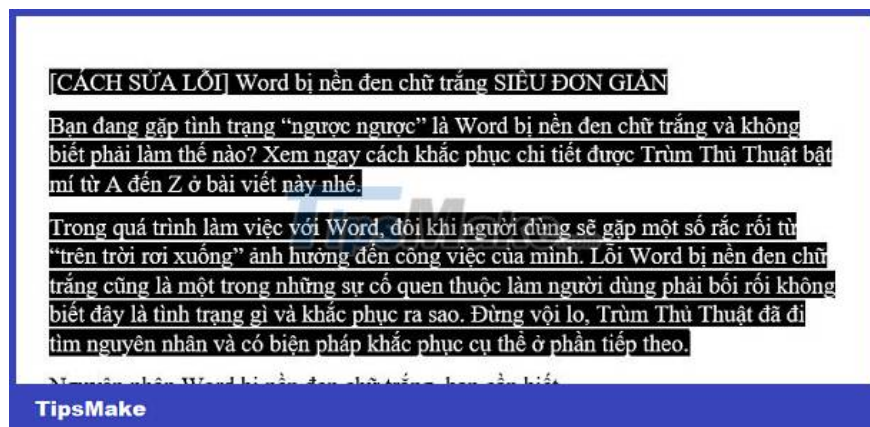


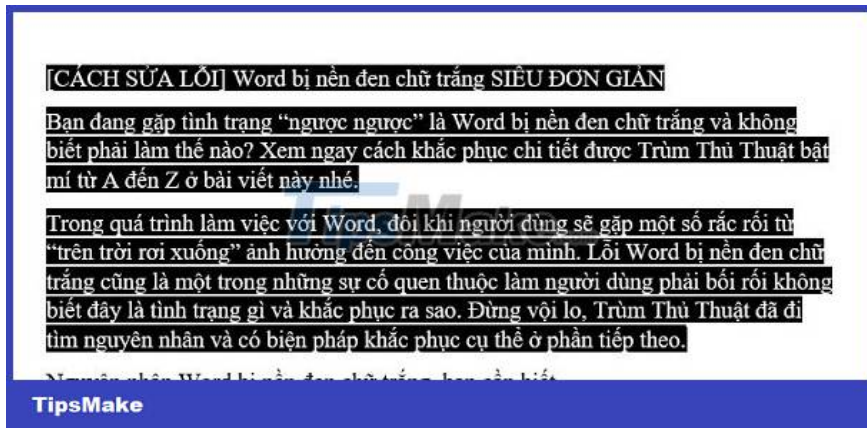
The reason why Word has a black background and white text, you need to know

Word having a black background with white text on a phone/computer is not an uncommon problem. Even many people often encounter this situation when copying a certain paragraph to Word. Before getting to the troubleshooting part, let's find out why Word has a black background with white text to get the most correct solution.

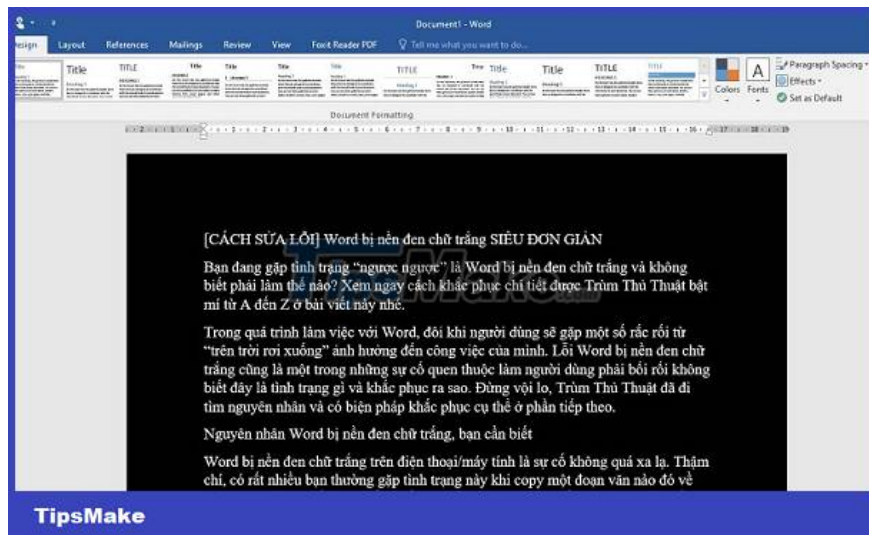
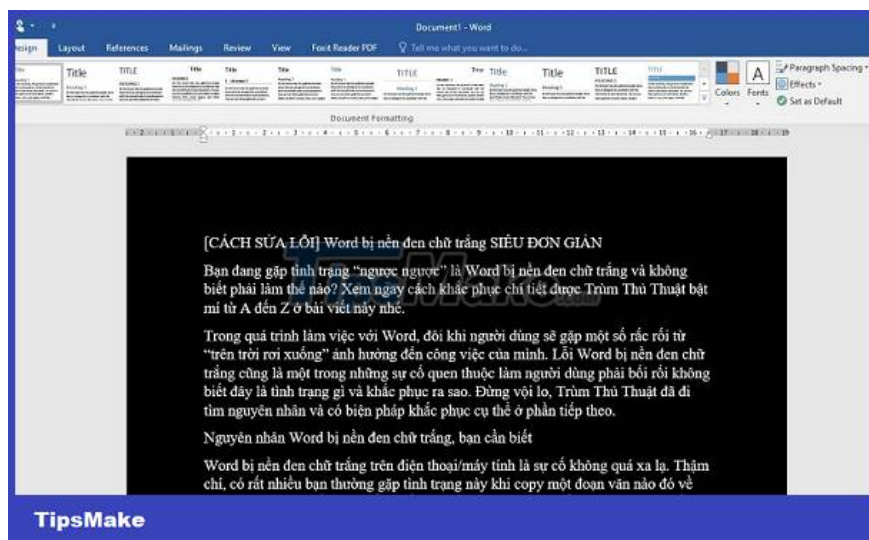
Why is Word's background black?

1. *Word's black background is likely because you changed the background color to black.*





1. Or Word's background has a completely black background so the text is white.



1. It's also possible that the error is due to turning on Dark mode in Word, so the black background and white text are displayed.

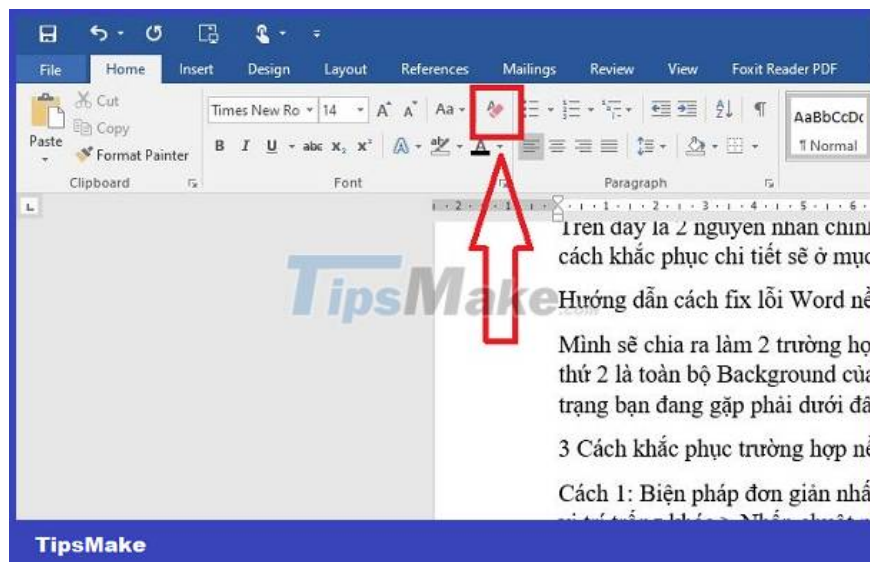
Above are the 2 main causes for Word having black background and white text errors, detailed fixes will be in the next section.

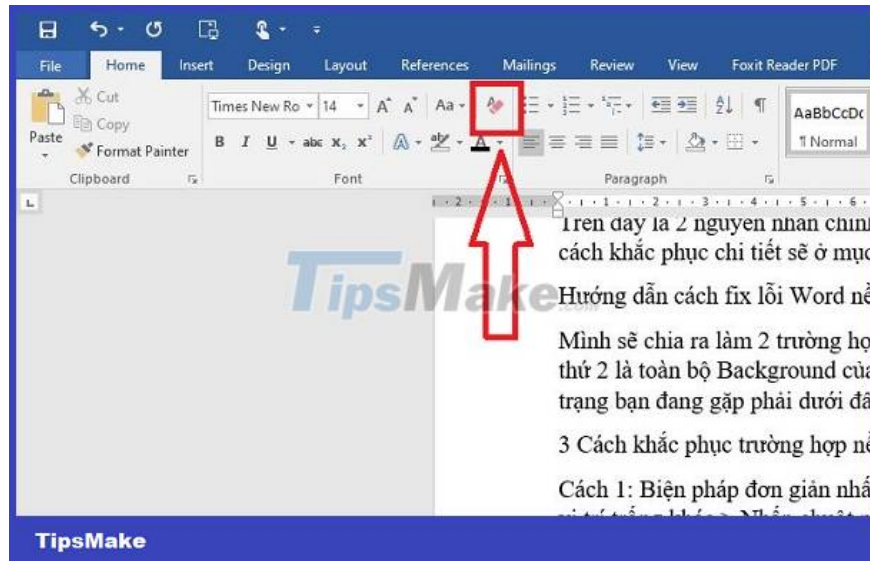
Instructions on how to quickly fix Word errors with black background and white text

I will divide it into two specific cases: the case of black background color and the second case where the entire background of Word is completely black. Depending on the situation you are experiencing, below are ways for you to fix it.

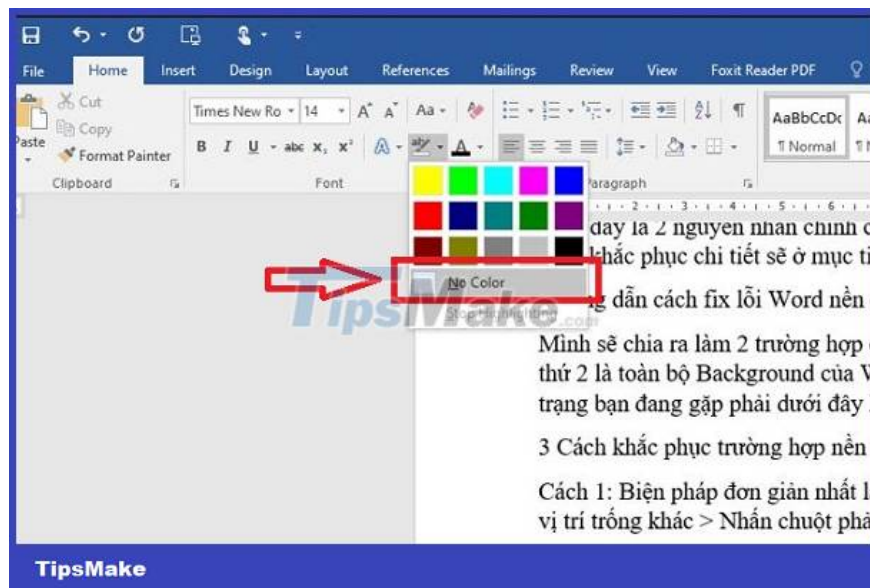
3 Ways to fix black background with white text 1

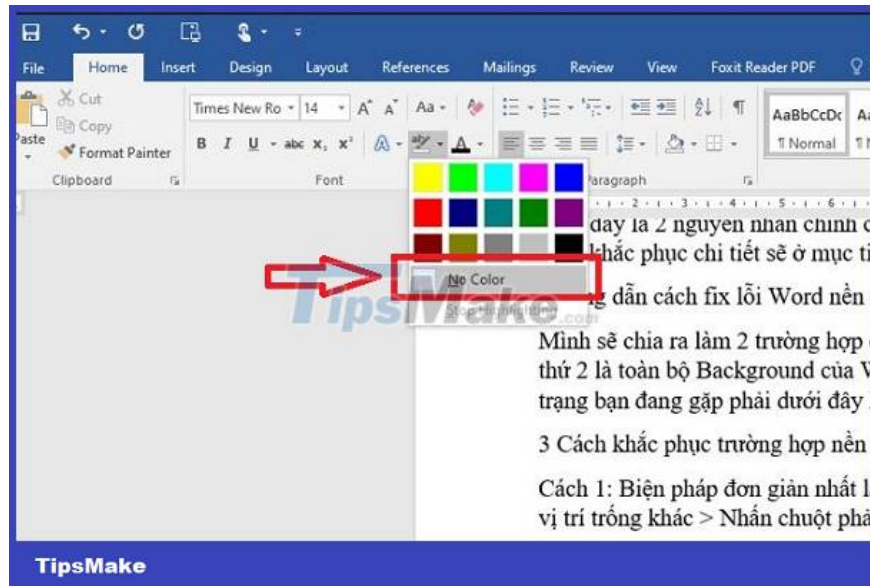
1. **Method 1** : The simplest solution is to copy the paragraph with black text > Then find another empty location > Right-click and select **Keep Text Only** .
2. **Method 2** : You highlight the entire text you want to change the Word background from black to white > Click the **Home tab** > Click the **Clear All Formatting** icon as shown to delete the background of the text you selected and you're done.





1. **Method 3** : You also black out all the text with a black background that you want to change to white > Click on the small ab icon in the **Home** tab > Select **No Color** .

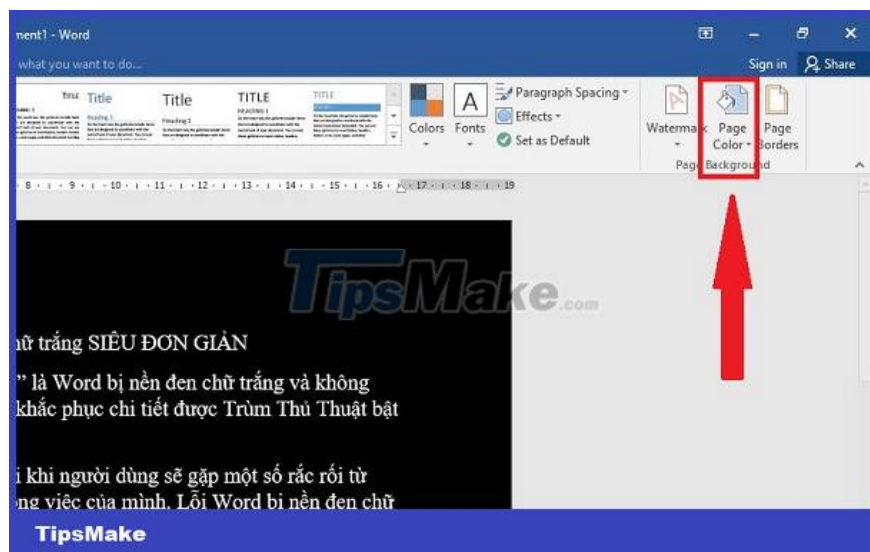


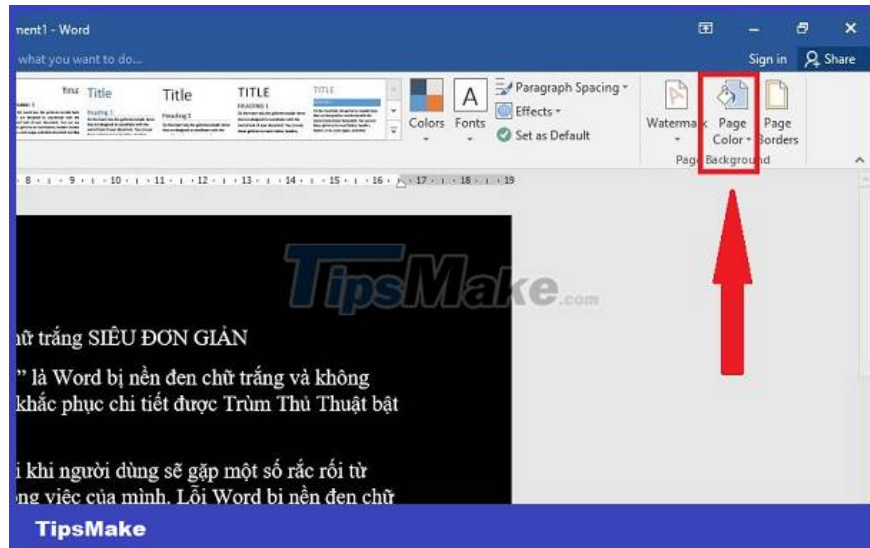


How to change black background in Word

If the entire Word is black, it means the whole page is formatted as black, not white as usual. Then you need to apply the following measures to handle:

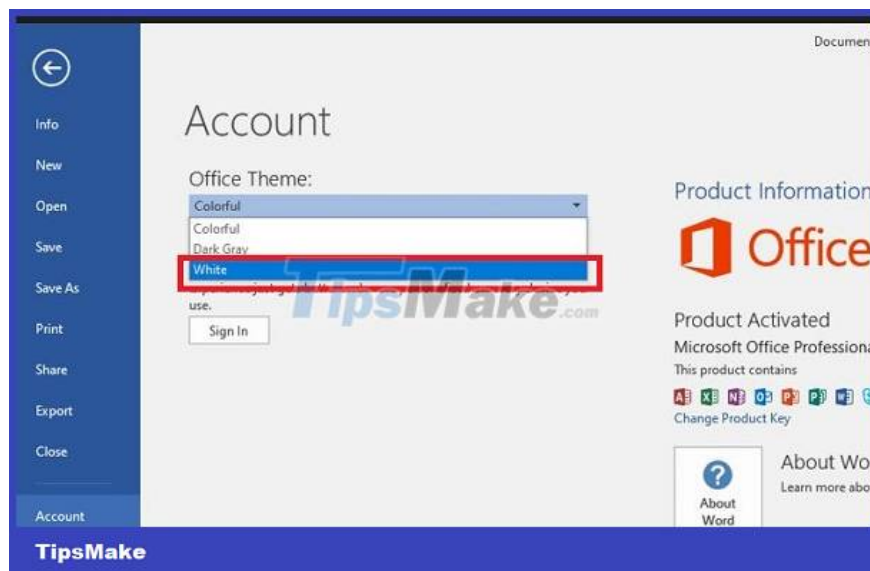
1. **Step 1** : Click on the word page with black background > Select the **Design** tab .
2. **Step 2** : Find the **Page Color** option > Click on the arrow of this line > When the list displays, click **No Color** .

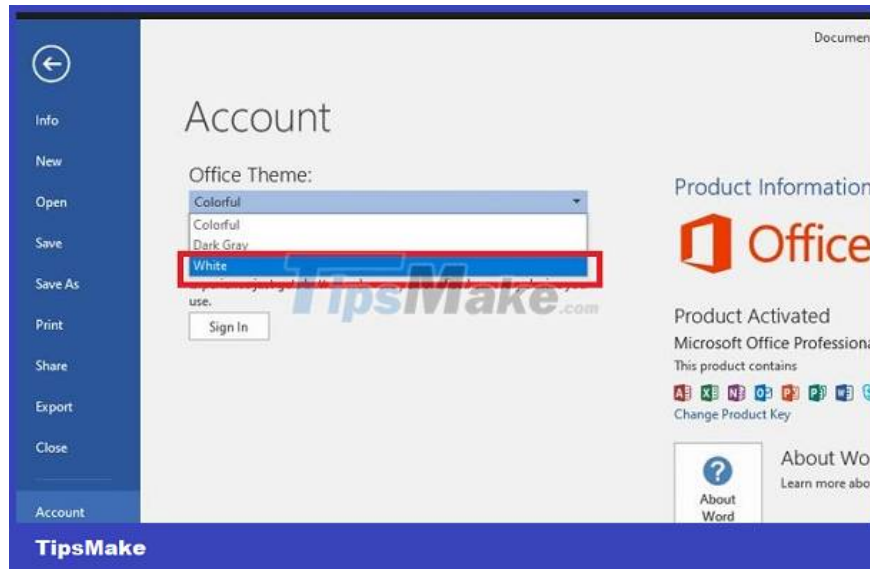




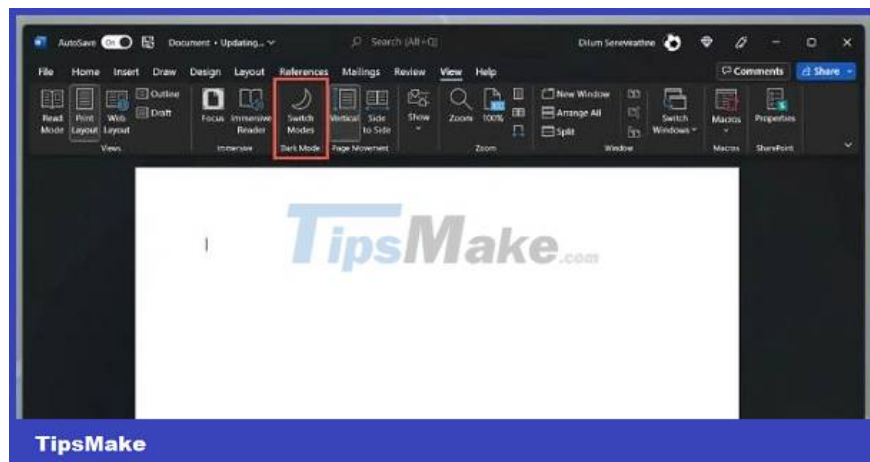
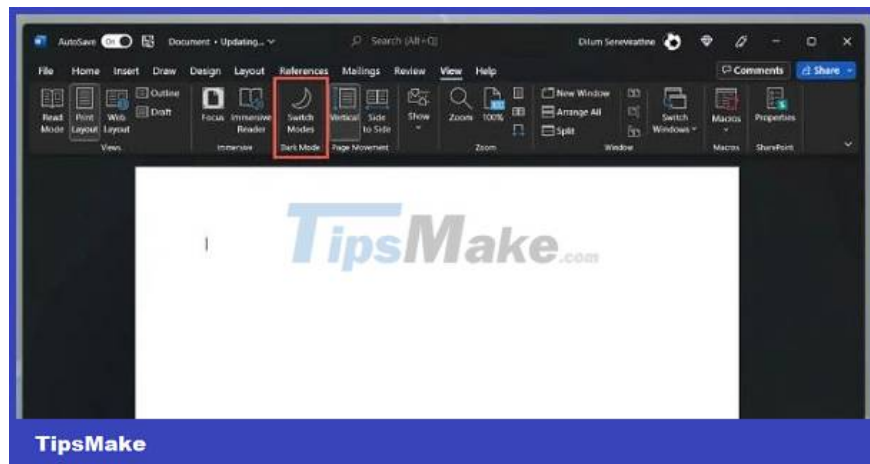
Turn off dark mode in Word

To turn off dark mode in Word, do the following: The user clicks on the **File** tab > Select **Account** > In the **Office Theme** section > Change from **Black** to **White** .

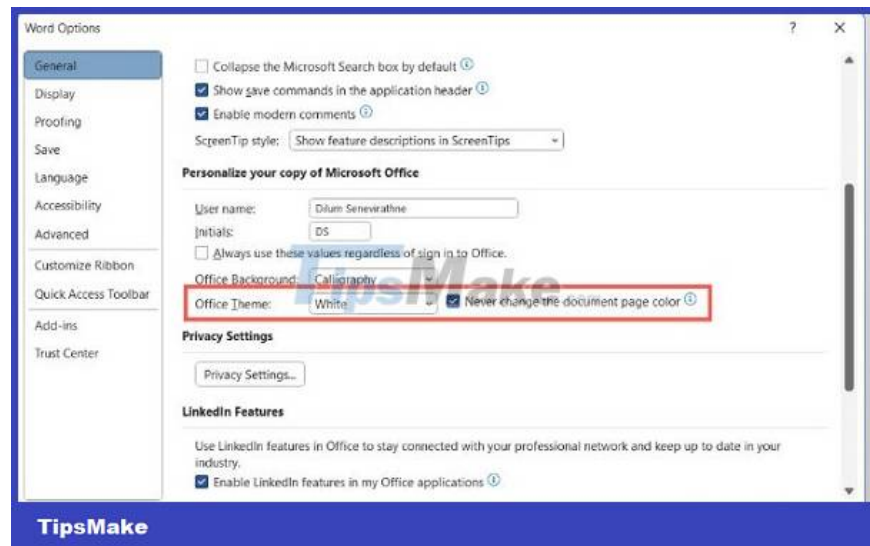




If you just want to turn off dark mode in the document area, this is also the way to change the Word background from black to white on Macbook/Windows: In the open document, click on the **View** tab > Click the **Switch Modes** button (for Macbook) to change to White background, black text if desired. As for Windows, on the **View** tab , click **Read Mode** > Click **View** again > Select **Page Color** and select **None** .



Install Word's dark mode: If you want to still use dark mode but the document area is still white as usual. You can install by following the path: Go to **File > Options > General > Personalize your copy of Microsoft Office > At the Office Theme line > Select White > Tick the line 'Never change the document page color' > Click OK** to save changes is to be.
