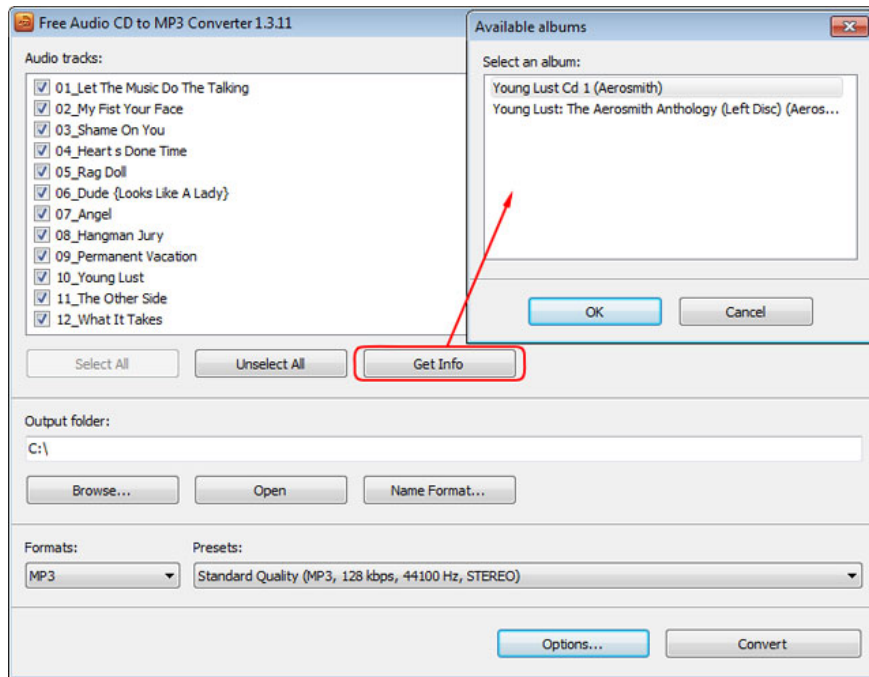
- Icons are easy to confuse

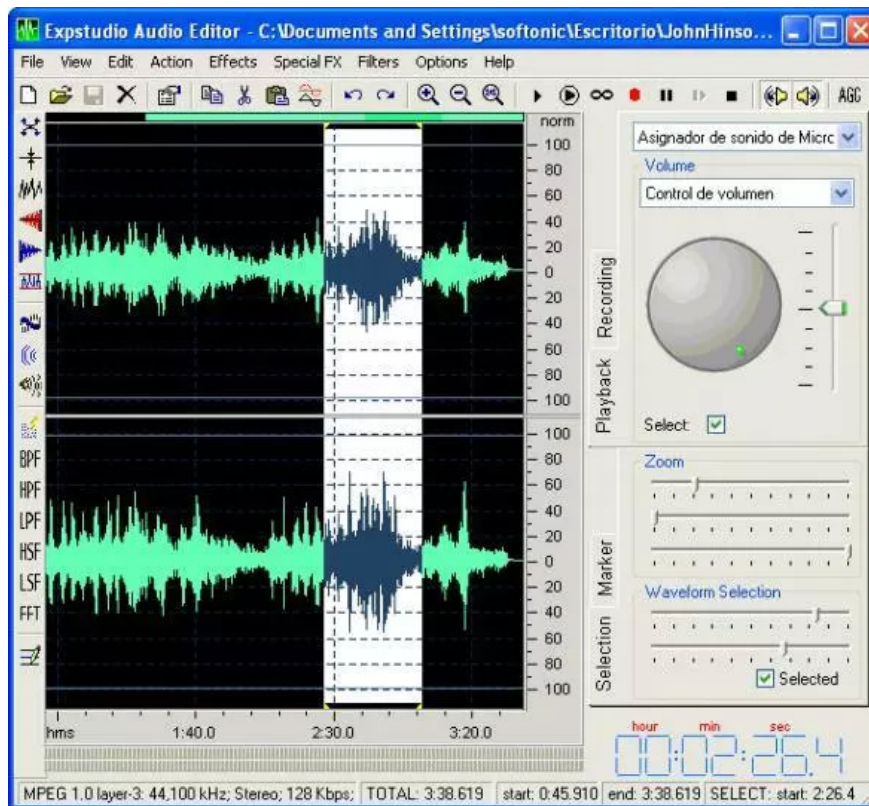
5. CD to MP3 Converter



This program helps you compress music files from CDs converted to MP3, WAV, OGG or WMA formats. The program automatically updates information from the CD and can store the song name based on the name on the CD. In addition, you can record audio from the microphone and switch to formats like MP3, WAV, OGG or WMA.

6. Expstudio Audio Editor Free



The program supports WAV PCM, WAV (ADPCM, GSM, DSP, A-LAW, U-LAW, ALF2), MP2, MP3 (MPEG Layer-3), VOX (Dialogic ADPCM), WMA (Windows Media Audio), RAW (PCM, A-LAW, U-LAW), CDA (Audio CD Tracks), OGG (Ogg Vorbis), G.721, G.723, G.726. This free tool also helps you edit audio files like editing a text file. With intuitive tools like collage, copy, delete, mix audio files, and a range of outstanding sound effects.

7. Free Video to MP3 Converter

Free Video to MP3 Converter splits audio files from video formats such as *.avi, *.mpg, *.mp4, *.wmv, *.asf, *.mov, *.qt, *.3gp, *.3g2 and *.flv and save in MP3 format. You can split the entire sound of the video or some part you like.

8. FreeRip

FreeRip is a free and simple application for recording tracks directly from a CD to a personal computer. You can burn music from CD to quality WAV with CD or you can compress in OGG, WMA, MP3 or Flac format. The program also converts audio files to WMA, WAV, MP3, OGG, Flac and vice versa.
