

After Motorola, Xiaomi is also dreaming of launching a 'legendary' clamshell folding phone model.

Xiaomi is expected to launch a clamshell folding screen smartphone in the near future.

According to leaked images from a patent posted on the website of CNIPA (China National Intellectual Property Rights Management Office), it is likely that there will be a folding screen smartphone in the near future. The 'legendary' clamshell model, which is quite similar to the Motorola RAZR that has been gaining popularity worldwide for the last few days, and this product is said to come from a familiar name: Xiaomi.

However, there will be some noticeable differences between Xiaomi's patent and the Motorola RAZR.

For Xiaomi products, when the device is in a folding state, you will see on the device an additional rectangular screen on the front. While located in the middle of the back will be a dual camera cluster. So if you want to take a selfie, you will have to switch the device to the open state because the selfie camera is located in the upper border inside the screen. In this respect, Motorola products will be a little different when the rear camera cluster becomes a selfie camera when the device is in a folding state, combined with a screen at the top that supports selfie capabilities.





Folding screen smartphones are gradually becoming a popular term worldwide after the introduction of pioneering devices from Samsung (Galaxy Fold) and Huawei (Mate X). This product line is expected to shape the future of the smartphone world in the next few years, and of course as a 'bloody' manufacturer, Xiaomi of course cannot afford to miss the hearty party. this.

Besides Motorola and Xiaomi, Samsung is also reportedly developing another clamshell clamshell smartphone next to the Galaxy Fold, and according to some sources, this product will be launched at Mobile World Congress 2020.
