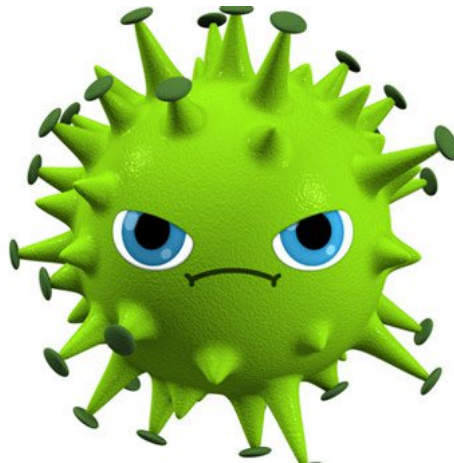

According to a marginal information received, this **D-type virus** has a structure similar to 50% similar to that of active influenza C in humans. However, whether or not this new virus spreads over the human body is still unproven.

In addition, blood samples on sheep and goats also found the D virus strain, but no poultry has been found in poultry such as ducks.

The most worrisome thing is that the virus may be recombinant, genetically modified or it could turn into some new strain that is more dangerous and spreads, causing illness directly on the human body. Professor Kaushik explained.
