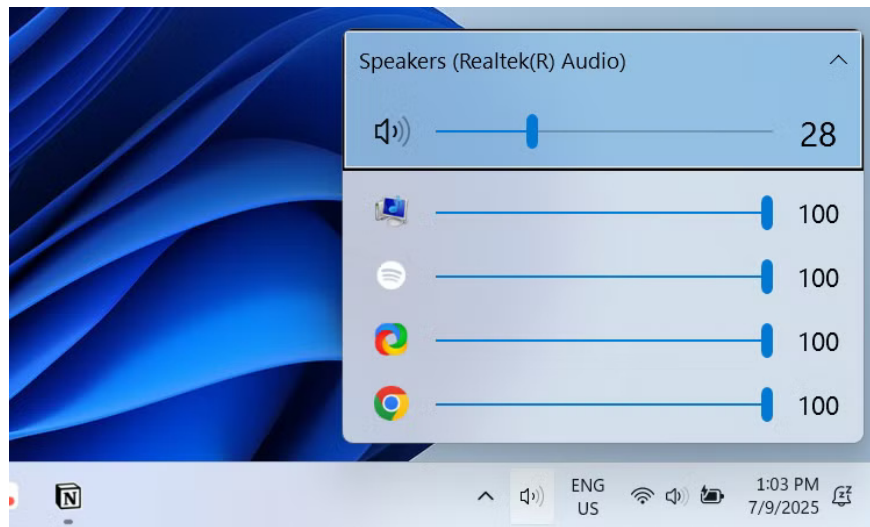


# 9 Apps That Instantly Fix Everything You Hate About Windows 11

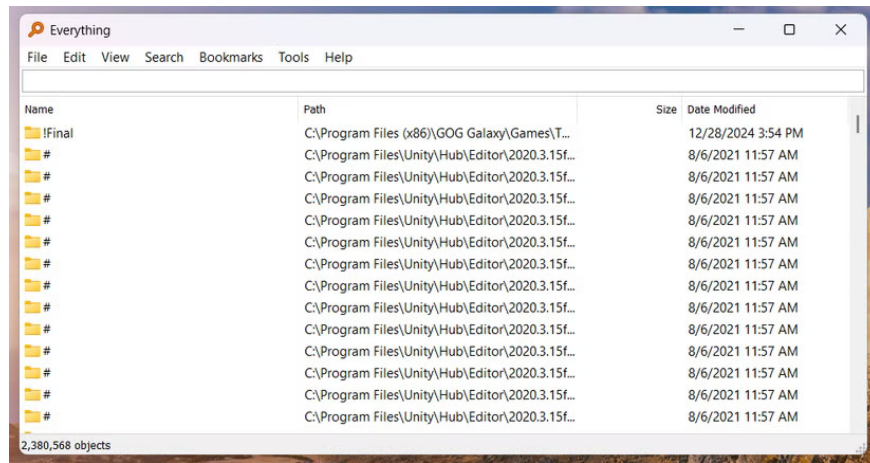

## 9. EarTrumpet



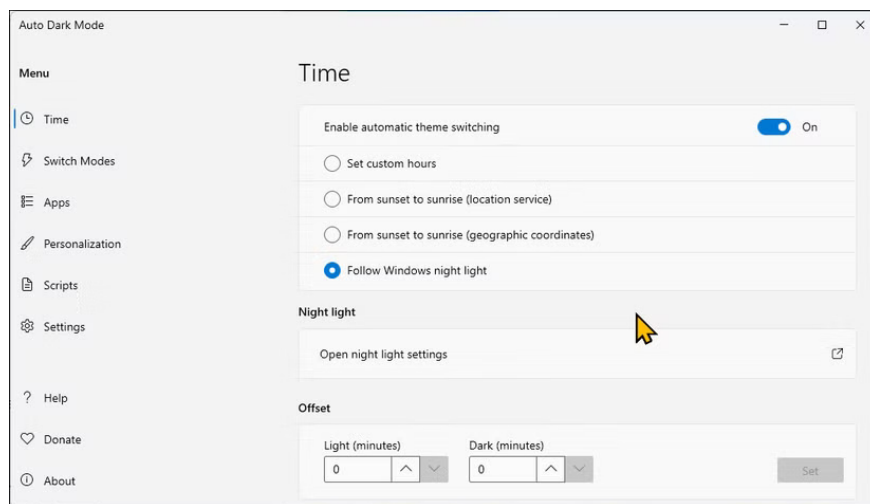

## 8. Everything



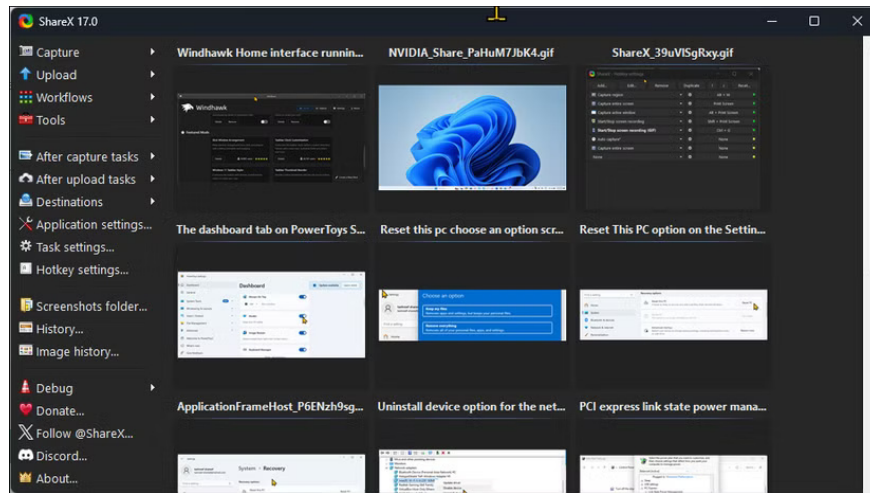

To fix this, install Everything, a blazing-fast file and folder search utility that offers a significant speed boost over the stock Windows Search.

## 7. Auto Dark Mode



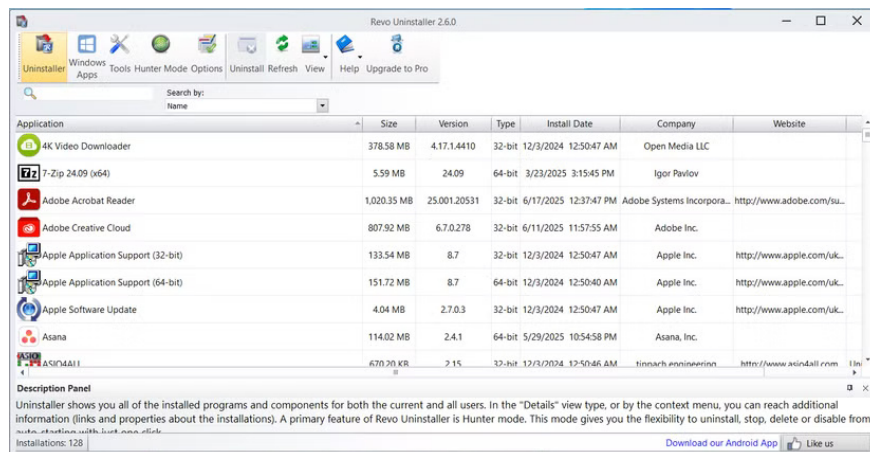

Since Windows doesn't have an automatic interface switching feature, Auto Dark Mode is the perfect app to fix this.

## 6. ShareX



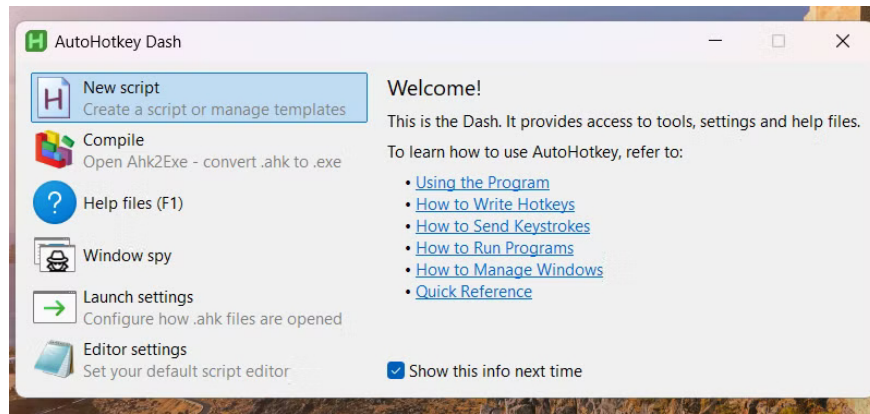
ShareX is an advanced screen capture, recording and sharing tool for Windows. As someone who regularly takes screenshots and records screen videos, ShareX is much more interesting than the built-in Snipping Tool.

## 5. Revo Uninstaller



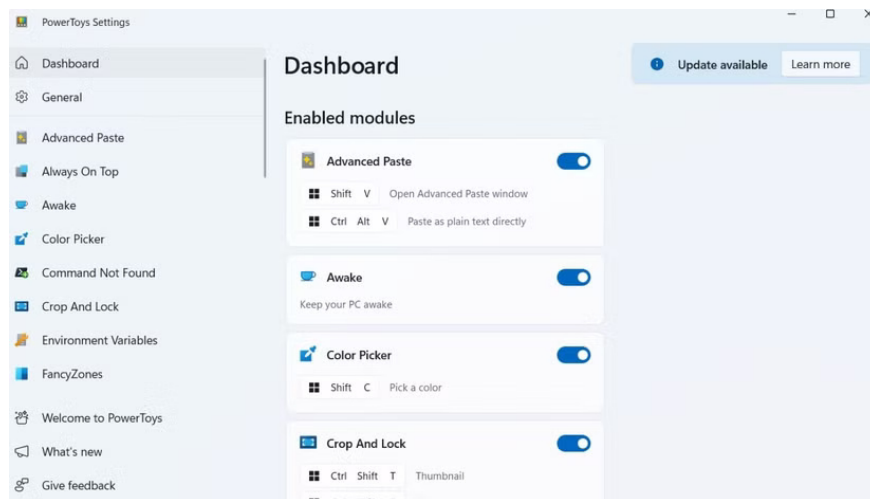
When you uninstall a program, it can sometimes leave behind leftovers, such as files, folders, and registry entries. These unwanted items can waste valuable disk space, slow down your system, cause errors, and even create security/privacy vulnerabilities. Revo Uninstaller not only removes unwanted programs, but also scans and cleans up any leftovers.

## 4. AutoHotkey



You can use AutoHotkey to get around Windows' limitations on user-created shortcuts and automation. AutoHotkey allows you to create many useful scripts, such as opening all your productivity apps at once, automatically correcting common spelling errors, or inserting an email signature.

### 3. PowerToys



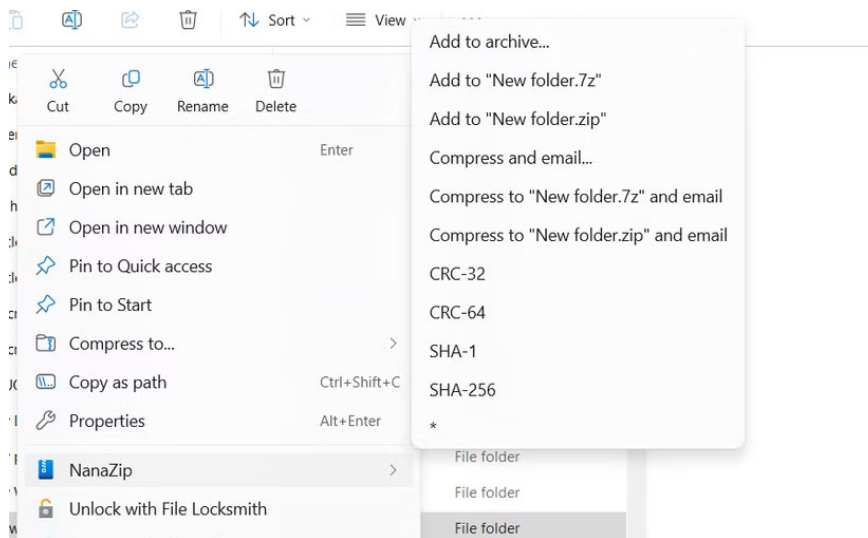
PowerToys offers a number of utilities to enhance your productivity and customize Windows. For example, Windows snaps are pretty basic, but PowerToys takes it to the next level with FancyZones. This feature lets you create custom window layouts that go beyond what a simple snap can do.

### 2. Rainmeter



A static desktop is uninteresting, which is why many people use Rainmeter to fill it with widgets, skins, and custom displays. With thousands of options, it ensures your desktop never looks boring. Beyond aesthetics, Rainmeter's tools also help boost productivity with system monitors and quick access shortcuts to apps, files, and folders.

## 1. NanaZip



Windows has a built-in file compression feature, but it is limited, outdated, and slow in some cases. That's why it's a good idea to replace it with NanaZip, a modern file archiver that integrates seamlessly with the context menu. It offers better performance and supports more archive formats, and it doesn't display ads or require registration (it's free and open source).
