

8 smart anti-theft ways that you can homemade at home

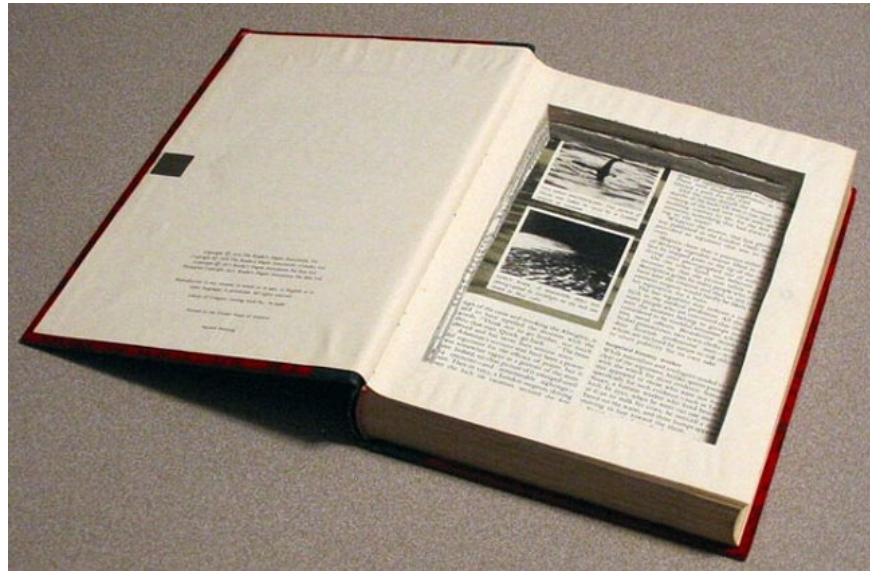
Do you know where the most hidden hideaway in the house challenges every thief? Let us refer to 8 ways to prevent theft smart that you can homemade at home!

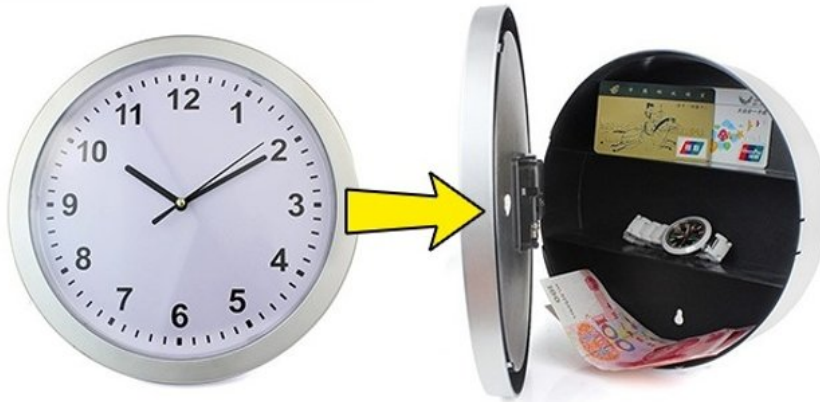
7. Fake stone

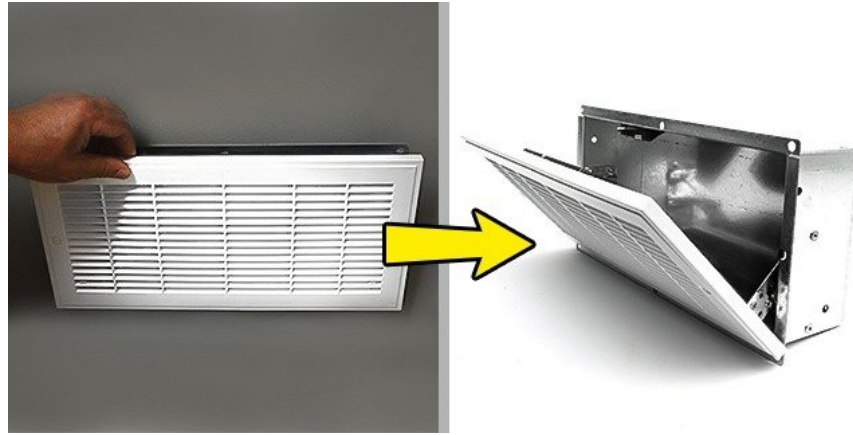
6. Wall clock

You must have seen this tip in many modern detective movies. Thanks to the movie, this tip became so popular that many companies are starting to make fake vents for sale.

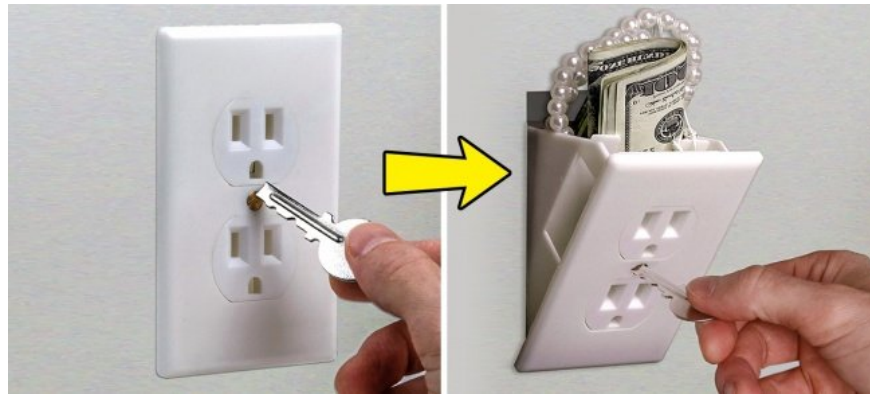
4. Thermometer

3. Safety recess

2. Money hiding place at the door stop





Have you ever thought of hiding money or valuables at the main door? If not, try it. You just need to cut a hole in the upper wall of the wooden door. After that, put an empty metal tube in this hole and put the money or valuables into it. When you want to remove it, you just need to use a normal magnet.
