So, if suddenly one day the toolbar on your computer is rotated vertically. Surely users will be very uncomfortable because they are 'unfamiliar'. 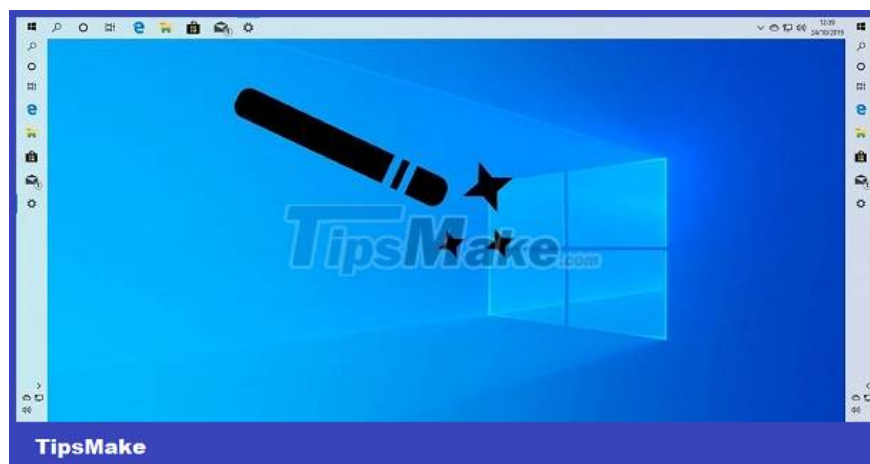
You should find out why the toolbar on your computer is rotated vertically

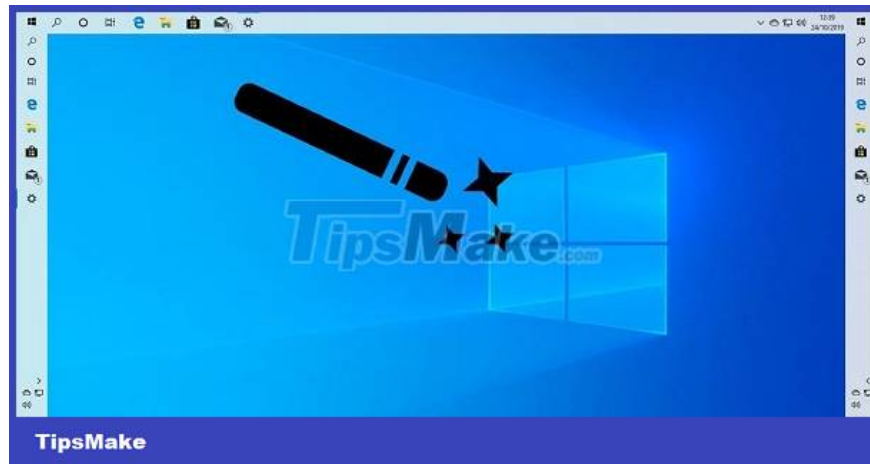
Don't worry too much when you see the taskbar rotated vertically, because this is not an error. Therefore, before getting to the troubleshooting part, I will explain a little more clearly why the toolbar on the computer suddenly 'left its original position'.

Why is the toolbar on the computer rotated vertically?

As I shared, this case is not a problem on the computer. There is a high possibility that you or someone else when using the computer has done the trick to move the Taskbar vertically. And not only vertical, you can also move the taskbar's position up, left, right.

Therefore, the fact that the toolbar on the computer is not located at the bottom is due to the settings. Therefore, the way to fix this situation is not too complicated. Join me in following the next part to know more.





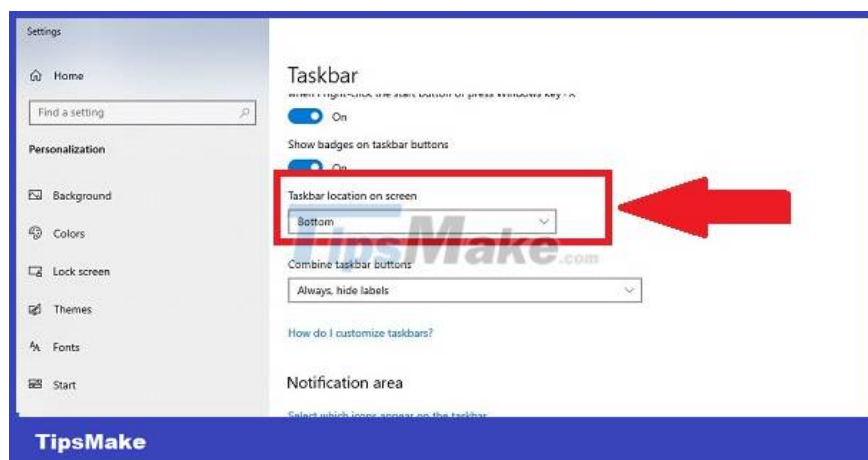
Instructions on how to fix the vertically rotated toolbar on the computer

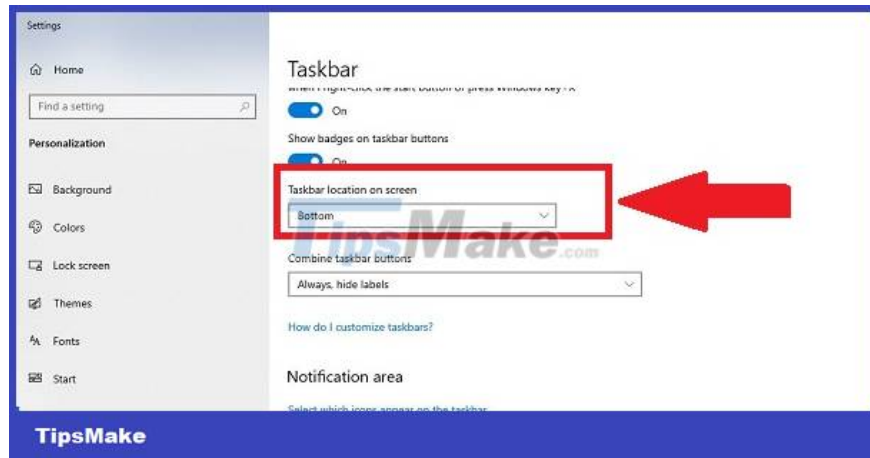
Admin will reveal how to set the taskbar back to its default position or move it somewhere as you like on Windows 10 and Windows 11. Depending on the operating system you are using, apply the appropriate solution.

1/ Share how to move the taskbar vertically in Windows 10

For Windows 10, changing the position of the toolbar is extremely simple without using software.

1. **Step 1** : Right-click any space on the taskbar > Select **TaskBar settings** .
2. **Step 2** : In the toolbar settings interface, find **TaskBar location on screen** and **Combine TaskBar buttons** . For **TaskBar location on screen**, select **the taskbar display location** . As for the **Combine TaskBar buttons** section, it is to **adjust the hiding/showing of the toolbar** , merging folders or dividing individual folders.
3. **Step 3** : Admin will talk specifically about **TaskBar location on screen** > You just need to click on the arrow on this line. If you want the toolbar to return to default, click **Bottom** (below). If you want to move vertically to the left or right, press **Left** (left) / **Right** (right). If you want the toolbar above, click **Top** .

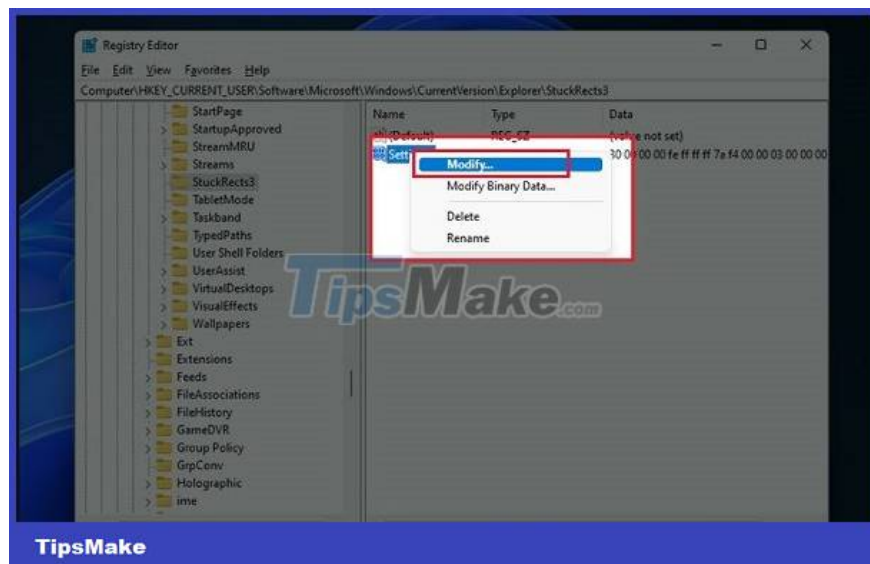


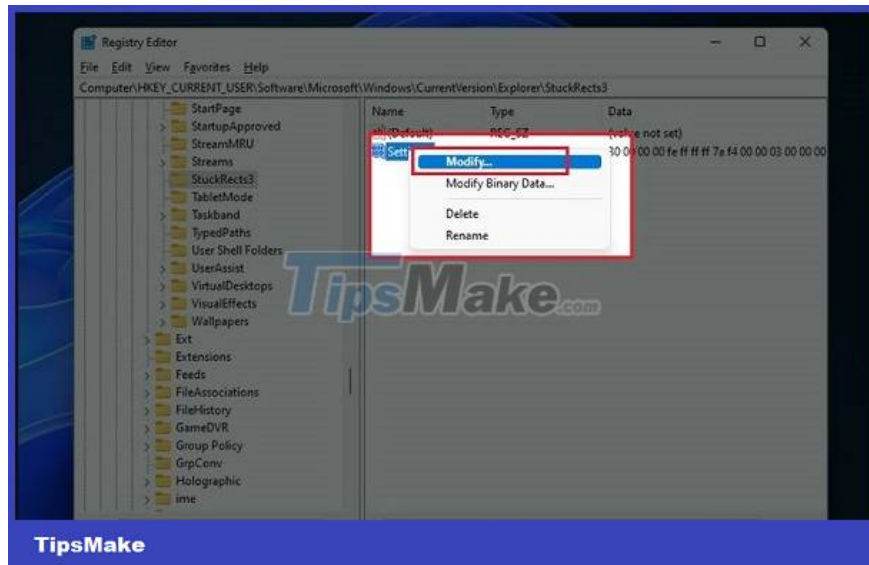


2/ Share how to move the Taskbar vertically in Windows 11

With Win 11, it's a little more complicated if you want to change the position of the toolbar. In case you find the operation a bit cumbersome, you can download a 3rd party software to support adjustments.

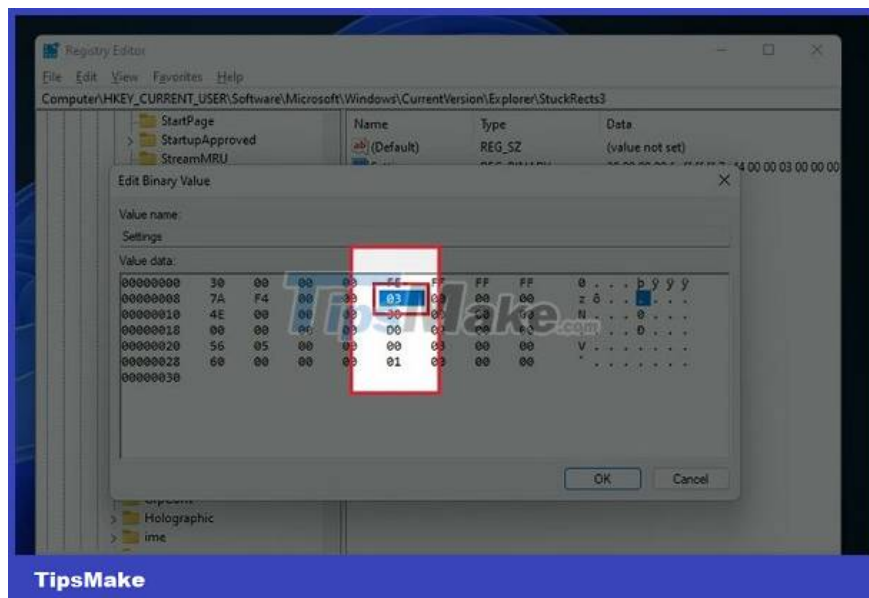
1. **Step 1** : Press the **Windows + R** key combination > Enter **regedit** and press **Ok** to run the command.
2. **Step 2** : Access the path **HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Explorer\StuckRects3** .
3. **Step 3** : In the next window, the user clicks on the **Setting** file > Select **Modify** .

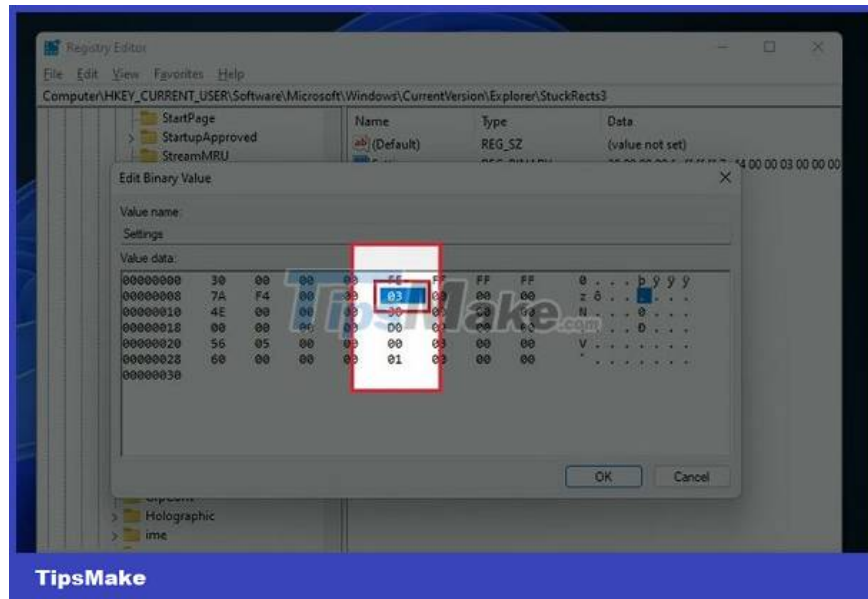




1. **Step 4 :** *When the Edit Binary Value window displays*> Go to column **FE** and delete the value in the first row. Note, some models still do not allow changing the taskbar to the left or right, so adjusting it may cause errors. Therefore, before doing so, you need to backup the Registry key by exporting file *StuckRects3*. Then, enter the following numbers to change the taskbar position:

1. **00:** Toolbar on the left side of the screen (Left)
2. **01:** Toolbar at the top (TOP)
3. **02:** Toolbar on the right side of the screen (Right)
4. **03:** Toolbar at the bottom (Bottom)





1. **Step 5** : After entering the value, click **OK** to close > Press the key combination **Ctrl + Shift + Esc** > Find **Windows Explorer** and right-click on it > select **Restart** to complete this process.
