1. Kadapul flowers

This is a 'priceless' flower because there are no gardeners in the world who can grow this flower. This flower gives off a very pleasant scent, giving a sense of relaxation to the spectator.

2. Juliet roses

To be able to own a bunch of pink Juliet, one would have to spend an amount of more than \$ 15 million (~ 330 billion). This expensive rose is because the breeder David Austin spent 15 years of research at a cost of up to £ 3 million (~ 84.9 billion) to develop it. Therefore, Juliet roses are also known as 'Rose of 3 million pounds' or 'million dollar roses'.





David Austin first introduced Juliet pink to the public in 2006. From its launch, the structure is elaborate and flawless, elegant and luxurious colors, the passionate aroma of the Juliet rose has overwhelmed. The beauty of all rose species has appeared before. To help this flower reach more flower lovers, David has improved and made it more popular with cheaper prices.

3. Nongke Shenzhen orchid





Shenzhen Lan is very rare because it is completely absent in nature but is 100% bred in the test fee. Researchers at Nongke, Shenzhen (China) have taken up to eight years of observation and nurturing to produce a Nongke orchid. In it, there are 4-5 years waiting for them to bloom. Only the most beautiful flowering plants are marketed and their prices are very expensive, up to \$ 200,000 a tree.

4. Gold of Kinabalu Orchid Flower





This flower is dubbed the Golden of Kinabalu Orchid because it is only available in Kanabalu National Park located in Malaysia. Gold of Kinabalu Orchid flowers are rare, newly hatched once every 15 years and between April and May. The price of one of the world's rarest flowers is up to 6,000 USD / tree (~ 136 million VND).

5. Saffron flower



Saffron is a native species of Southwest Asia, unable to grow in its natural environment but always needs human intervention. Each saffron flower is priced from 1,200 - 1,500 USD / 1 cotton (~ 27.3 - 34.2 million VND). In particular, saffron flower pistil is also a special and most expensive spice in the world with the price up to 5,000USD for 500gram.

6. 17th-century Tulips



Unlike other popular tulips, 17th-century Tulip flowers are 'pure' flowers that are usually yellow or milk yellow, interspersed with soft red rays on each petal. This very unique flower is very rare, its price is about \$ 5,700 / bundle (~ 129.9 million VND).

7. United Gloriosa



Gloriosa flowers are also known as 'Lily fire', the wings of the flowers bend with the stigmata near the yellow and the wing tips are bright red. This flower only grows naturally in South Africa and Asia so it is very rare. And despite being poisonous in all parts, Gloriosa flowers are sold at quite expensive prices of about 6-10 USD / branch (~ 140,000 - 230,000 VND).

8. Orchid flowers



Linh lan or lan lan is a kind of forest flower that only grows in temperate, cool climate. Orchid flowers are pure white, shaped like a small bell and give off a very pleasant scent. However, the plastic of this elegant beauty flower contains toxins. Each year, flowers are harvested only once, each time only lasts about a week so its price is very expensive, about 143 USD / bundle (~ 3.2 million VND).
