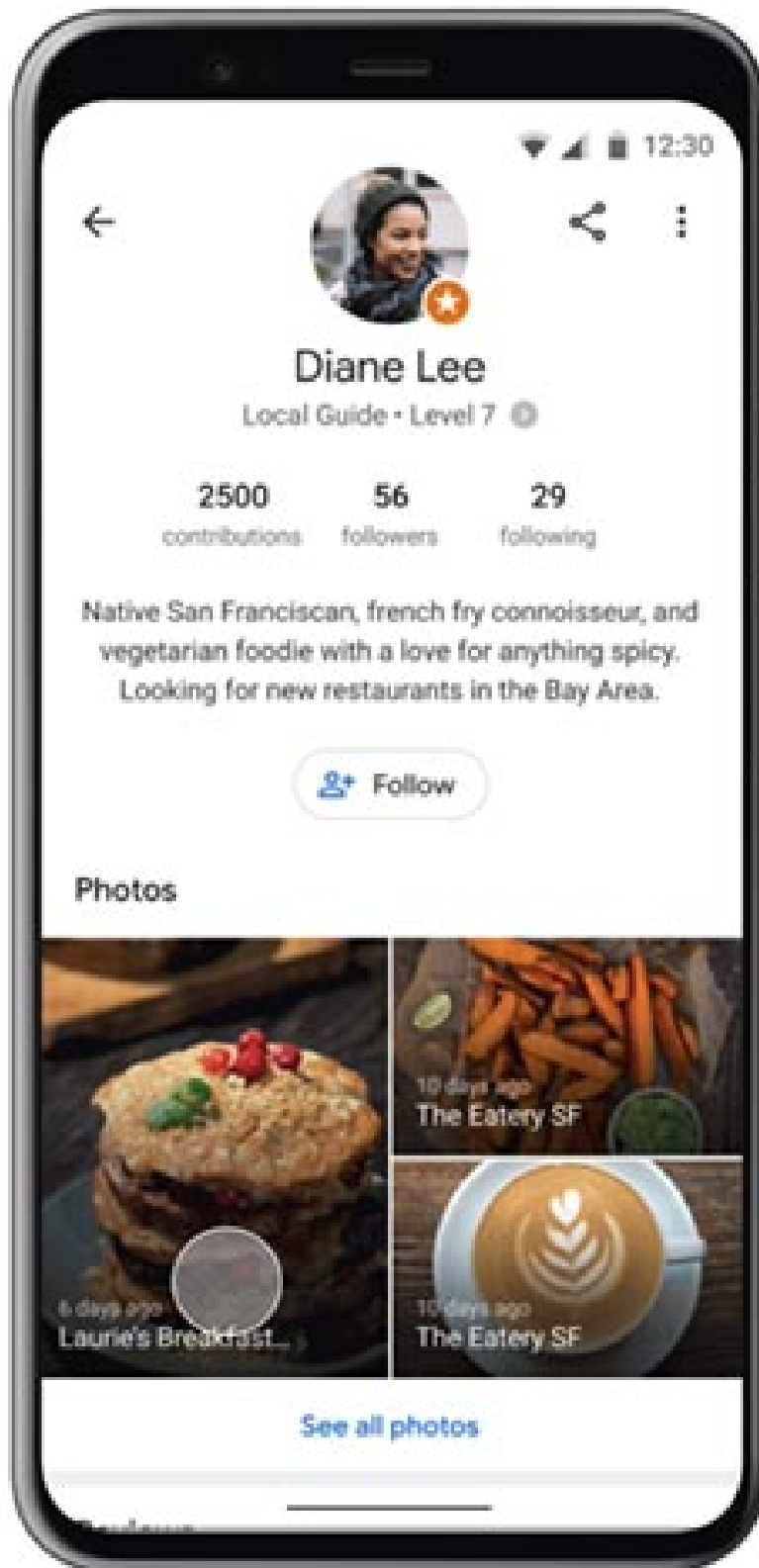


# Adding new features, Google Maps is gradually becoming a social network?
