9. Employees are not able to completely clean food spilled on the floor by the time between the shifts too close together

Have you ever noticed that the cinema floor feels a bit sticky and quite dirty even when there are always staff cleaning the room after each projection?

That's because **the break time between screenings is quite short so all the cleaning staff can do during this time is sweep the floor** . Sometimes it is done quickly and carelessly. The floor in the theater is only properly cleaned and cleaned with a solution at night, when the projection rates are out on that day.

8. It is easier for cleaning staff if you put the garbage on the chair, not under the seat

6. Butter popcorn is usually too expensive

According to some sources, 10.5 oz (*about 168g*) of popcorn **costs more than high quality steak** and weight. The price of this favorite snack is so expensive that it is even cheaper when you go to a high-class restaurant.

In the US, part of the big popcorn in the theater is sold for an average of \$ 8, while it is offered to the cinema for only \$ 1, along with the price you pay in grocery.

5. Until 1981, movie theater seats had cup holders

Interestingly, the cup holders on the movie seat were only invented in 1981, about 60 years after the first air-conditioned cinema opened in the United States.

Besides, popcorn began to be sold in US theaters during World War II, when the shortage of sugar caused the cinema to stop selling candy.

4. Why is the corn popcorn so fragrant?
