1. Palau

The Republic of Palau is a beautiful island nation in the Western Pacific, comprising more than 300 large and small islands forming the western island chain of the Caroline Islands in Micronesia. Palau is almost covered by many vast tropical rain forests and countless species of particular creatures. In particular, it is home to more than 130 rare shark species and about 2 million types of jellyfish that live in the famous scenic spot called " *Lake Jellyfish* ".

With an area of 459km², the Palau republic is home to 21,347 inhabitants. In addition, tourists from all over the world are exempt from 30-day tourist visa.

2. Niue

Niue is a small island nation located in the middle of Oceania. Although the scenery here is wonderful, but because there are very few tourists coming here, the country mainly maintains activities with the amount of international subsidies, mainly from New Zealand.

Niue has a total area of about 261.46km² and a total population of 1,190 people. Niue's capital is just a small village of less than 600 people. In addition, there is an airport and a single supermarket across the country.

3. Saint Kitts and Nevis

True to its name, the country consists of two archipelago named **Saint Kitts and Nevis** . Saint Kitts and Nevis' main source of state budget revenue comes from foreign investors. Anyone who spends a certain amount of money in accordance with state regulations (*at least \$ 250,000*) to invest in the sugar manufacturing industry or buy other assets will become an official citizen here. In addition, there is another way to get citizenship here is to buy a property worth about \$ 400,000 on one of the two islands.

The total area of ??Saint Kitts and Nevis is 261km² and has a population of over 52,329 people. The enchanting nature of the heart, the clear blue sky, warm sea water and white sandy beaches, all make this place the most peaceful and peaceful place in the Caribbean.

4. Hutt River Kingdom

The country is actually a province called **Hutt River** of Australia, found by Leonard Casley, who founded his own state. Although it is not officially recognized as a separate country, it also has its own coins, stamps and passports. Hutt River duchy is 75km² wide and only 30 people live. However, each year it attracts more than 40,000 tourists from all over the place.

5. Tuvalu

With an area of only 26km², there are 10,959 people living, **Tuvalu** is one of the smallest and poorest countries in the world. The economic situation of this tiny country may be even more harmful if Tuvalu is not provided with Internet domain names, which contribute millions of dollars each year to the country's budget.

Tuvalu is an archipelago consisting of many reefs and corals located in the South Pacific. Because it is only about 10cm above sea level, this country is also at risk of being wiped out from the world map due to climate change.

6. Nauru

Nauru is an island nation with an area of 21km² and the smallest island in the world. Not only that, this country has no capital or public transportation system at all. The total length of the road here is about 40.2 km and people only use their personal vehicles to travel. In addition, the environmental issues that make this island not visited by many visitors.

With a population of 9,591 people, Nauru has over 70% of the population suffering from obesity. The number of tourists coming here is very small so the economy here depends mainly on the export of fertilizers.

7. The Principality of Seborga

Seborga is actually a small village in Italian territory and is located near the border with France. This is one of the oldest self-proclaimed countries on the planet with a total area of ??only 4,91km². The whole country Seborga **only 312 people live and the military system consists of 3 people** : 1 defense minister and 2 border guards. However, until now the Italian government has not recognized its independence.

8. Molossia Republic

Molossia self-proclaimed republic is located in Nevada state, USA. The country covers an area of ??0.055km² and the head is Mr. Kevin Baugh. He came up with the idea of ??forming this country from a movie watching as a child. The strange thing is that this country consists of only one family with 7 members, 3 dogs, 1 cat and 1

rabbit. Even the Molossia republic has a national flag, its own national anthem and those who commit serious crimes will be condemned to death. In May 2017, the republic declared Molossia to turn 40.

9. Republic of Malta

In addition to the Vatican, there is another tiny country on Rome's territory, called **The Sovereign Military Order of Malta**. With an area of ??only about 0.012km² but the population reaches 113,500 people, this is one of the smallest but most populous countries in the world.

The Malta Governor's line of diplomats has diplomatic relations with about 100 countries, with many ambassadors, they have passports, monetary systems, postage stamps and their own vehicle registration plates. Citizens of this country have a right to visa exemption in some countries around the world. The line of Maltese Governor-General is the only country in the world, where Latin is the official language.

10. The Sealand duchy

Sealand is famous for being the smallest country in the world. If you look over, you will think that this country is an ancient fortress or oil rig. The area of this country is only about 0,00055km², located in the English Channel, about 10km from Suffolk coast and usually only no more than 5 people live here.

Sealand is a super small country but soon has its own flag, its own court, its own money and even its own stamp. Although declared independent, Sealand was not recognized by the United Nations as a nation.
