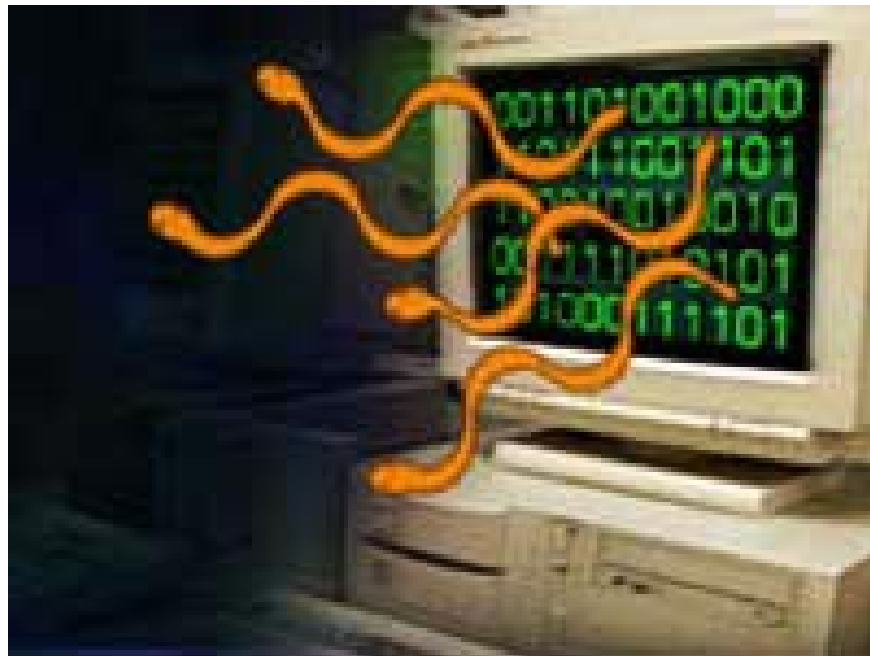
Hackers have just launched a 'talking' trojan that can give users a sarcastic voice when it successfully infects their PC.

Using the BotVoice-A operating system's Windows Text Reader feature informs users that the PC has been infected with malicious code and it is starting to delete files on their system.

(Your PC has been infected with malware. I repeat once again that your PC has been infected with malicious code. The file system has been deleted. Sorry. Good day. Goodbye.



Security software Panda Software said the voice will be constantly released when the trojan in turn erases the data stored on the hard drive. Its goal is to erase all data on the infected hard disk, mainly BAT, EXE and MP3 files.

Although only a small part of the file can be deleted, the trojan is still capable of causing the Windows operating system to become unstable. BotVoice-A also changes the Windows Registry parameters, causing some

applications to be completely disabled. Among those applications that are disabled include the Windows Registry Editor, Task Manager.

BotVoice-A Trojan is infected by the way of exploiting the operating system's security vulnerability when users access a malicious website or via P2P peer-to-peer file sharing network, attached with email and device. storage . User interaction is required to successfully break into.
