Latest missing case at Bermuda triangle triangle

On May 15, 2017, four Americans were mysteriously missing on a civilian plane after flying over the Bermuda triangle. Miami air traffic has been disconnected via radar with a twin-engine MU-2B when flying from Puerto Rico to Titusville, Northeast Florida.



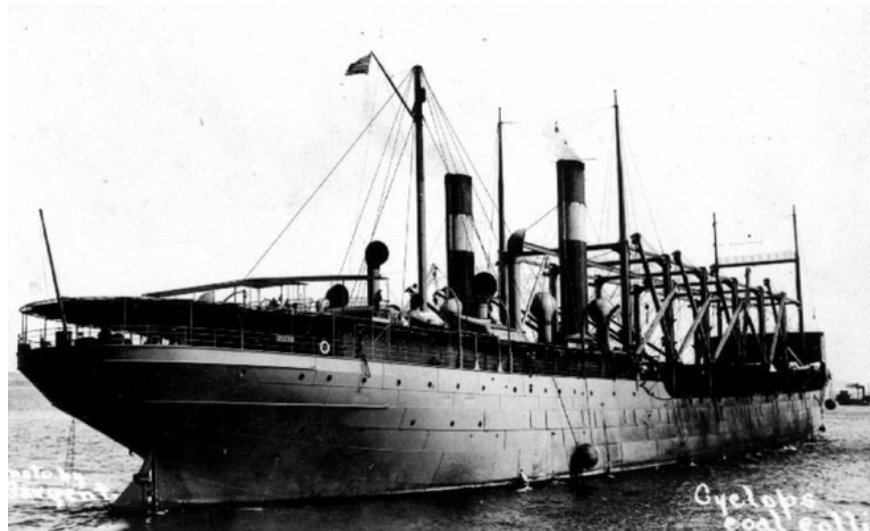
At that time, the plane was 60 km away from Eleuthera Island, Bahamas and at 7,300m above sea level. Driving an airplane is an experienced pilot, accompanied by a businesswoman and two small children.

Marine search and rescue forces are trying to find survivors. At 3:30 pm on May 16, a fragment was suspected of being MU-2B and a spill of oil was discovered near the Bahamas. So far, there has been no further information about this mysterious disappearance.

Historically, there have been many mysterious disappearances like this happening in the Bermuda triangle. According to statistics, there are more than 100 aircraft, all kinds of boats mysteriously disappeared after passing through this area.

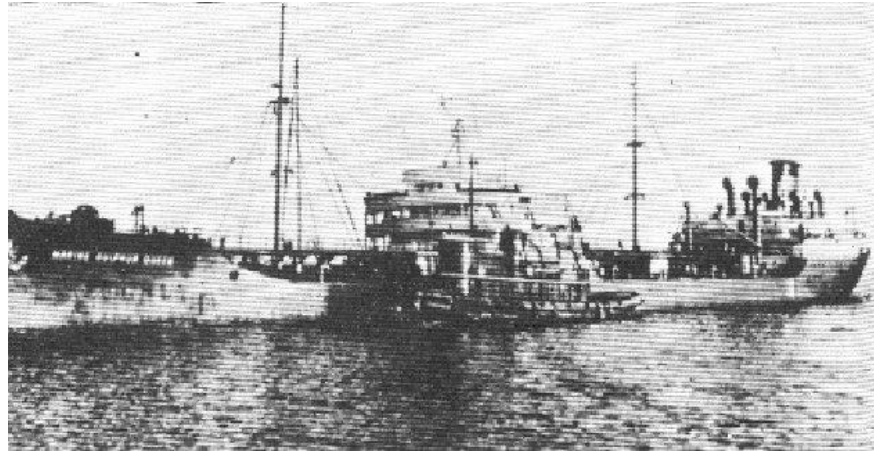
1. USS Cyclops



In 1918, the giant transport ship USS Cyclops was dispatched to Brazil to fuel British warships in the South Atlantic region.

The giant battleship is fully equipped with a radio transceiver system, more than 165m long, with 309 sailors and 10,000 tons of manganese ore, suddenly disappeared completely when crossing Bermuda waters. There is not even any emergency signal sent. All rescue work at that time had no results.

2. SS Marine Sulfur Queen



In 1963, SS Marine Sulfur Queen a ship carrying more than 15,000 tons of liquid sulfur and 39 sailors disappeared while traveling in the western area of Key West, in addition to the Bermuda triangle.

The ship is 100 meters long, 30 meters wide and 30 meters high, so it disappears in a strange way, leaving no trace. A 350,000-square-mile, six-day search was opened to search for the ship's whereabouts but with no results.

3. "Flight 19"



At the end of 1945, the 19-US Navy squadron consisted of five bombers that had mysteriously disappeared while training in the Atlantic sky.

Before his disappearance, Lieutenant Charles Taylor - the flight commander sent a very weak signal of the base to report strange phenomena like the compass turning unidentified, the appearance of "white water" - Some substances rise through the gap in the ocean floor, especially unusually high sulfur concentrations .

During the search, a 13-person rescue plane also exploded shortly after take-off 23 minutes.

In 1991, while searching for a gold-waiting ship near Phort-Loderdeila northeastern sea, the "Dip Sip" ship accidentally discovered the bodies of five aircraft. But strangely, four of them lined up straight at a depth of 250 meters, the other one was 1 nautical mile away.

4. The Mary Celeste ship mysteriously



In early November 1872, a merchant ship named Mary Celeste left the station from Genoa to begin her journey. Nearly a month later, the ship Mary Celeste caught sight of the sea in the middle of Portugal with the Azores Islands.

Upon examination, it was found that Mary Celeste was only slightly inundated with water but still in very good condition, without any damage. Food, water and goods are still intact and sufficient for 6 months but strangely there are no signs of humanity. Most papers, navigation devices and rescue drops are missing!

Why did all the crew disappear when the ship was still healed, not spoiled and where did they go to the rescue boat?

5. Star Tiger and Douglas DC-3 aircraft



In 1948, there were two missing unmarked planes believed to be related to Bermuda's dead sea. One was a British Star Tiger aircraft with 25 passengers on a flight from Santa Maria in the Azores to Bermuda, the other was a 36-man DC-3 plane on the way from Puerto Rico to Miami. Both planes disappeared without a trace to this day.

6. Flight 441



On October 30, 1954, Flight 441 aircraft departed from Patuxent River Naval Air Station air base to Portugal with 45 passengers and pilots. At about 11 noon, the aircraft signaled its current location, about 600km from the coast. After that, it simply disappeared completely without leaving any trace.
