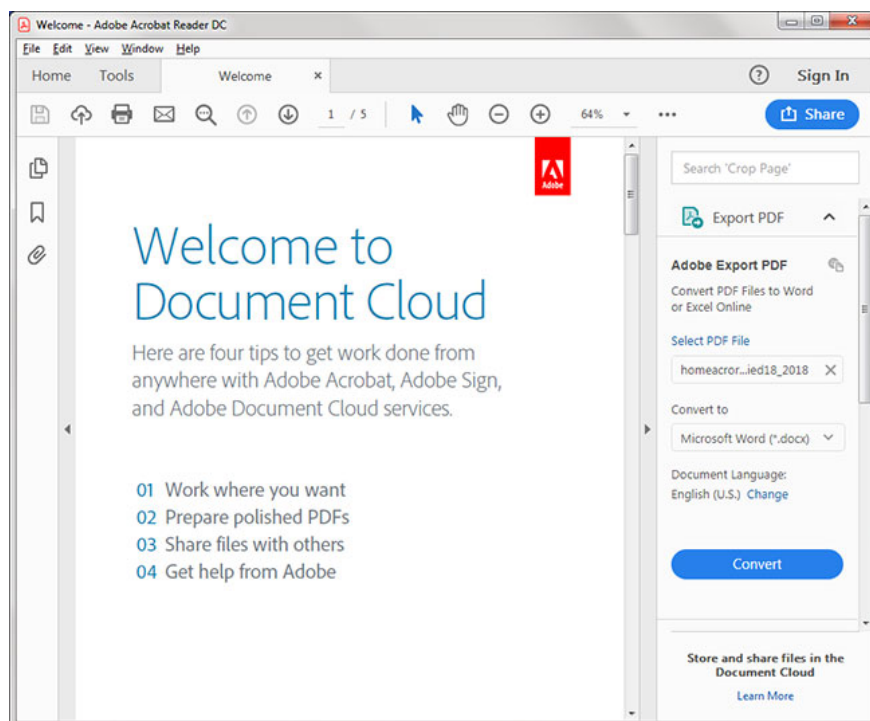

What is Adobe Acrobat Reader DC?

Adobe Acrobat Reader DC is a way to enjoy PDF access anytime, anywhere. This program is a virtual office for busy people on the go. The Windows program gives you complete control over viewing and editing a variety of PDFs, as well as other files. You can share, comment, edit and export PDF files, and organize your files with colorful sticky notes or highlights.

This program is a cloud-based PDF reader and editor. Create your own PDF from a Microsoft Office document or a web page, use autofill to sign multiple agreements and important documents.

You can upgrade to Adobe Acrobat Professional DC to export, convert or share PDF files.



Features of Adobe Reader for Windows

This program has many features and acts as a virtual office space to manage and create PDF files. However, for uncontrolled access to a comprehensive feature library, you'll need to upgrade to the Pro program.

Once you've taken some time to navigate the site, you'll find a bunch of useful features at hand. Activate the menu on the left side for full access to the feature-rich program.

Open the fill and sign tool for working with bulk contracts. Upgrade to Pro version to export and edit existing PDF files or create your own from scratch. A drop-down menu explains how to use each tool.

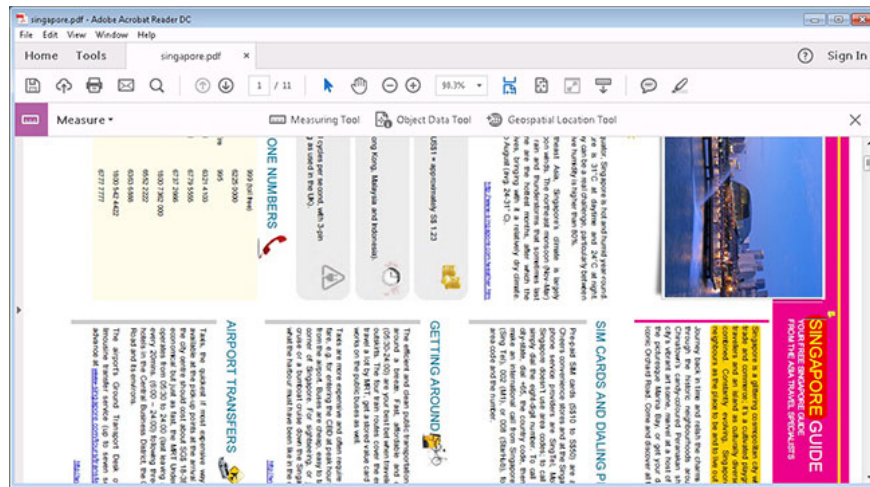
Adobe Acrobat Reader is an essential tool for working with PDFs. You can not only read files (in 3 different modes depending on your requirements) with premium version, but also easily convert them to Microsoft Word or Excel, sign them, share notes, and edit and organize all your files from one interface.

Is Adobe Reader just a PDF reader?

This program does not just have PDF functions. Through Adobe, you can also add 'stamps' to your PDF files. Digital version of rubber stamp on paper document, this tool lets you choose from a panel of options or create your own custom stamp. A useful way to certify documents.

You can also add digital certificates to your PDF files and customize the encryption to ensure only the intended recipient can read the file.

The application is packed with handy features to make viewing easier: Not only can you enlarge detailed PDFs, you can also rotate pages, switch to night-reading mode and take snapshots of useful parts. useful.



Adobe Reader does not encourage undo and error correction functions. Once you've signed it, it's hard to go back and revise an earlier document. Also, keep in mind that many features like password protection or custom stamps are locked after a fee, and you'll need an Adobe Acrobat Pro DC subscription for full access.

Adobe Reader is a cross-platform program

You can run this PDF reader on computers and mobile devices. Windows users will need a 1.5GHz processor or higher on Windows 8, 8.1 or Windows 10 (32-bit and 64-bit) operating systems.

Adobe Reader for Mac requires Intel and macOS v10.12, macOS v10.13, macOS v10.14, or macOS v10.15 processor.

For both Windows and Mac versions, you'll also need at least 1GB of RAM and 380MB of space on the hard drive.

Adobe Acrobat Reader for mobile apps can run on iOS, Android and Windows Phone smartphones. You can also scan documents and use the **Adobe Fill & Sign** feature on both iOS and Android.

Is Adobe Reader the best PDF reader?

For the ultimate PDF tool, you'll really need Adobe Acrobat Pro DC along with Adobe Reader. Adobe Reader itself is very useful - but not indispensable.

There are some other best simple PDF readers for Windows that don't come from Acrobat. Sumatra PDF is a fast and lightweight program for Windows. The program is open source and reliable software at zero cost. However, unlike Adobe Acrobat Pro, you cannot edit or sign your PDFs.

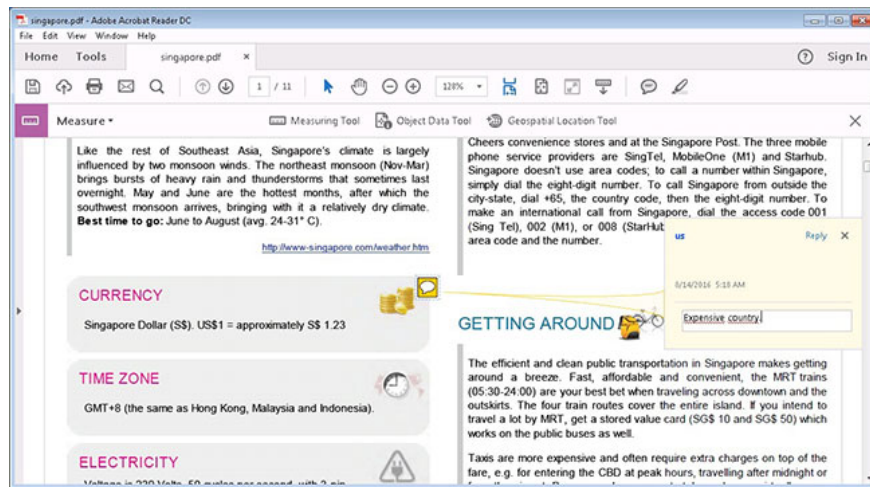
Nitro PDF Reader is another favorite Windows app. The program doesn't have as many features as some of its competitors, but its minimalism makes it a great program for simple and intuitive PDF reading.
