According to *Engadget* , **Acer C720P** uses an 11.6-inch touch screen that achieves a resolution of 1,366 x 768 pixels (*HD standard*), which is essentially an improved version from the cheap **Acer C720** version announced by the company in January. 10 past.

Regarding configuration, Acer C720P is equipped with Intel Celeron 2955U processor (*based on Haswell architecture*), 2GB RAM, 32GB SSD drive (*higher than 16GB SSD on Acer C720*) . The battery life of the device is about 7.5 hours.

Acer said it will be available in December with a retail price of around \$ 299. When buying a device, users are also given a 100 GB storage account at Google Drive service for 2 years.

Reportedly, Chrome OS is an operating system built from the Chromium open source platform based on web and cloud computing.
