

## **A woman's body was exhumed from a thousand-year-old blood coffin leaking thick black water, experts were shocked: Evacuate immediately**

The owner of the thousand-year-old blood coffin excavated in Inner Mongolia in 2003 is Princess Yulu Jiangu, sister of Yelu Abaoji of the Khitan ethnic group.

In 2003, a group of workers accidentally blew up an ancient tomb while mining in Inner Mongolia. Because there were special patterns painted on the rock, they immediately reported it to the relevant units.

Experts speculate that the princess may have died from drinking poisonous wine containing mercury and that she was only about 30 years old when she died.
