

# 8 indications that the computer is infected with spyware

## From the filial marks are visible

1. The most obvious sign of pyware affecting computers is some pop-up windows, included in web browsers (Internet Explorer, Opera, Firefox .), containing advertising content or a warning message "your computer has problems ." automatically pops up every time you boot into Windows or run a web browser.
2. Changes in browser settings are another sign of spyware. For example, even if you set up the [www.google.com](http://www.google.com) Web site as your homepage, the browser will display another page when it runs. Some websites that have Activex controls (especially pornographic sites, crack .) can change these settings without the consent of the computer user.
3. The third common sign of spyware is the unidentified appearance of strange toolbars on Internet Explorer. Normally, it is located directly under the Address bar of Internet Explorer and immediately visible. In some cases, strange toolbars are "smarter" to install and open themselves like a normal toolbar, without suggesting

suspicion.

4. The fourth sign that can be seen directly is the strange icons on the desktop, it can be a shortcut to porn sites, online casino casinos or some other program such as "free gifts." charge ".

### **Until abnormal signs**

5. Your computer suddenly has some minor problems, which may be a sign of spyware. You need to pay attention to the sudden increase in error messages if you have not previously installed any new software.

6. The status of the system often responds too slowly compared to normal, it may be because spyware runs underground. You try to check if there is any new program installed that consumes system resources? (See the Processes tab of Windows Task Manager). If not, think about active spyware on your computer.

7. Pay attention to the firewall, antivirus or anti-spyware programs installed on your computer. If they are not enabled automatically, check to see if they are disabled by spyware programs. The icon in the System Tray will help you monitor the status of the programs.

8. The increase of bill: phone bill or ADSL bill (depending on the type of Internet connection you use) increased dramatically, which is also one of the signs of spyware infection. If you use the full-service ADSL service, this method is not applicable.

### **Epilogue**

Computers infected with spyware often bring discomfort to users, even when not connected to the Internet. In my experience, every time I detect spyware, the best way to do it is to scan with Spybot - Search & Destroy (version 1.4, 4.8MB capacity) with Ad-Aware SE Professional (version 1.0. 6, 6.4MB capacity) because they are quite powerful, stable, free and updated regularly.
