

# 9 great home cleaning techniques save time

**Cleaning up a clean house** is not an easy task, it always requires a lot of time and effort. Sometimes, it takes us a whole day and a lot of effort to clean the house, bringing great emotions the way we want. For example, strands of hair that are clogged in the manhole, mold, stains on the bathroom doors, toilets - are all uncomfortable jobs for all of us. ## 1. Clean the washing machine

1. You don't need to clean your washing machine with expensive cleaning products, but instead you can use regular **vinegar** . Pour a little vinegar into the drawer for detergent, normal washing whirlpool, When finished, your washing bucket will be clean and shiny.
2. In addition, a little trick that some people know involves strengthening cleaning clothes with the help of vinegar. Mix one third of vinegar compared to washing powder, help clean clothes more effectively. This is especially true for colored clothes.
3. Some materials for easy-to-catch pet clothes like dogs and cats. Wash these clothes with white vinegar and fur will never stick to your clothes again.

## 2. Clean the bathtub

How can I clean a huge bathtub while being alone with a little time? Simple! Heat some vinegar in the microwave (just be warm). **Mix vinegar with soap** in a spray at a ratio of 1: 1, do not shake the spray vigorously, just shake gently to mix well together. Spray the solution into the bath, let stand for 30 minutes, then wipe with a sponge. The result will be more impressive than what you get with these expensive cleaning products.

### **3. Clean the sliding window rails**

We always spend a lot of time cleaning windows sliding rails. However, this is a way to help you do it easily, without much effort.

Sprinkle some **baking soda** into hard to reach places (pay attention to the corners). After that, add a little vinegar - the stain will start to appear bubbles, which is a good sign. For about 10-15 minutes, backing soda and vinegar will deal with stubborn dirt and rust. After leaving for the required time, wipe the sliding window rails with a paper towel.

#### 4. How to wash children's toys

Every parent feels anxious when encountering situations in the house rolling toys under the floor. So sometimes toys need to be cleaned. Currently, there is a way to avoid wasting a lot of time on this. Put **all the toys in a basket and put them in the washing machine**, the washing machine will help clean them quickly.

#### 5. Eliminate stubborn stains

Many of us often encounter colorful brushstrokes across the walls and clean up and still do not fly the ink. However, there are a few quick and easy ways to be known, that are:

1. To remove " *permanent* " ink stains on the floor or on the table, apply some common **toothpaste** to a wet cloth (preferably microfilm) and rub the stains.
2. Use **hair spray** or deodorant, even aerosol, spray directly on the dirty area and rinse with water.
3. Another method is to use regular carbonated soft drinks and a sponge. Sprinkle some soda into the sponge, rub the area that is dirty and rinse it off with water.

## 6. How to remove nail polish when they stick to the fabric

If you've ever fallen or accidentally broke a nail polish bottle, it's a tragedy: not only have you lost your favorite colored nail polish bottle, but you also have to think about how to clean up the paint spill? Here are a few tips you can apply:

1. First, let the paint stain dry, then use a **nail polish remover** to clean this paint. Rub the stain with a paper towel and remove what's left with a rubber eraser. In just a few minutes everything is clean again, then wipe it off with warm water and soap.
2. What happens if nail polish spills onto the carpet? Please apply the same way to remove stains, then wipe the seal with a damp cloth.

## 7. Clean the microwave oven

With this procedure, you can perform microwave cleaning in just five minutes. Cut the **lemon** in half, place it in a cup and add some **cinnamon** and put the cup in the microwave and turn it on within 5-10 minutes at the lowest power. Lemon will help clean and disinfect, cinnamon will help get rid of unpleasant odors.

## 8. Clean the cooking stove

In order not to waste many hours cleaning the kitchen, apply this simple trick. Mix some **baking soda** with **vegetable oil** until the mixture matches. Apply the mixture directly to any stubborn grease surface and leave it for 5-10 minutes. Then just wipe with a cloth with soap.

## 9. Flying dust on utensils

There is an easy way to avoid spending time cleaning dirt on utensils. Put a few drops of essential oil on a paper towel and wipe it over the dusty area. Then wipe again with a clean paper towel. By cleaning this, make the furniture surface more shiny and help avoid dust accumulation.
