

Additional features for Microsoft Word with 3 useful add-ins

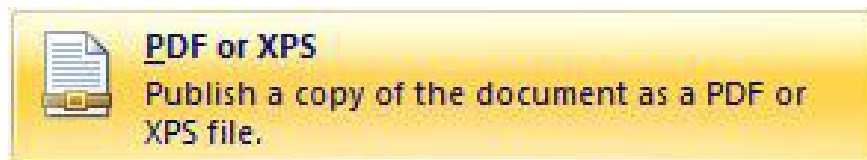
Although there are many applications for both Offline and Online for the office in editing Word documents, the current reality is that Microsoft Word is still the number one choice.

Microsoft Word is not out of the box, and here are three useful plug-ins for this editor.

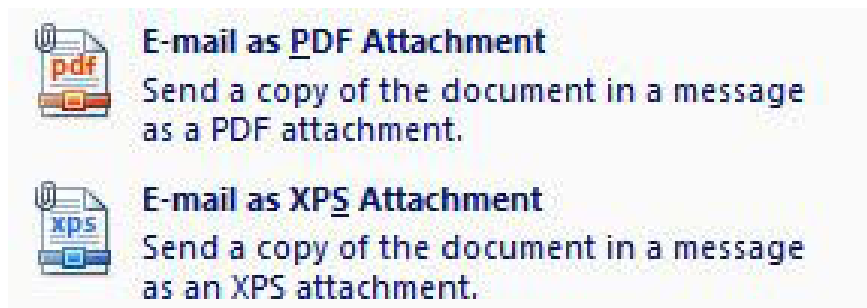
Save PDF or XPS file in Office 2007

Microsoft has introduced a free Save-PDF or XPS plug-in, which adds the feature to save documents in PDF format right inside the Save as menu, combined with XPS (an active format). same as Microsoft-owned PDF).
