

# 8 useful 'super' tools for Freelancer

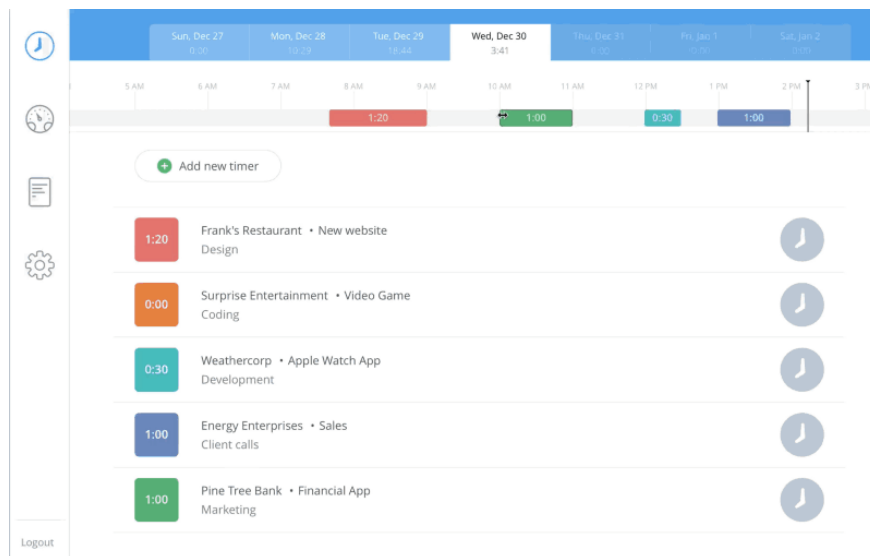
If you are having difficulty creating Proposal, managing time, finding customers ... then these 8 tools are exactly what you need.

**Benefits:** Track your time for work (and rest).



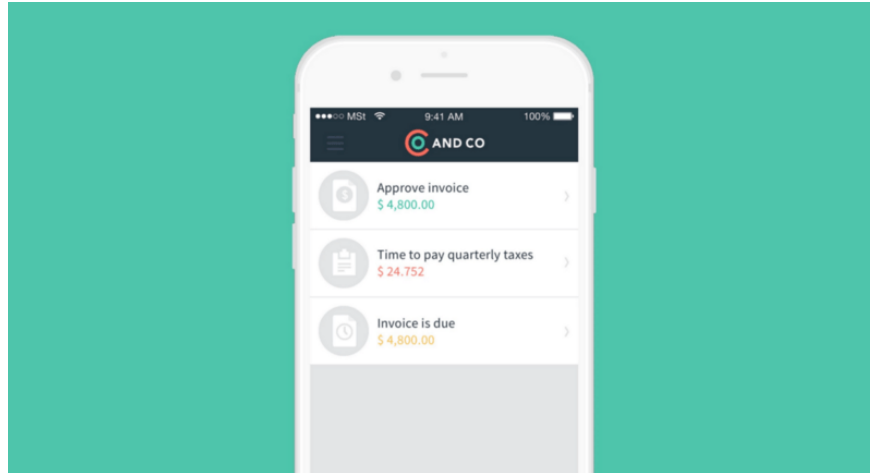
Time tracking is a very important - but often very bland - task that any Freelancer must do to control the progress of the project they are working on.

**Benefits:** Automate your business transactions.

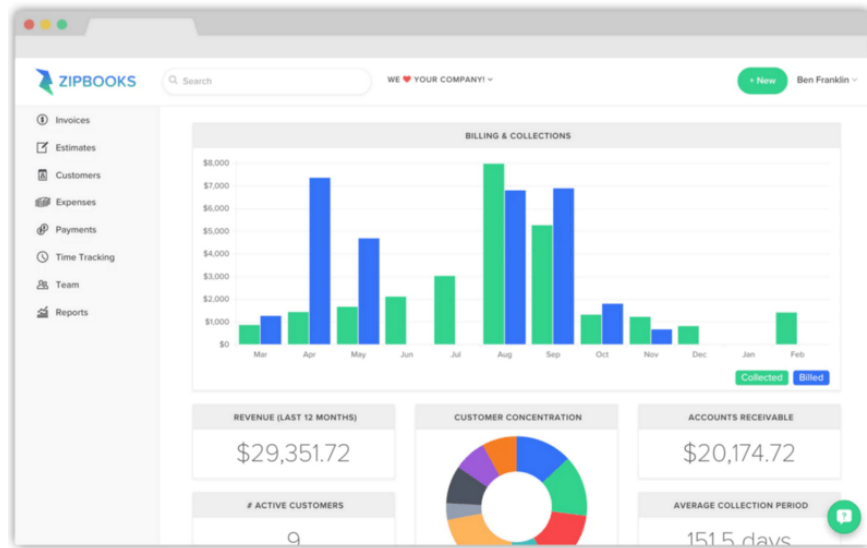

**Benefits:** Simple, intuitive accounting solution.



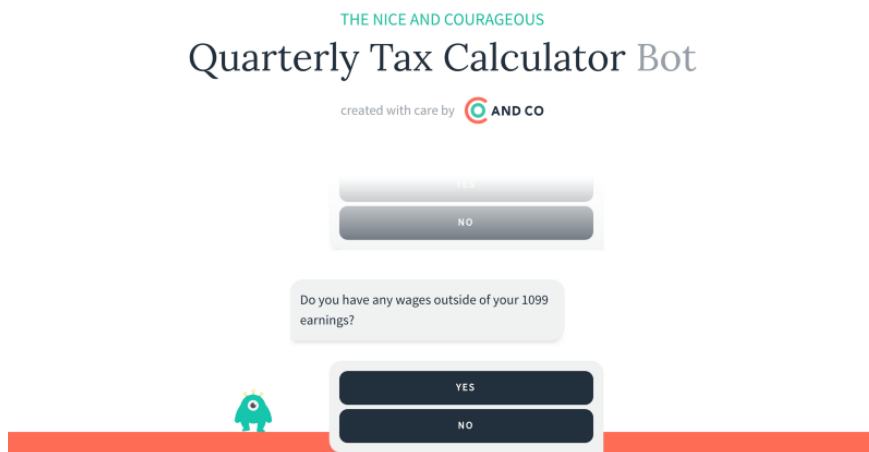
ZipBooks will make accounting operations easier for freelancers. Its goal is to simplify the process of making books and withdrawing cash from banks faster when needed.

**Benefits:** Calculate monthly tax payable.

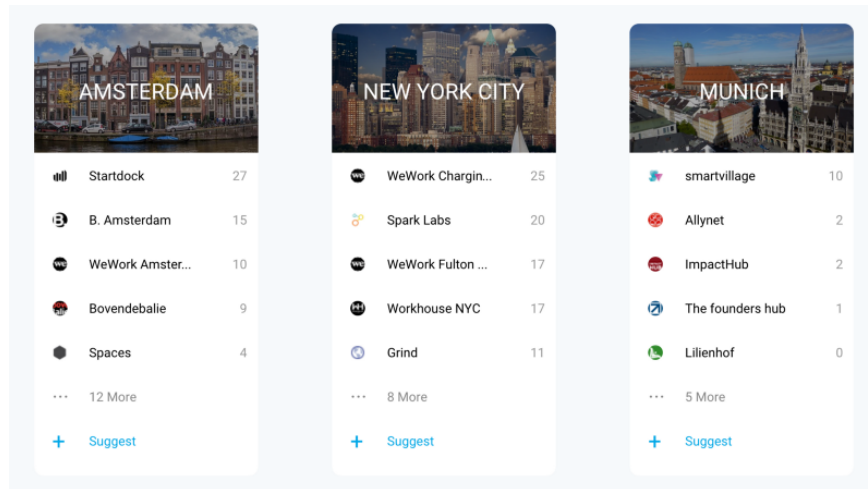


One of the most unpleasant things for a relatively good Freelancer is that every month you have to pay taxes. Although not too complicated, sometimes you lose control of this expense.

**Benefits:** Discover the most favorite Co-working workspaces.

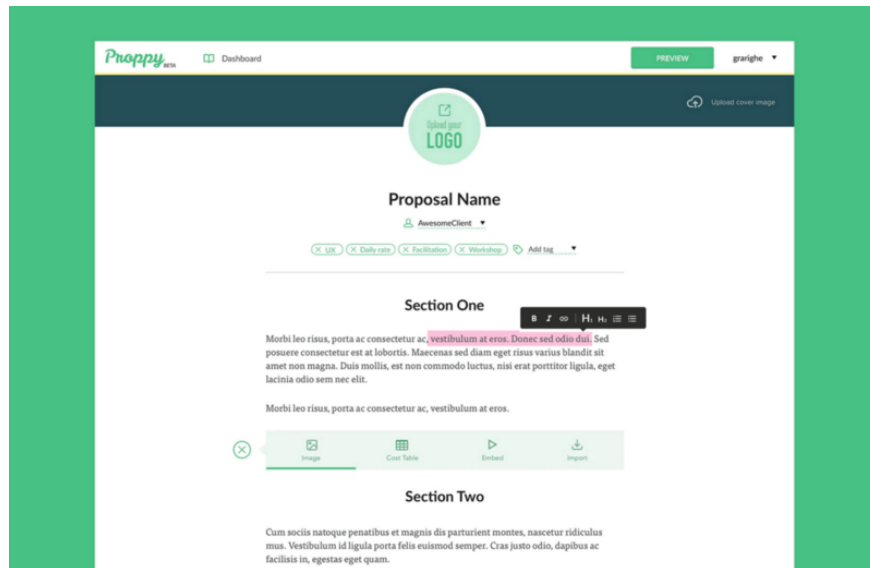

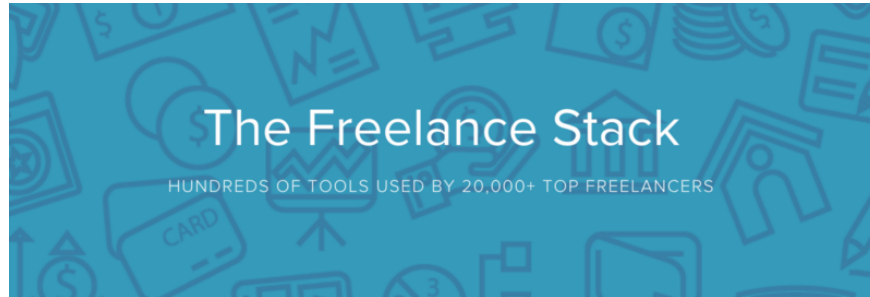
