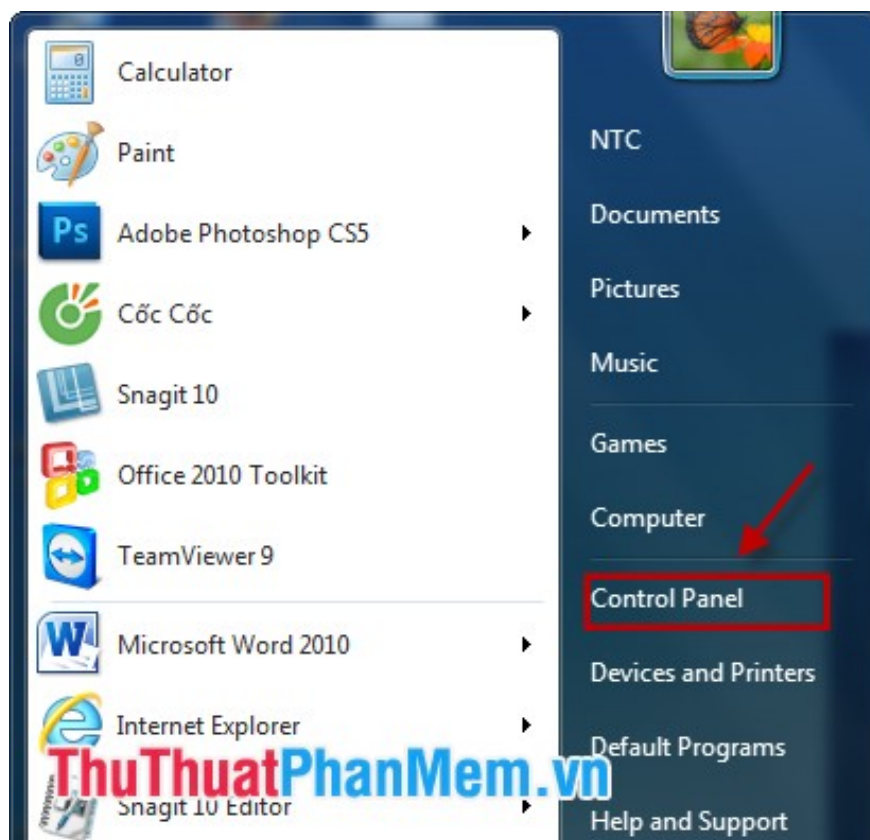

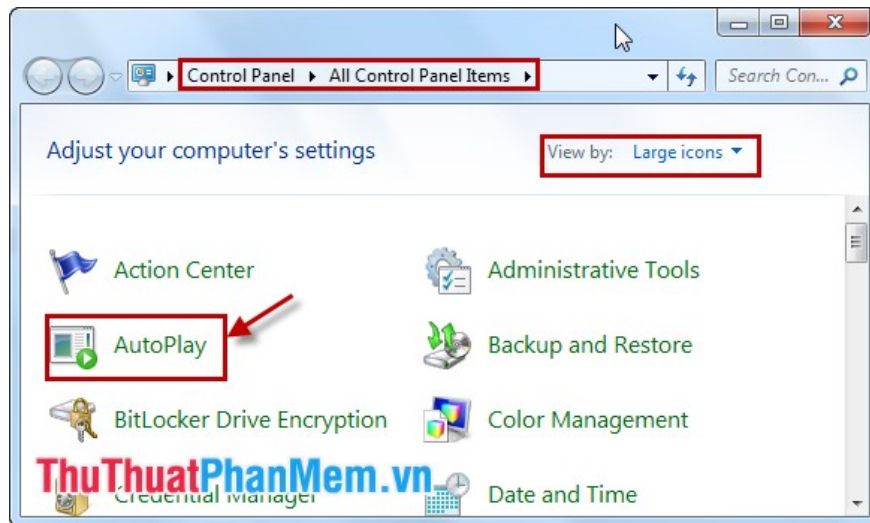
To change the default values ??for AutoPlay as you like. Follow the article below to learn how to adjust the AutoPlay option in Windows 7.

**Step 1:** Open the Autoplay window.

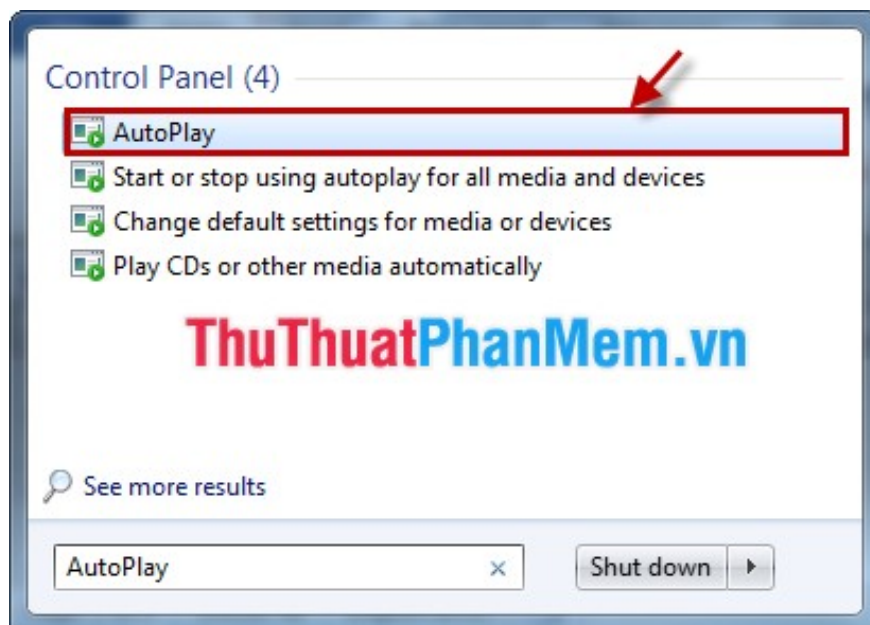
- Go to Start -> Control Panel .



In Control Panel -> Autoplay .

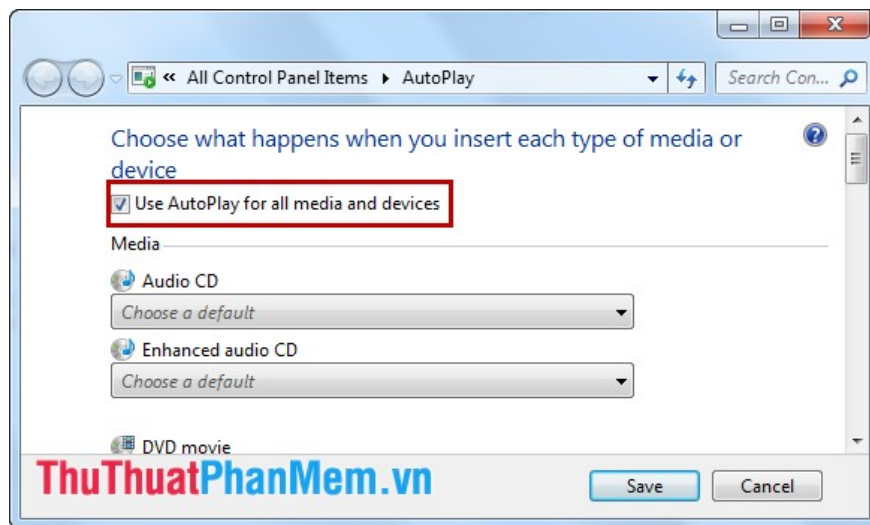


- Or select **Start** , in the *Search programs and files box*, type the keyword *AutoPlay* and select **AutoPlay** .



**Step 2:** Adjust the options in the AutoPlay window.

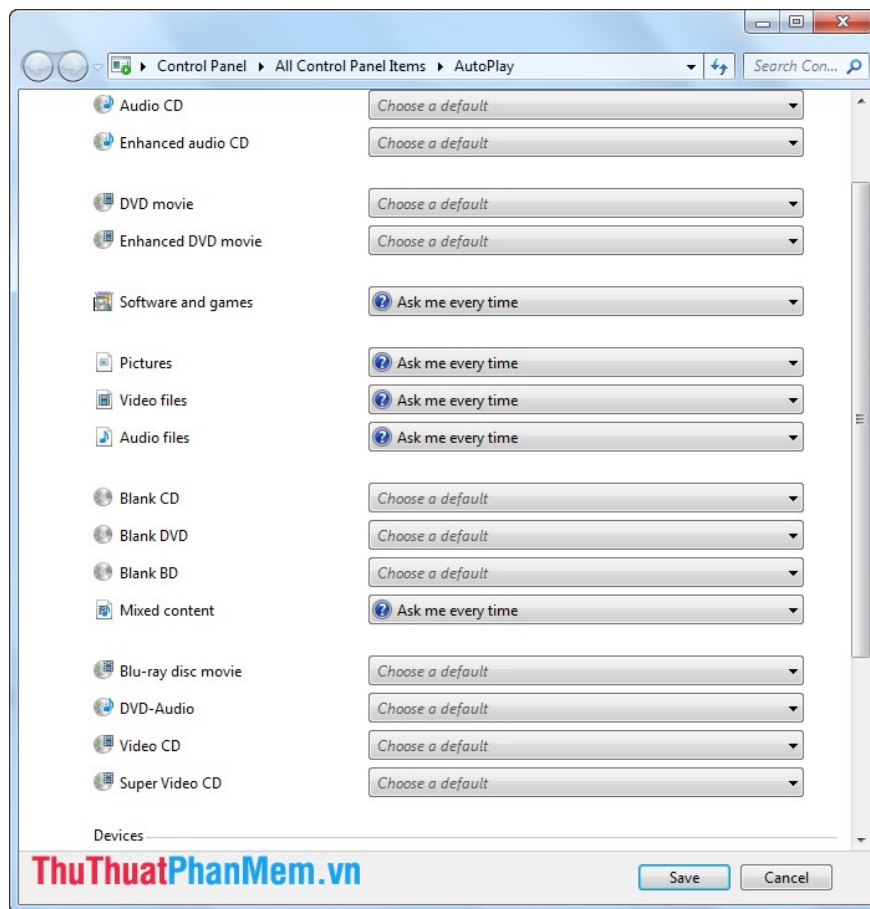
- To use the AutoPlay feature for all devices when connecting to the computer, you need to tick the box *Use AutoPlay for all media and devices* .



- For each type of private media and devices, you select the option on the right of it will drop down list for you to choose to suit your needs.

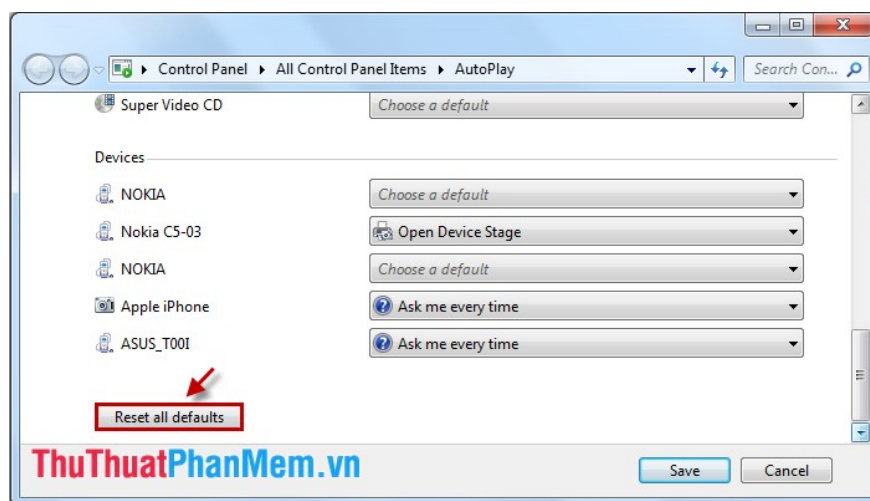


- There are many media and devices connected to the computer for you to customize **Autoplay** .
