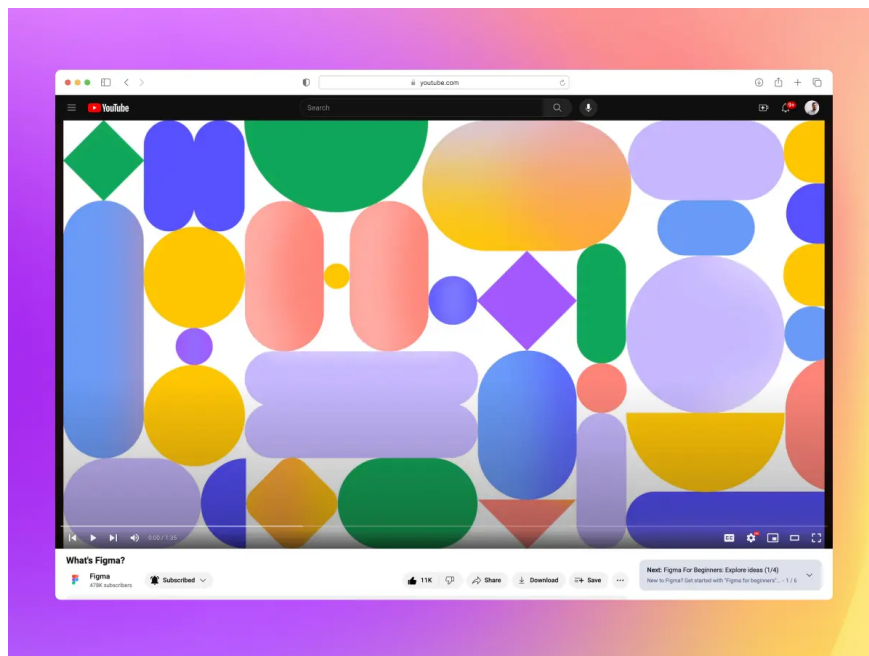

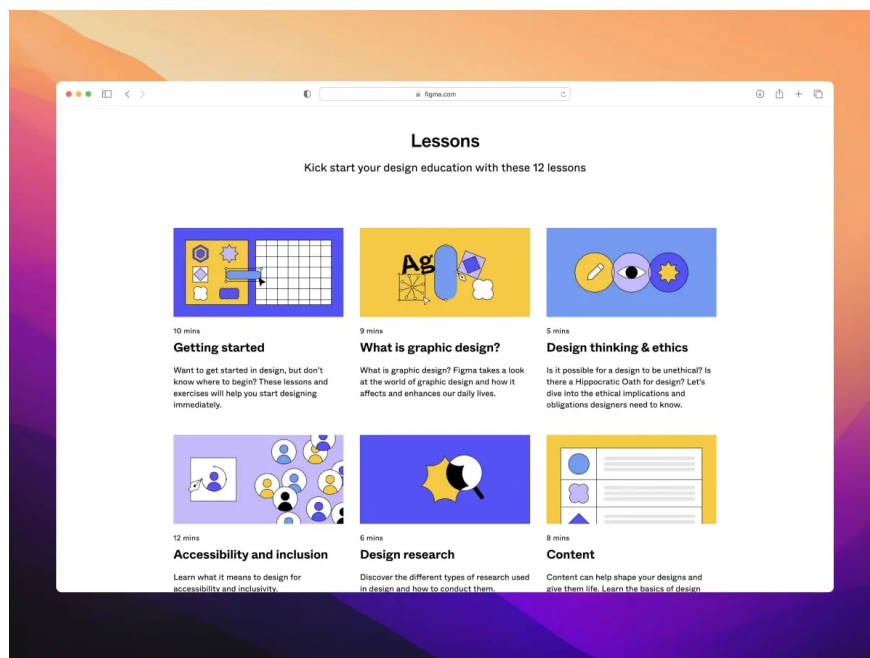

5. Design research: Explore the different types of research used in design and how to conduct them.

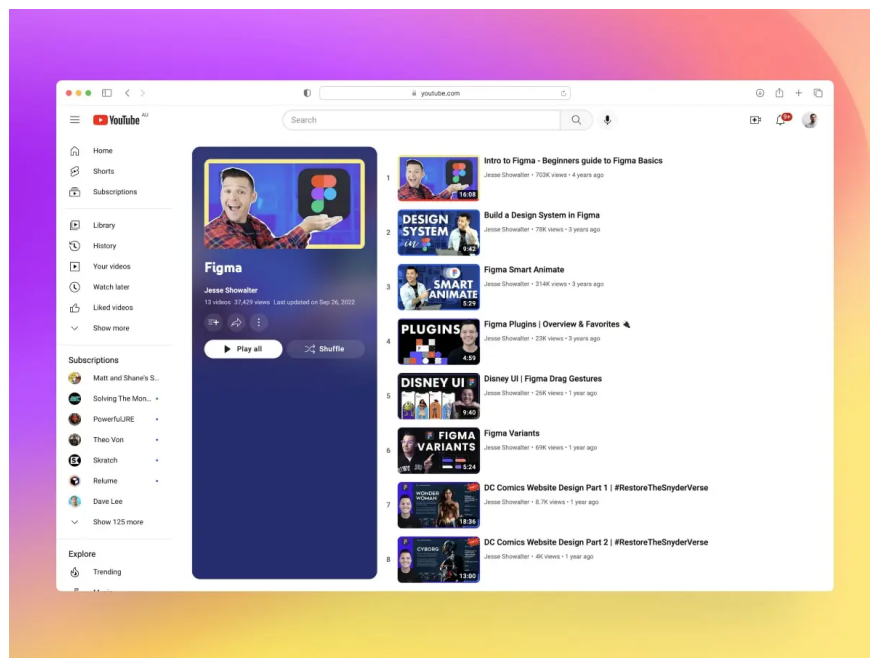
6. **Content:** Content can help shape your designs and bring them to life. Learn the basics of designing with and for content.

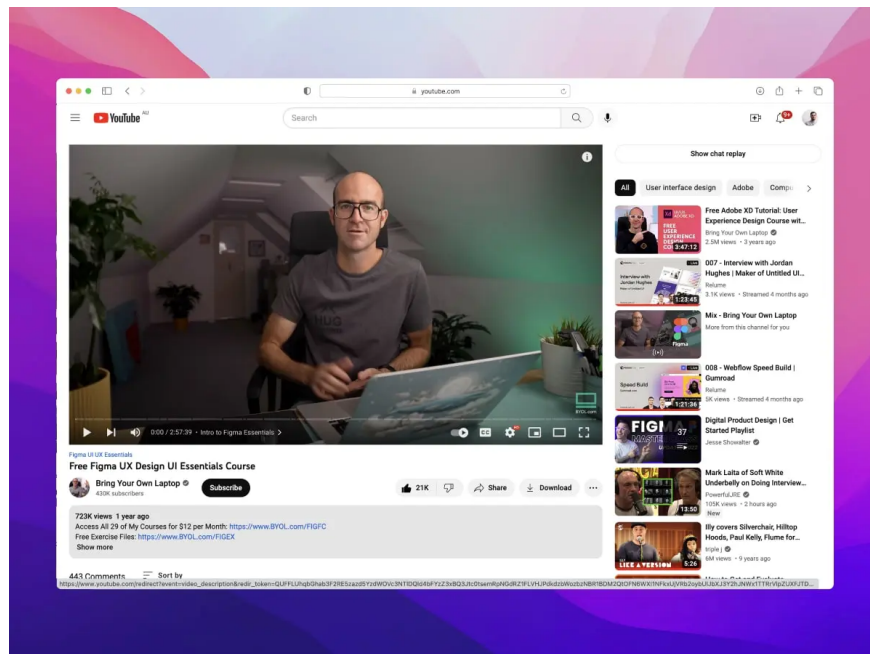
Jesse Showalter's course on Figma is a great free course for beginners, intermediate and advanced UI and UX designers. Jesse is a user interface designer and developer, as well as an incredible teacher and entertainer! His videos are of great quality and fun to watch.

This course is widely available for free on YouTube, and to date it has over 650,000 views, making it one of the most popular free online Figma courses. This course includes 13 videos and lasts less than 2 hours.

This free Figma course includes an introduction to basic concepts, advanced Figma features like automatic layouts and variations, the design system, and the Figma plugin. The instructor will then explain how to design a website for DC comics in the last two videos, so if you want to learn web design from scratch (or you're simply a huge DC comics fan), you will definitely like this course.

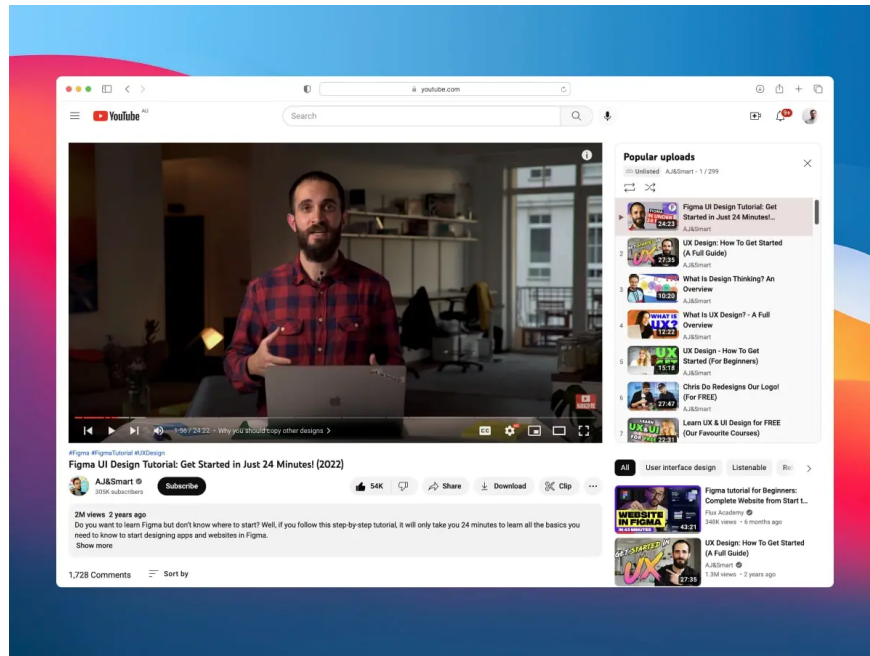
In this course, you'll learn all the essential UX and UI terms and techniques, as well as how to use Figma. Some of the content this course focuses on include:

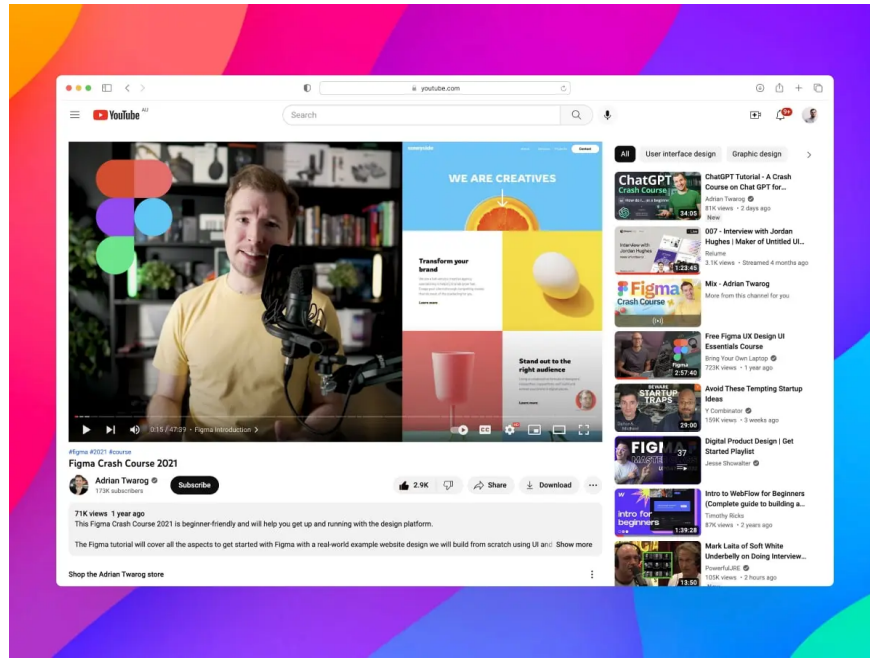

If you're a beginner, you should start with the Figma UI Design Tutorial, where you'll learn how to create a Figma UI design from scratch in just 24 minutes!

In the first part of the video, this tutorial covers Figma's features, how to navigate the Figma interface in your web browser, and the advantages of Figma for future projects. After covering the basics, this tutorial focuses on different ways to create design projects using templates, how to create frames, shapes, colors and circles, how to create high-resolution designs. High fidelity as well as the use of images, text, icons, etc.

6. Figma Crash Course by Adrian Twarog

2. Instructor: Adrian Twarog

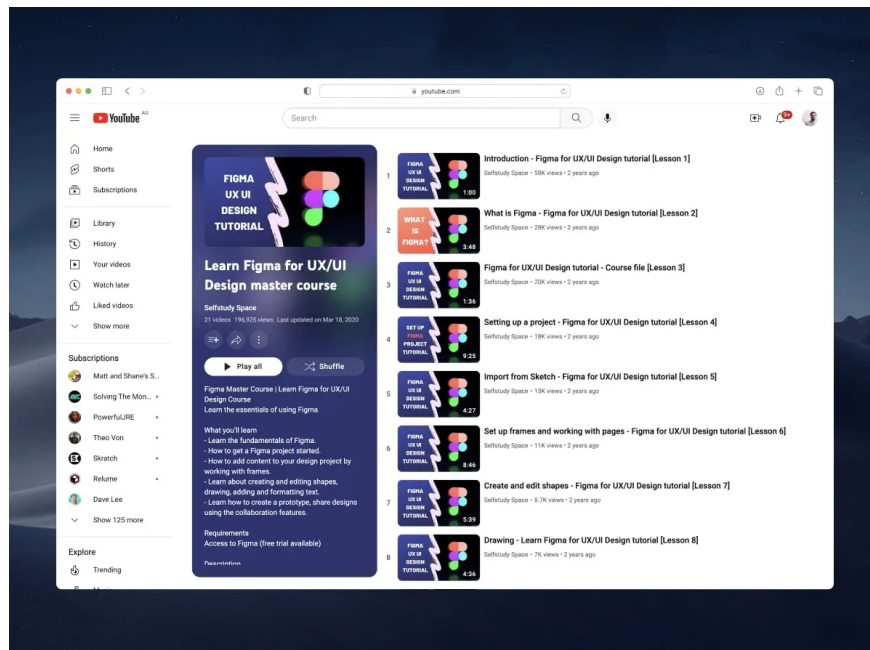

2. Instructor: A place for self-study

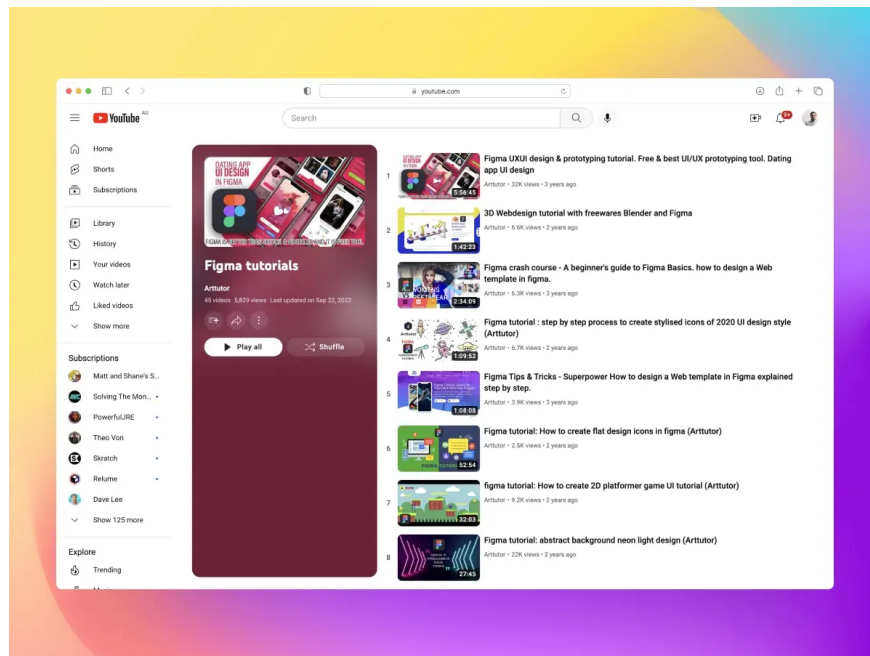

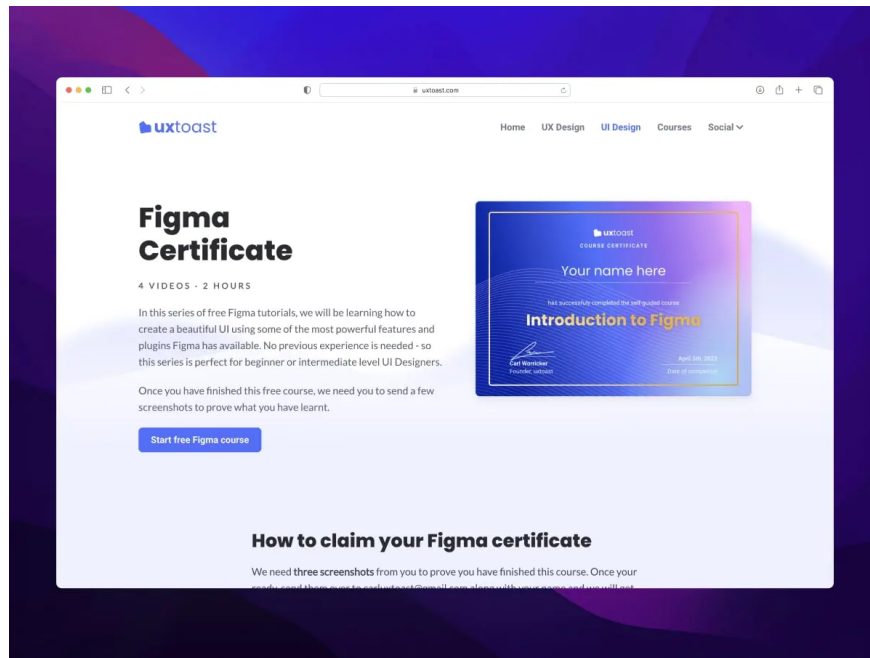
