

# Acer launched two new high-strength Chromebooks for students

Acer has just introduced two new Chromebook computers ( *running on Chrome OS* ) code-named C740 and C910. Both use high-strength SSD drives, many configurations and will be sold in the US in February this year, prices for the C740 and C910 are \$ 260 and \$ 300 respectively.



## *C740 Chromebook*

C740 Chromebook has an 11.6-inch screen with a resolution of 1366 x 768 pixels, a 16 GB SSD drive, an 8.5-hour battery, 2 GB RAM or 4 GB and optional Celeron or Core i3 CPU. And the C910 Chromebook has a higher configuration including a 15.6-inch screen with Full-HD resolution or 1366 x 768, the same CPU option as above, by default with 4 GB of RAM and a storage drive of 16 GB or 32 GB.

Speaking of impact resistance, both are designed to withstand the pressure equivalent to 60 kg on the surface of a laptop, the angles are still able to withstand the impact of falling from near height. half a meter and hinges are

also reinforced to make it harder to break.
