Acer's Chromebook uses a strong Core i chip instead of the Celeron chip commonly found on Chromebooks today.

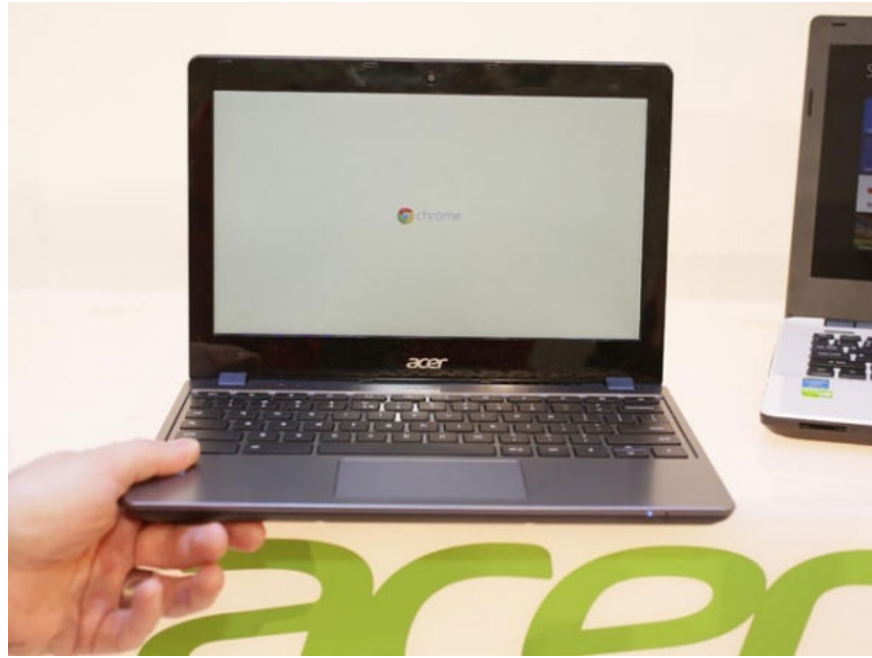
**Acer's Chromebook uses a strong Core i chip instead of the Celeron chip commonly found on Chromebooks today.**

Currently Acer has not announced much information about the product, only know that it will have an 11-inch version and more likely to sell in the summer. The company will then release models with larger screens. It will be similar in design to Acer's current Chromebook, the Chromebook C720p. The China Times page said the price of the product will fall to about \$ 349.
