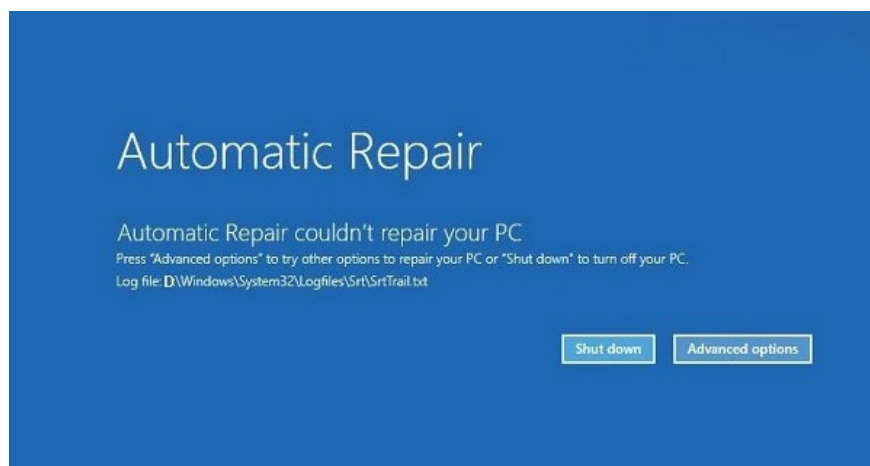


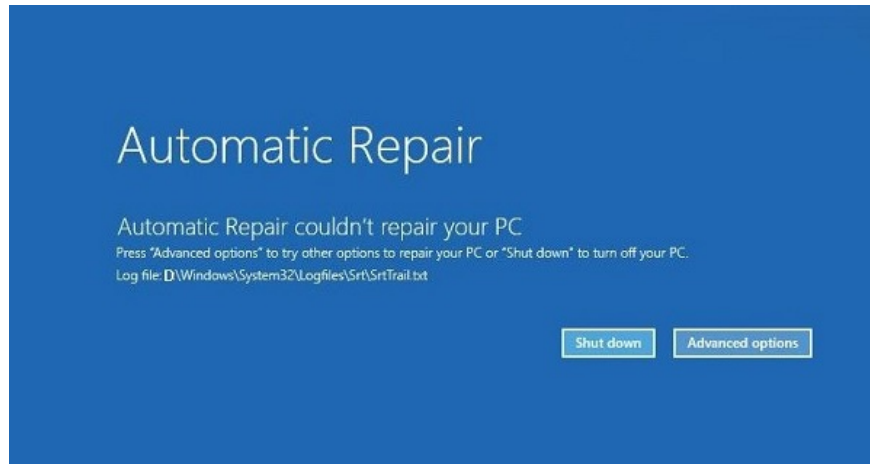
## Information you need to understand before fixing the error Choose an option Win 10+11

When it comes to **Choose an option**, you will probably feel strange. But in fact, if you have ever used Startup Repair or fixed Automatic Repair errors, you have probably seen this message.

### So what exactly is the Choose an option error?

In fact, Choose an option is not an error but a screen with many options. This screen usually appears when accessing Repair your Computer or when you enter the Advanced Startup Options menu. Therefore, you can understand that Choose an option is an intermediate step that you need to take if you want to do other steps.





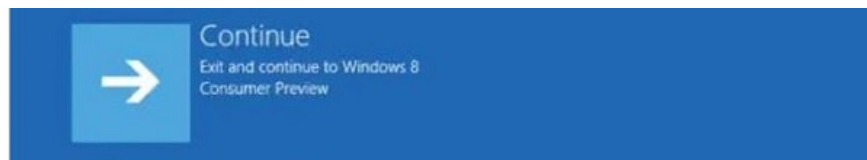
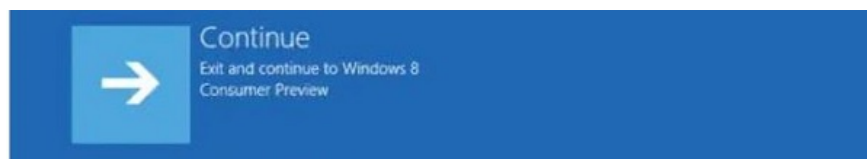
## Instructions to fix errors Choose an option Windows 10, 11

As mentioned above, only when opening a certain mode will the Choose an option screen appear. But if you don't do anything but when you turn on the device you see Choose an option. This is a sign that your computer is having some problem.

After a period of research, I see that up to now, we have not yet specifically determined the cause of this situation. In this case, you can refer to how to fix the Choose an option error. Windows 11 and 10 are guided below.

### 1: Select Continue

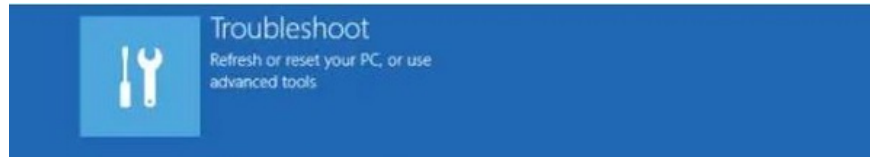
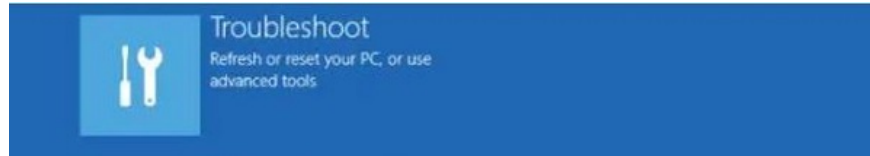
First, try selecting **Continue** . This option will take you out of the Choose an option screen and into windows. If everything goes well, you should be able to access your computer. Now, please check and update your computer if there is a new update. And if you suspect the error is caused by some strange software or file. Please remove all these ingredients.



### 2: Select Troubleshoot

If the above method doesn't work, try selecting **Troubleshoot** . Then select **advanced Options** and select **Startup Repair** . When the Preparing Automatic Repair screen appears, you must wait a moment to finish the process. Then click **Test Machine** and enter your computer password if required. At this time, the system will

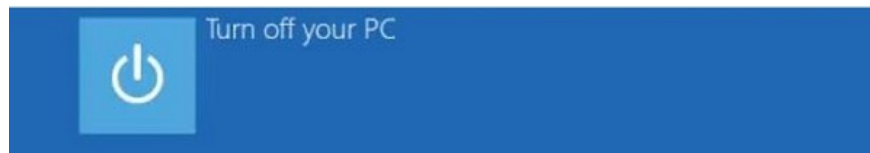
try to run and fix the remaining errors.



### 3: Turn Off your PC

Finally, you can select Turn Off your PC and then try to restart your computer again. This method sounds quite simple, but sometimes it brings surprising results.

In case you have tried the above methods but the situation is still not satisfactory. This is when you need to bring your computer to the center for testing. With professional technicians, determining the cause and fixing the error will be much simpler.
