

Activate 2-layer verification to secure your Apple ID account

To protect users from hacker attacks, Apple has integrated 2-layer security on its devices. Both 2-layer verification security and 2-step verification security are available for Apple ID users. However, the 2-layer verification security feature and 2-step verification security feature are slightly different.

However, the 2-layer verification security feature and the 2-step verification security feature are slightly different but not as many people believe it to be a common feature. In the article below Network Administrator will explain to you how 2-step verification and 2-layer authentication and how to enable 2-layer authentication for your Apple ID account.



1. Apple ID account security: 2-layer authentication

Apple has provided 2-layer authentication for Apple ID users since 2013, and this is the first solution users can use to protect themselves from hackers accessing content in the case if the hacker knows. get Apple ID password.

Apple ID users will be notified to authenticate their account in 2 steps each time they log in with their Apple ID account or iCloud account, or when they buy anything on their new iOS device.

Also in some other cases, users will be prompted to verify the login, and you can find these options on Apple's support homepage.

But how do I verify my account? There are 4 different options below that you can choose from:

- **Send notifications to a trusted iOS device** : Check login by allowing notifications to be sent on another iOS device.
- **Text message or voice call to the phone number you register** : Apple can text you a message including a 4-digit login verification code. In addition, Apple can call and give you the authentication code on your phone.
- **Recovery Key Offline** : You will receive a 14-Character Recovery Key to set up 2-layer authentication. This Recovery Key can be used to access in case if you lose access to your trusted device, or forget the Apple ID password.
- **Specific application password** : If the application you are using does not support two-step verification, you can create a specific application password from your Apple ID account pages to use when notified .

How to authenticate 2 Apple ID account elements?

2-layer authentication for Apple ID accounts is quite simple. Just click on the link here, log in to your Apple ID account and follow the instructions on the screen.

Note that this method is only for users who do not have access to Apple devices, cannot set up the device for some reason or cannot access 2-step verification.

2. Apple ID account security: 2-step verification

What exactly is 2-layer authentication, and why is this method better than the 2-step verification method? Apple considers the 2-layer authentication method to be a higher step than 2-step verification, and the 2-layer authentication feature was first released in 2015 on iOS 9 devices.

This new security feature is directly integrated on iOS 9 and X EI Capitan OS and higher versions. This means that users using older devices cannot use this feature.

What makes the 2-layer authentication feature so special? The other two-layer authentication method with 2-step verification, users can use the following options:

- **Send notifications to a trusted device** : Like the old methods, Apple will send an interactive notification to all trusted Apple devices, allowing users to quickly verify the posting. enter her.
- **Text message or voice call that you register** : This method is similar to Apple's old 2-step verification method. Apple will text or make a voice call for you to send a 4-digit verification code.
- **Hidden code generated by reliable devices** : This is a specific method for 2-layer authentication, and allows activation of code on a trusted device, even when Offline. Simply visit the **Settings Menu** on your trusted device and make a note for the generated code.

Like the above three methods, Apple also provides a method to verify login information on Apple devices running iOS 8 and X Yosemite OS or older versions.

When trying to log in to an Apple ID or iCloud account on an unsupported device, you will receive a verification mode from a trusted device to add the Apple ID account password to the end. me

For example, if your Apple ID password is 'password'. And the code generated by your trusted device is 1234, you enter Matkhau1234 as your Apple ID account password.
