

A series of Windows 11 users have black screen errors - Black Screen of Death

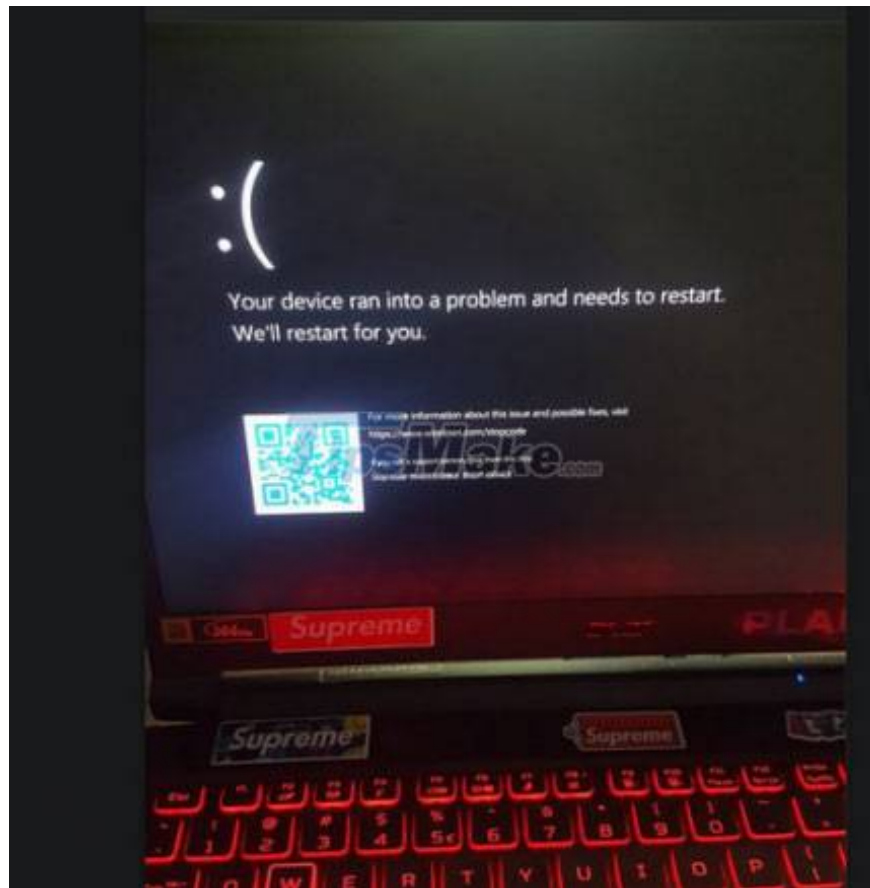
Many Windows 11 users around the world, including Vietnam, have encountered a black screen error - Black Screen of Death after updating to Build 22000.282.

A few days ago, Microsoft released Windows 11 update KB5006746 (**Build 22000.282**) to fix various bugs such as resolving File Explorer errors, solving the problem of AMD CPUs being severely affected by increasing the latency of 3 times more L3 Cache memory.

Immediately after this update was released, many Windows 11 users immediately updated in the hope that it would make their PCs and laptops smoother.

However, many Windows 11 users around the world, including Vietnam, have encountered a black screen error - Black Screen of Death after updating to *Build 22000.282*. Some users even reflected that their device could not be restarted after many times of black screen errors.

Some users have tried to fix this situation by Auto Repair many times, Recover system, even tried to interfere with hardware such as removing the CMOS Battery and removing the SSD containing Windows 11 instead of the HDD containing Windows 10, but it did not work. .



To handle the black screen error - Black Screen of Death on Windows 11, users are forced to reinstall the entire Windows 11.

Currently, Microsoft has not yet made any comment on this matter.

To avoid unexpected errors, you should not update to **Build 22000.282** on Windows 11.
