Floating Camera button - Features that make shooting more convenient on Samsung

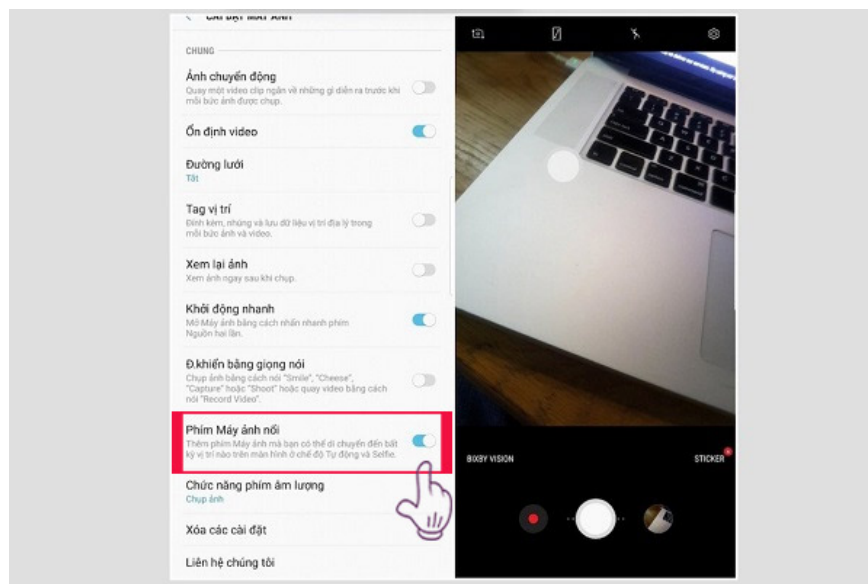
Currently, Samsung phones are gradually following the trend of screen overflow with 18: 5: 9 ratio. With such a long and large screen will help users get the best experience when using, especially playing games, watching videos. However, it is this design that makes you feel very difficult to manipulate the shutter button when taking photos.

And to overcome this problem, manufacturers have integrated the Floating Camera button feature in the camera section. This is a feature that lets you add an extra button to move around the screen, you can put it in any position that fits your hand best, and then press shooting at any angle without worrying about being entangled.



How to activate the Floating Camera button on Samsung phones

To activate the Floating Camera button, simply go to *Camera settings* (gear icon in the right corner) and pull down the *Floating Camera button* to finish.



Successfully turned on, you will return to the shooting interface, then you will see a camera button on the camera screen to move anywhere you want.

If you do not want to use the secondary shutter button, go back to the *Settings* section above to turn it off. Or press and hold down the capture button until the minus sign (-) appears, then click to delete successfully.

Note:

If you can't find the Floating Camera button, it may be because your device doesn't support this feature yet. Reportedly, the feature to help take more photos on only available on Samsung's super products launched from 2017 onwards like Galaxy A 2017, S8 / S8 Plus, Note 8, S9 / S9 Plus.

With this tip, I hope to help you take photos on your Samsung phone more conveniently, catch every moment quickly and get really sparkling photos. In addition, if you feel troublesome with the sound of "splitting" generated every time you take a picture on your Samsung phone, you can immediately refer to two ways to turn off the sound when taking photos on Samsung that Network Administrator previously shared.
