

A compilation of the fastest ways to shut down Windows 10.

Guide to shutting down Windows 10, the fastest way to shut down Win 10.

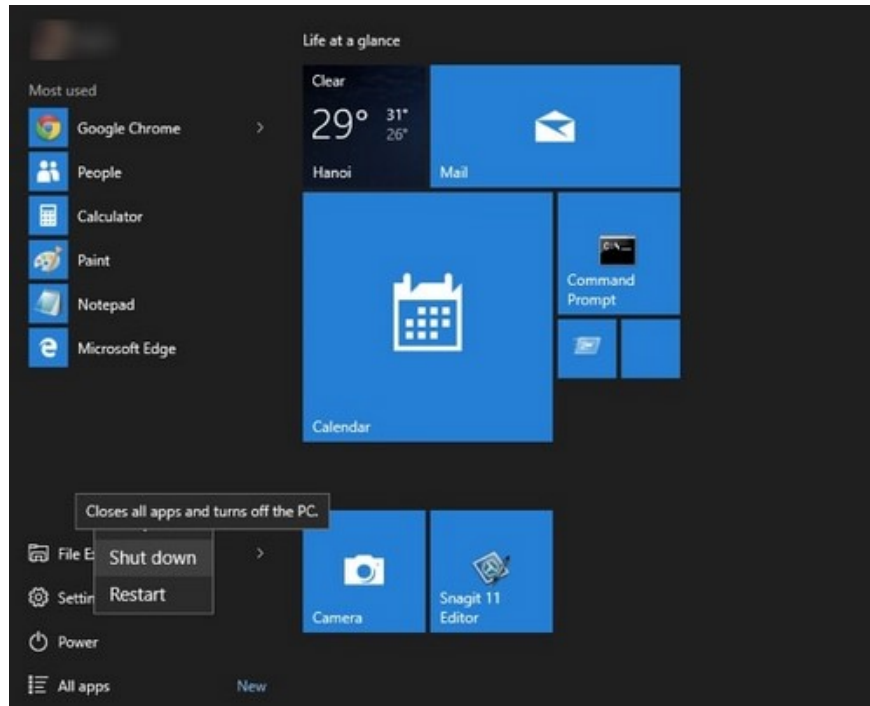
With Windows 10, the process is no longer as complicated as on Windows 8. After installing Windows 10 , you can easily use a simple shutdown method similar to Windows 7 and Windows XP. In this article, we will summarize the fastest ways to shut down Windows 10.

- 1. Default shutdown .**
- 2. Right-click the Start button.**
- 3. Create a shortcut to the home screen.**
- 4. Use the Shutdown command with cmd.**
- 5. Swipe down to shut down.**
- 6. Use Cortana to shut down.**
- 7. Shut down via the Windows Toolbox.**
- 8. Set up a physical Power button for quick computer shutdown.**

Ways to shut down Windows 10, the fastest ways to turn off Windows 10.

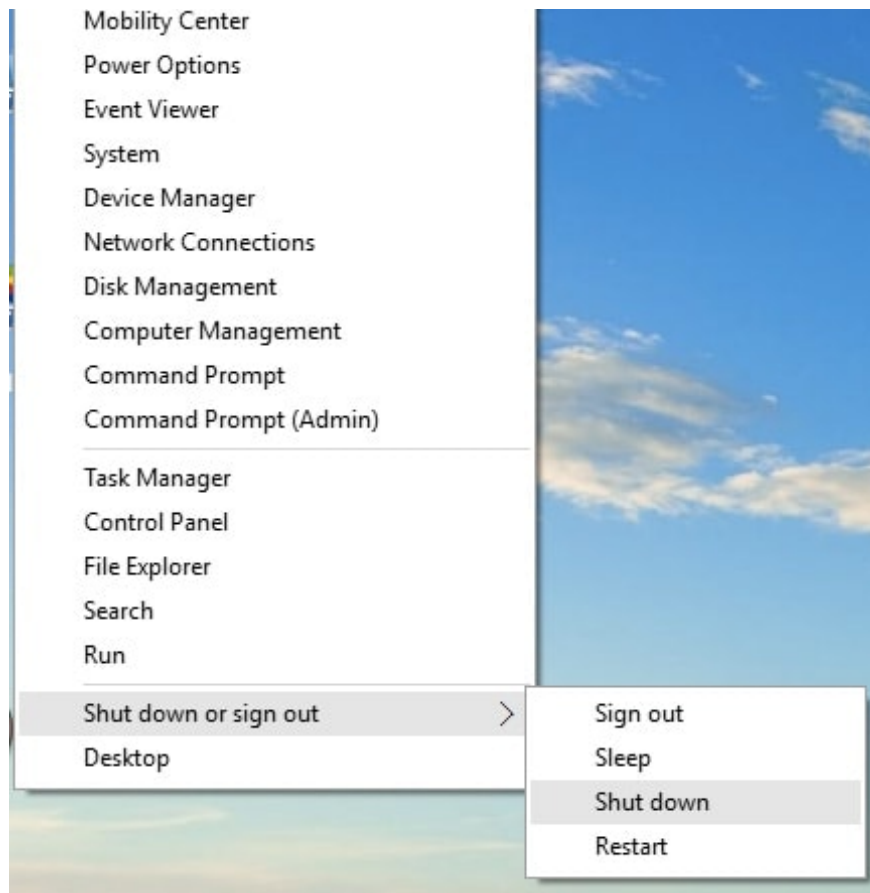
1. Shutdown by default.

To shut down **Windows 10** , click on the **Start** menu , then select **Power > Shutdown** .



2. Right-click on the Start button.

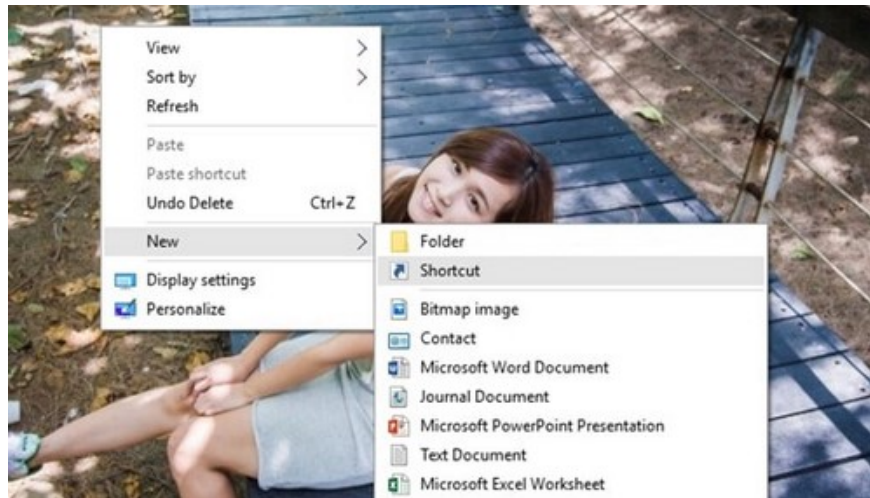
Another equally simple way is to right-click the **Start** button , then select **Shut down or sign out > Shut down** Win 10 to turn off the computer.



3. Create a shortcut to the home screen.

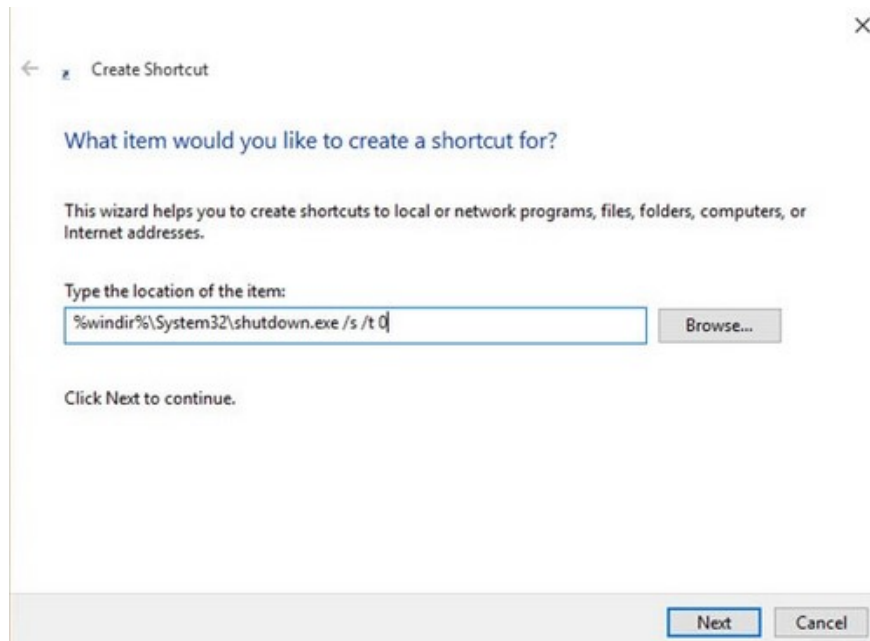
Alternatively, you can create a shutdown shortcut on the home screen using the instructions below.

First, right-click on the desktop and select **New > Shortcut** .

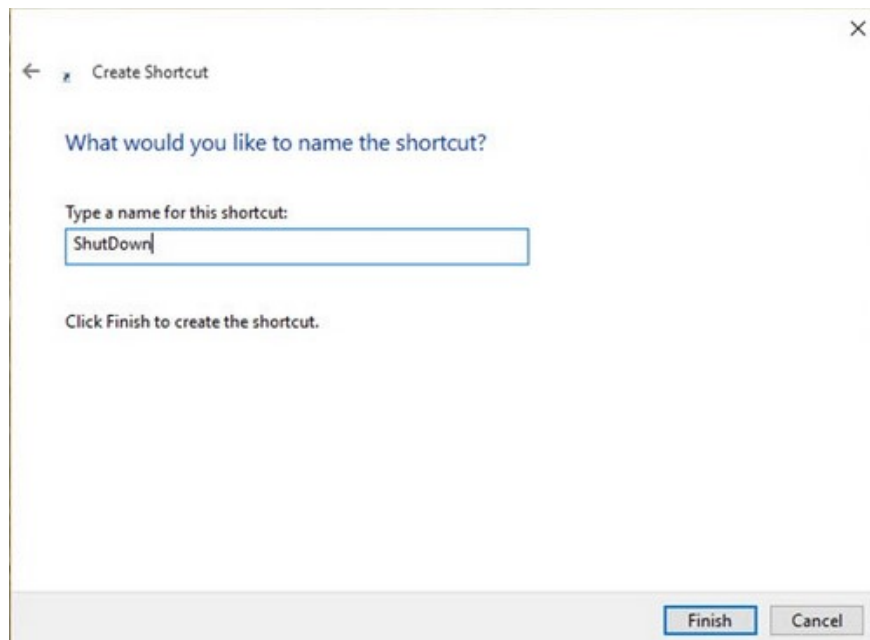


Next, enter the following command: **%windir%System32shutdown.exe /s /t 0**

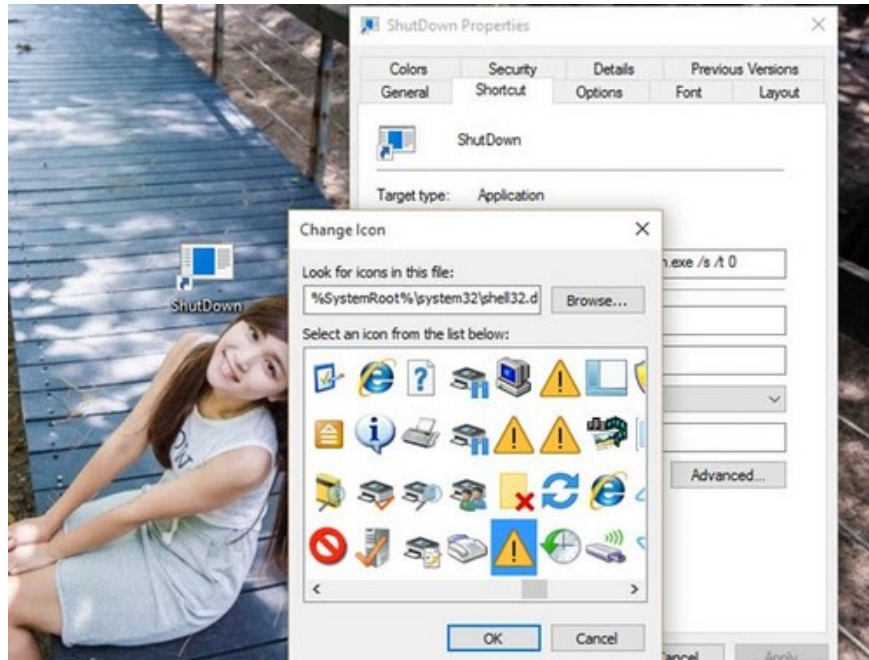
This command shuts down Windows 10 immediately without waiting for processes to close, making the shutdown process as fast as possible.



Give the shortcut a name. Here we've named it 'ShutDown'.



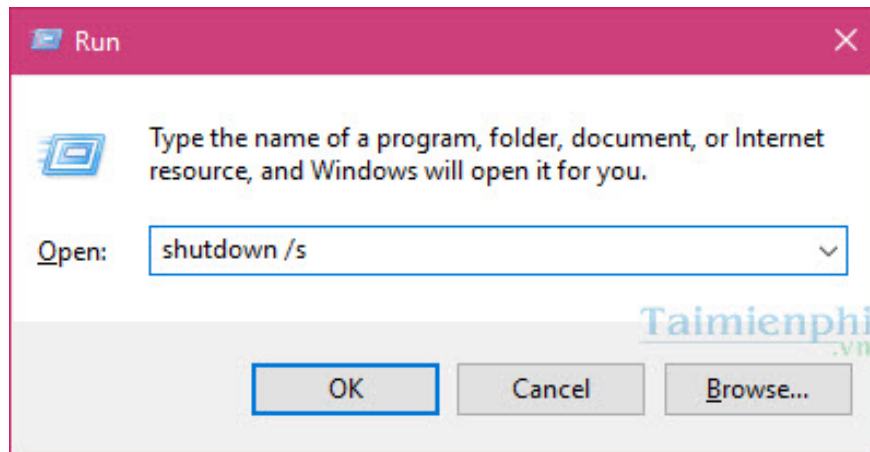
The icon appears after installation. Now, whenever you want to shut down your computer, you just double-click this icon. You can also change the icon to make it more visually appealing.



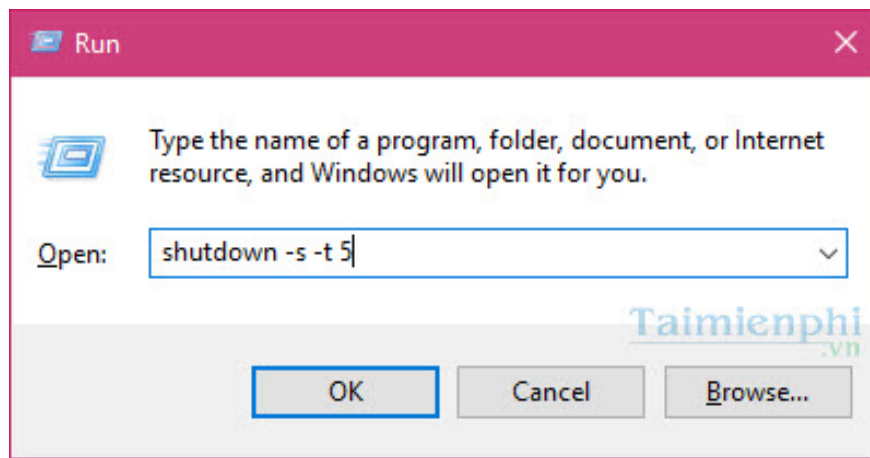
4. Using the Shutdown command with CMD

This is one of the quickest ways to shut down Windows 10 using the very simple command: `` shutdown /s``.

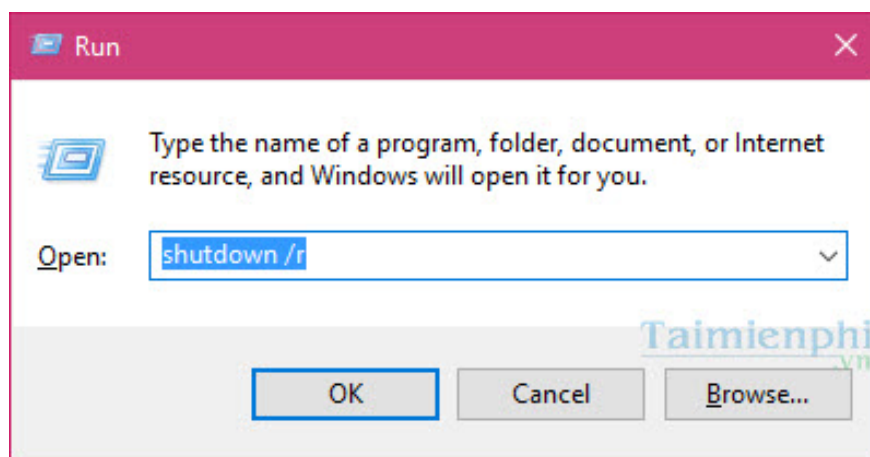
To execute this command, first press **Windows + R**, then enter the code above and click **OK**. Your computer will shut down immediately.



And of course, you can use it to schedule a shutdown with the same formula plus the character 't' and the desired shutdown time. For example, if I want the computer to shut down in 1 minute, I would enter `` shutdown -s -t 60``. '-t' is the time value in seconds; if it's 0, the computer will shut down immediately.



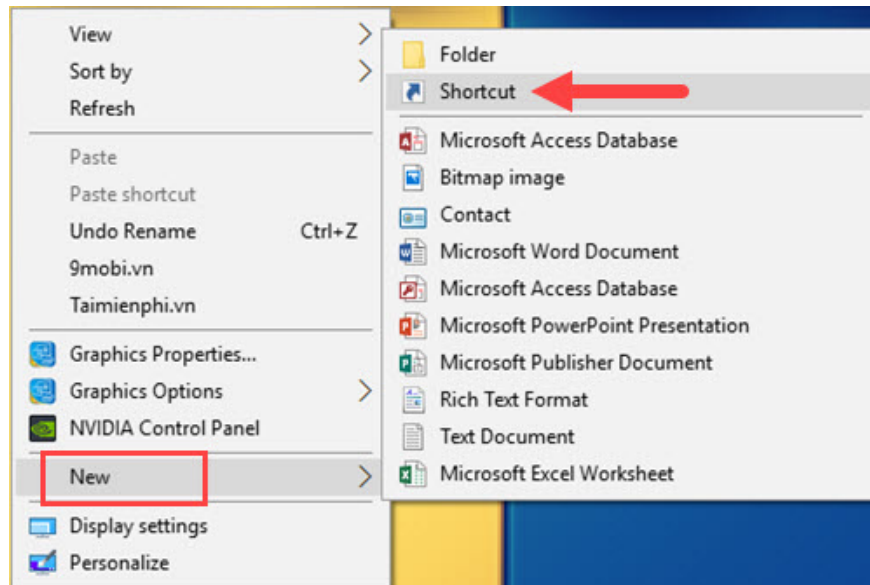
You can also apply the ``Shutdown -r`` function to restart your computer, similar to how you shut down a computer.



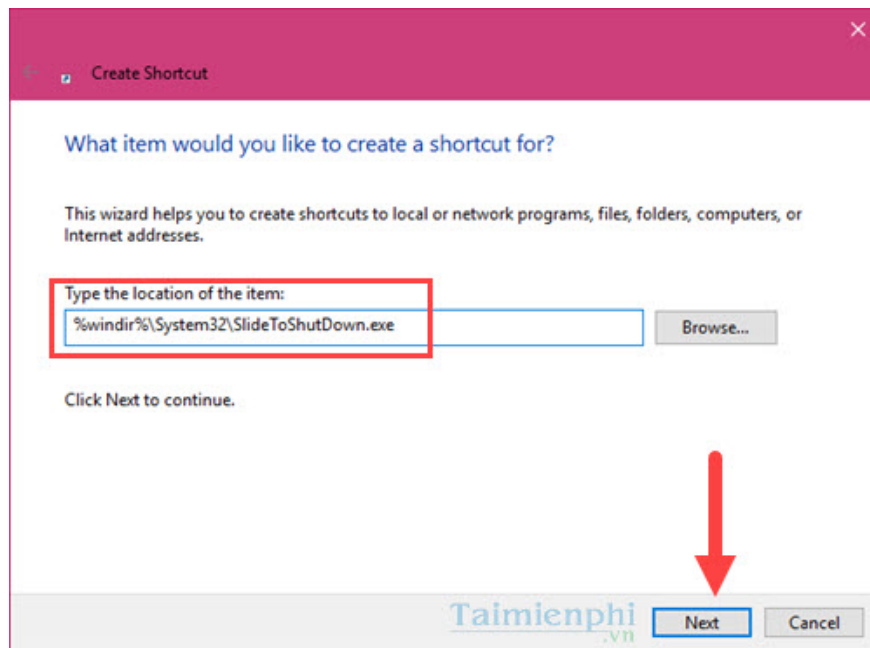
5. Swipe down to turn off the device.

In reality, this method doesn't shut down your computer any faster, but it does offer a unique way to shut down Windows 10: swiping the screen to turn it off. Here's how:

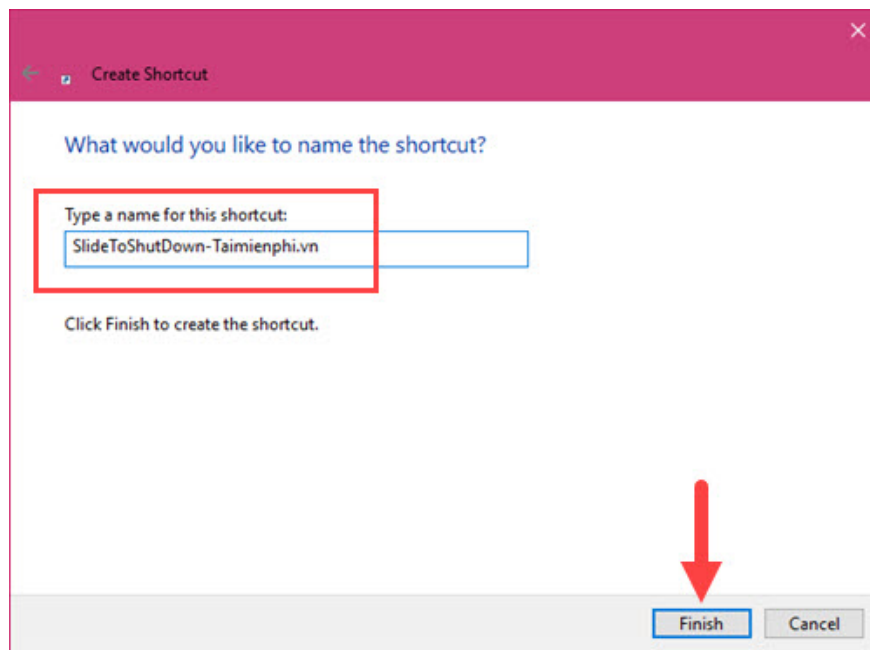
Step 1: Right-click on the desktop and select **New > Shortcut** .



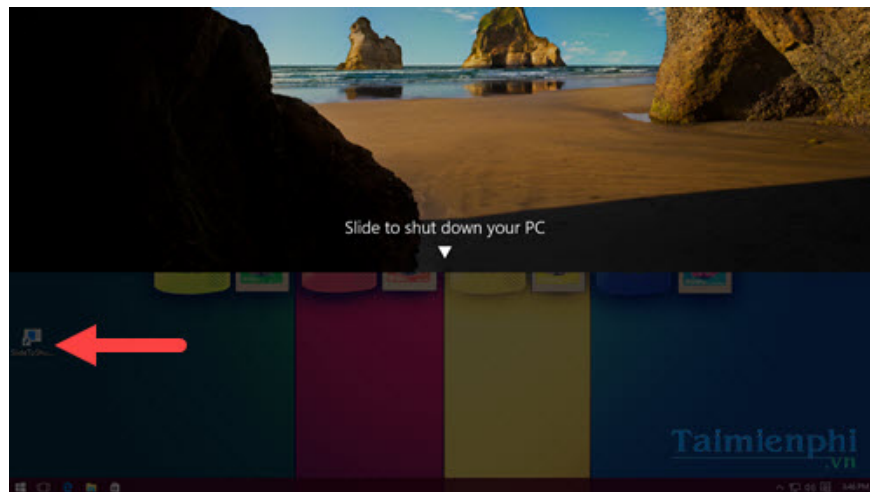
Step 2: Enter the code ' %windir%\System32\SlideToShutDown.exe ' into the empty box, then press **Next** .



Step 3: Name the newly created shortcut file and click **Finish** to complete the process.



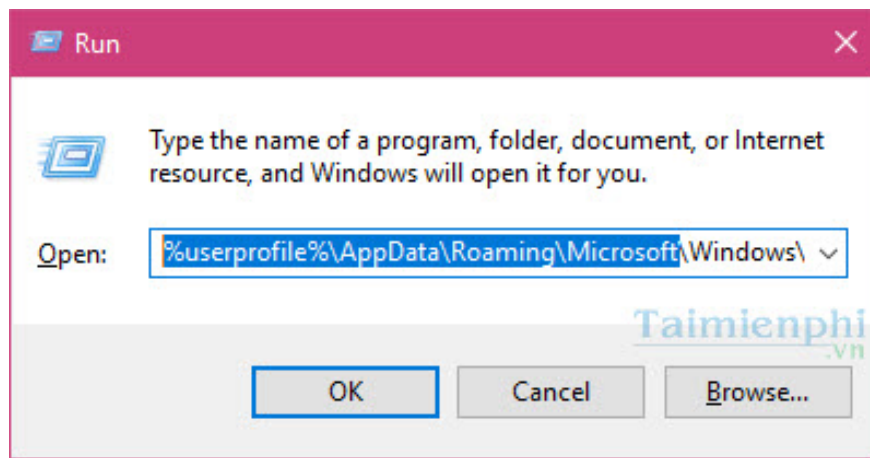
Step 4: And from now on, if you want to use the slide-to-shutdown feature, simply click on the shortcut file you just created and you're done.



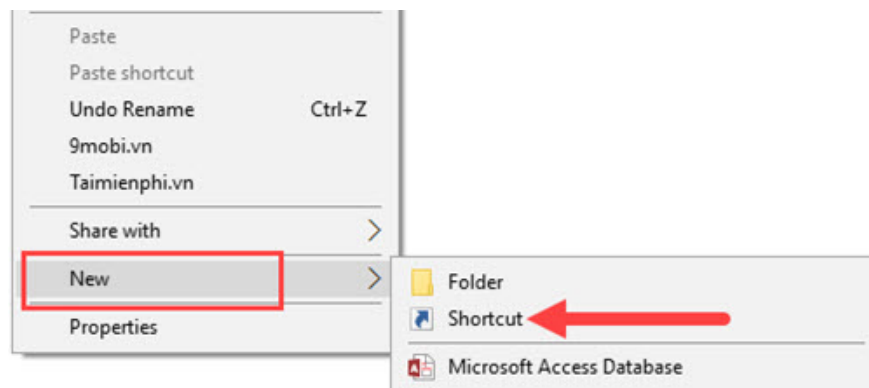
6. Use Cortana to shut down your computer .

This is a great idea for those who frequently use Cortana to shut down their devices.

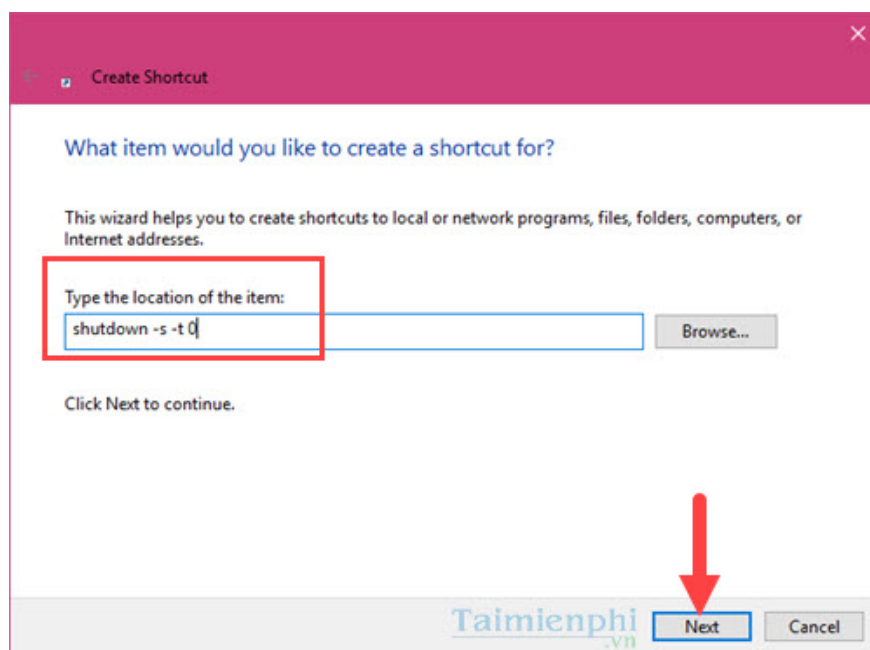
Step 1: To do this, first press the Windows + R key combination and enter the following code: '`%userprofile%\AppData\Roaming\Microsoft\Windows\Start Menu\Programs`'



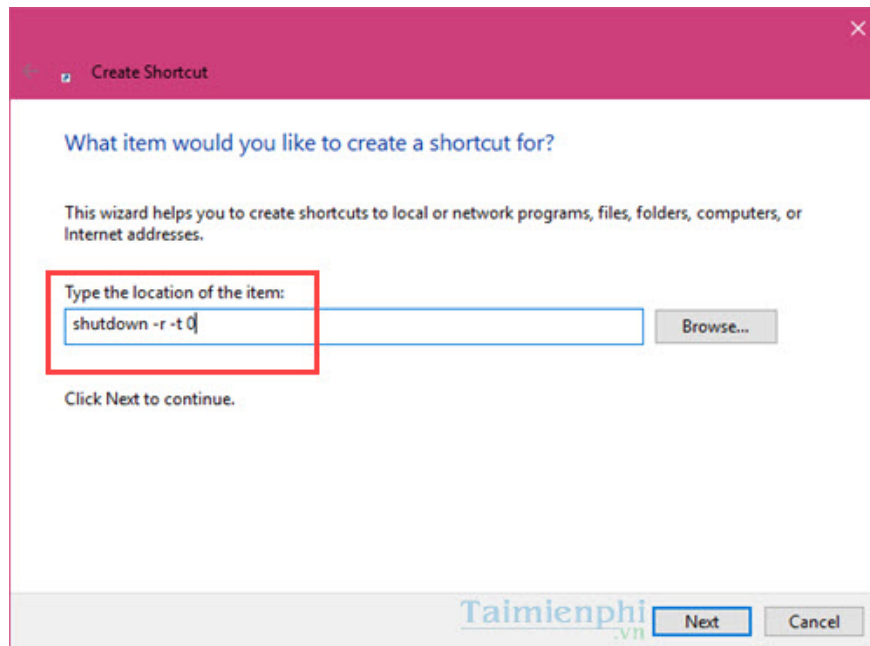
Step 2: In the Programs section, create new shortcuts as instructed above for Shutdown and Restart if you want a faster startup.



To shut down your computer, type ``shutdown -s -t 0`` to turn it off immediately.



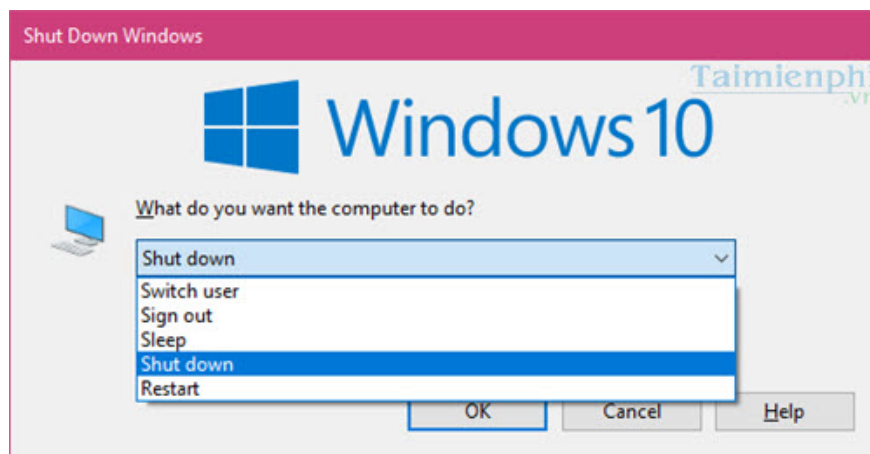
To restart your computer, type ``shutdown -r -t 0``.



Once you've completed the steps above, from now on you just need to say 'hey Cortana' to open the app and then say 'shutdown' or 'restart'.

7. Shut down the computer via the Windows Toolbox .

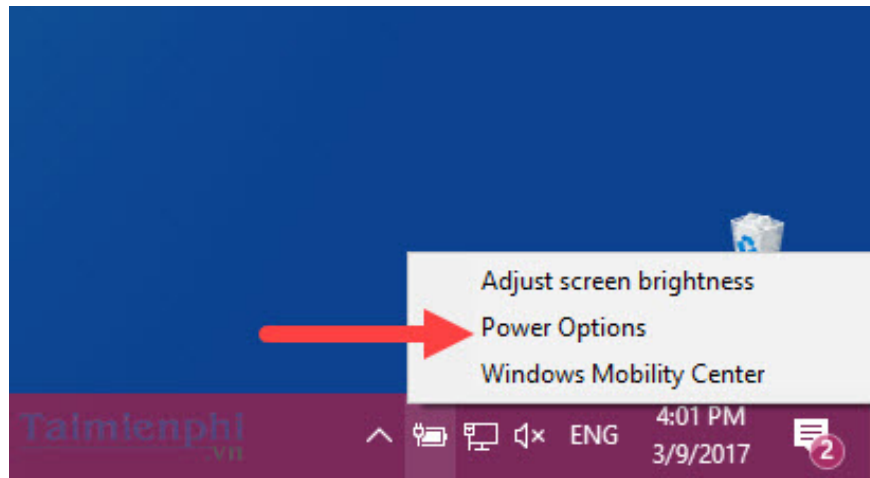
This feature has been around for a long time; it's very simple: just point to the screen, press **Alt + F4** , and then select the shutdown option.



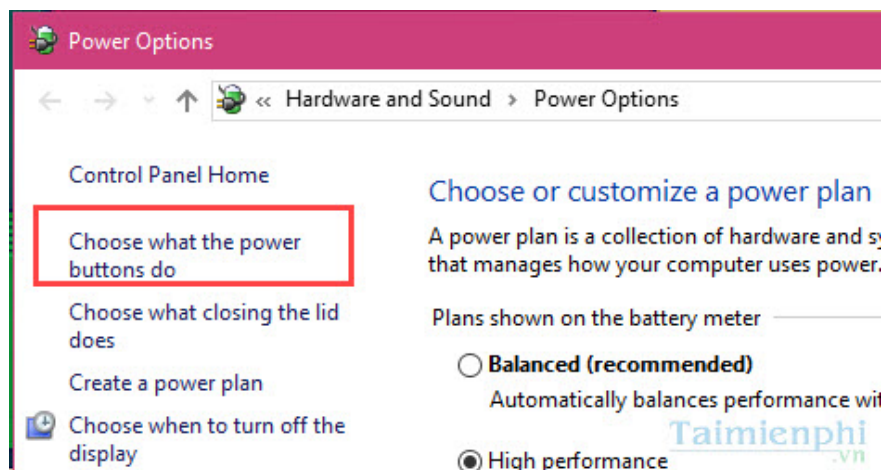
8. Set up a physical Power button for quick computer shutdown .

One of the unexpected and useful features that Windows 10 can offer.

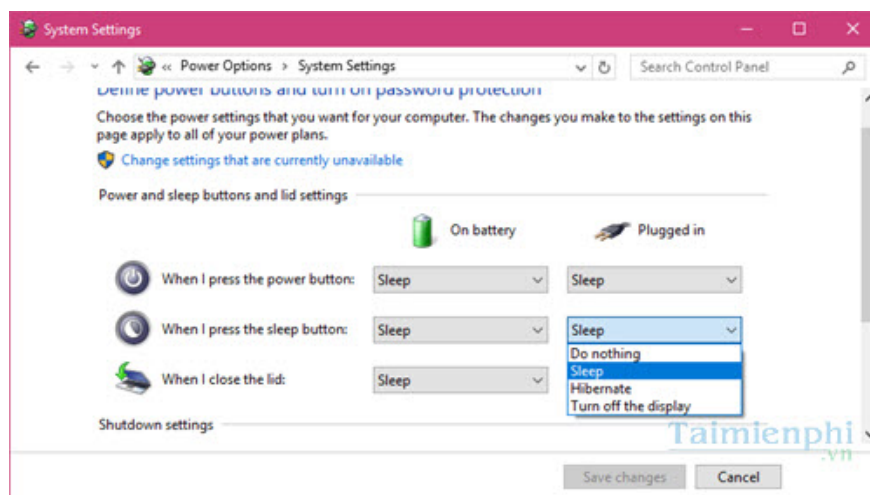
Step 1: First, look at the **Taskbar** and click on the battery icon, then select **Power Options** . If you're on a PC, you can open **the Start Menu** and search for it directly.



Step 2: In the Power Options section, select **Choose what the power buttons do** .



Step 3: Here you can choose the "**When I press the power button**" option depending on the task you want to perform. If you want to shut down the computer, select "shutdown" and then "Save changes".
