On social networking sites such as Facebook, Muare, . consumers can catch a series of online stores with monumental and aggressive advertising on Japanese electronics such as air conditioners, washing machines, pots Electric rice, fridge, fan, microwave oven, oven . are sold at great prices. Used household goods are favored by many customers because there are many new 'items' of 80-98% but the prices are only 15- 40% of the new products' value.



For the reason that Japanese household electrical appliances are priced quite high, products cost up to several tens of millions of dong. For example, Zojirushi water kettle costs VND 5 million, Tiger 6.5 million rice cooker, from VND 20 - 35 million from Hitachi . makes consumers tend to buy old domestic goods even though the

price of old Japanese goods is equivalent. New items in Vietnam with other joint ventures.

According to the survey, with old Japanese domestic goods, with the amount of 300,000-600,000 VND, it is possible to own an old brand fan. However, to own items such as refrigerators, air conditioners, rice cookers . customers have to spend an amount of 8,000,000 - 10,000,000 VND to buy depending on the new level and brand name of the company. Even, there are many products customers have to spend from 18,000,000 to 30,000,000 to get products.



Although it is known that Japanese goods have a reputation for durability, but for the money, do used products be as good as their prices?

Besides the price, when using domestic Japanese goods is not easy. Maybe for example a Japanese high-frequency rice cooker, this is a Japanese domestic product, of course it will be Japanese when used will have a lot of trouble on the pot mode because how do you understand? all they write on it. If you still accept the use, there is no way, you can search on google translate or the seller will give you a basic Vietnamese guide for easy use. However, it is only a solution, sometimes with special functions, if there is no certain Japanese capital, it is difficult to use.



When it comes to the origin of these items, you will probably be surprised and will review the decision before buying old goods. These items are actually just your country's crushed goods, then purchased and packed into a container, smuggled back to Vietnam. When the goods arrive at the gathering place, small businesses will pay for and choose for themselves the items that can be recycled for reuse, brought back to the refurbished, polished, and will be sold again. When they sell, of course they will use fine words, good warranty policies so that users can drag and drop to buy that old item to use.



As for items that cannot be reused, it will certainly be dumped in the landfill, and Vietnam today is becoming the world's largest 'technology dump'.

If you prefer to use Japanese goods and intend to buy these old electronic goods, you should keep in mind the following:

1. Refer carefully to how new items are priced? Is it really too expensive? Why are you willing to buy a 15-20tr phone and use it for 1 year, but can't buy a new refrigerator for 15-20tr and use it for 10 years - 20 years, but have to buy old high-priced items? Do not say because there is no money, no conditions!
2. Don't believe the seller's words completely, their ultimate goal is to make you buy, they say it's cheap, it's not really cheap, they say it's not good.
3. If the value of a large item (eg 10tr or more) I recommend that you consider new items, even if there are fewer functions, it is still new, and new things are always better than the old ones.
4. There are some things even if you buy new ones in Vietnam cheaper than Japanese old ones, I'm sure of that.



Today with the development of science and technology. So there will be many new products coming out, you can find them for yourself. Having gone through the time of being sure to wear durable, this time to eat well, then you can follow the trend of the world. Utensils have a short lifespan for economic development, encourage consumption, now they produce 1 dish to use durable for 20-30 years to sell new things to whom?
