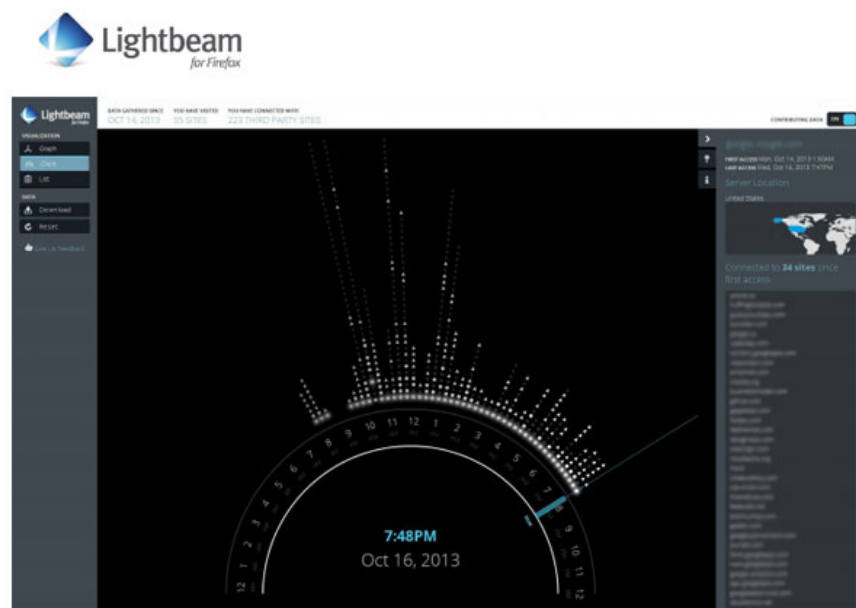


# Add-on in Firefox helps users avoid scouting
