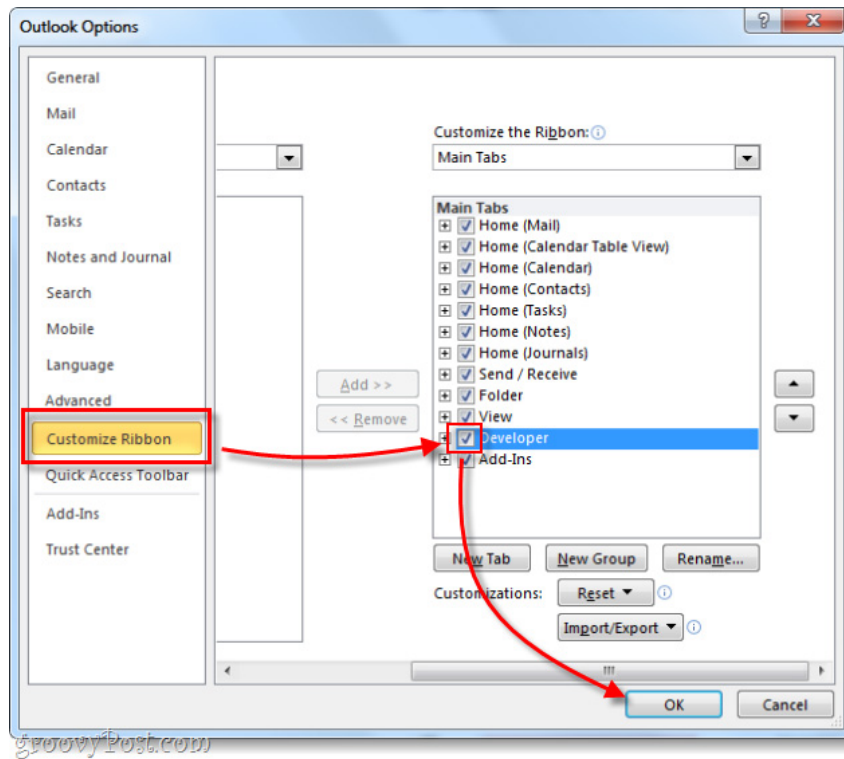
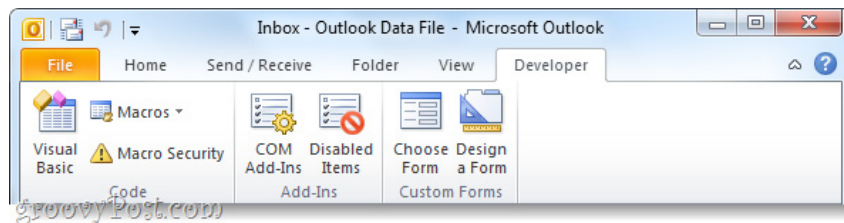


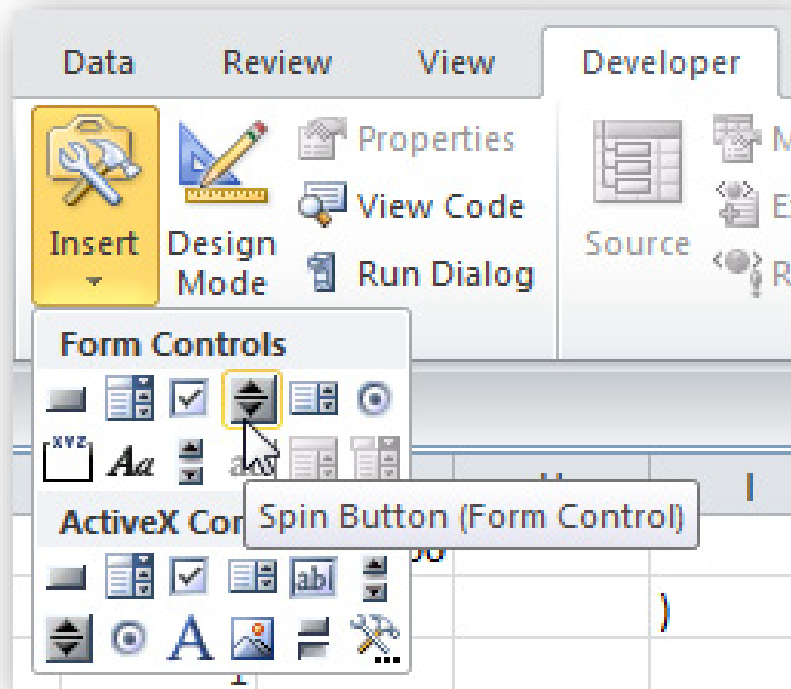
Options window displays, select **Customize Ribbon** and then tick the **Developer** box below the **Main Tabs** section. Click **OK** to save the changes:

Here, you click **Insert> Spin Button**:

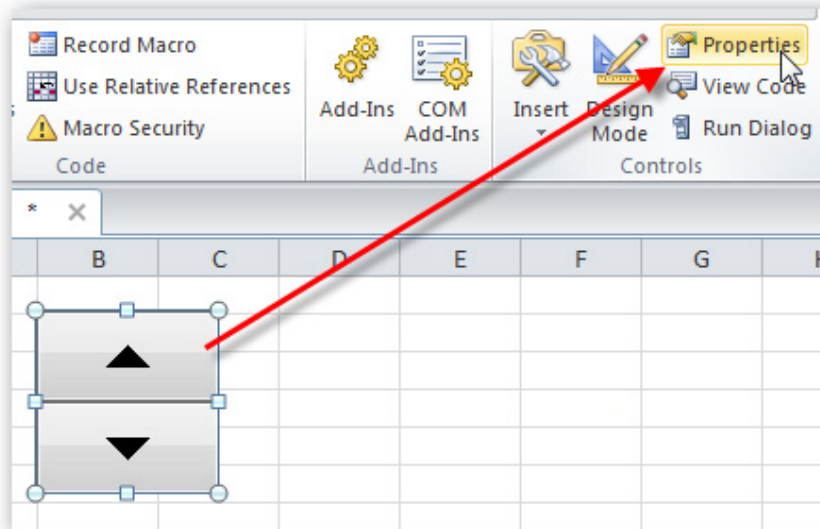


Next, select the data line to set these buttons:

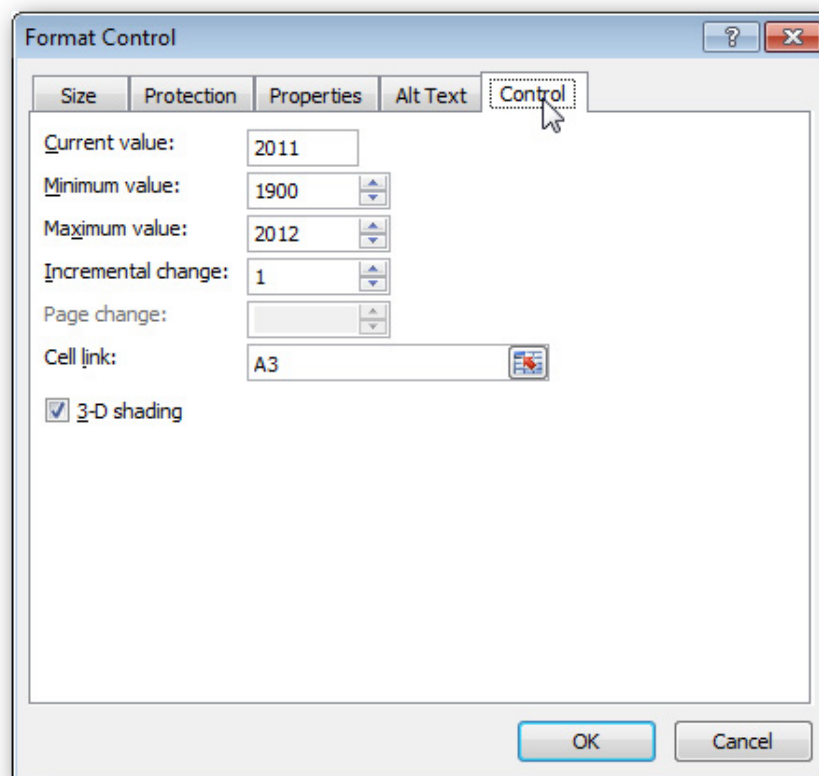
