US President Donald Trump declared war on SARS-CoV-2 virus literally, when the US military officially joined. ' *We are confronting an invisible enemy,* ' Trump said on Twitter, adding that the virus "*could not resist the spirit and courage of the Americans .*"

The U.S. Department of Defense focuses on protecting its forces, along with ensuring the safety of civilian servicemen and their families. Safety measures are at the forefront, because as of Wednesday, 49 men were in the army, 14 members were in the army outside the regular force, 19 were family members of the people in the army and Seven military contractors were positive for the flu virus.

Here are the steps taken by the US military before the Covid-19 pandemic:

Support home quarantine tasks



The US Department of Defense's first move was to send forces to support requests from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, allow military bases to isolate themselves and provide homes for servicemen. water from the epidemic area.

Research vaccine for SARS-CoV-2



Scientists at the Military Medical Research and Development Command are urgently searching for a flu vaccine. According to Secretary Mark Esper, the research is 'going well'. The vaccine is expected to appear in 12 to 18 months.

Mobilize National Guards



As of Wednesday, about 2,000 soldiers from the National Guard have been involved in the prevention of disease in 23 states. They disinfect public areas, provide food for people, support people to move, .

Play the reserve mask



Also according to Secretary Esper, the US Department of Defense will distribute 5 million N95 masks that are stored in the warehouse, the first 1 million masks will be issued immediately.

Prepare a field hospital

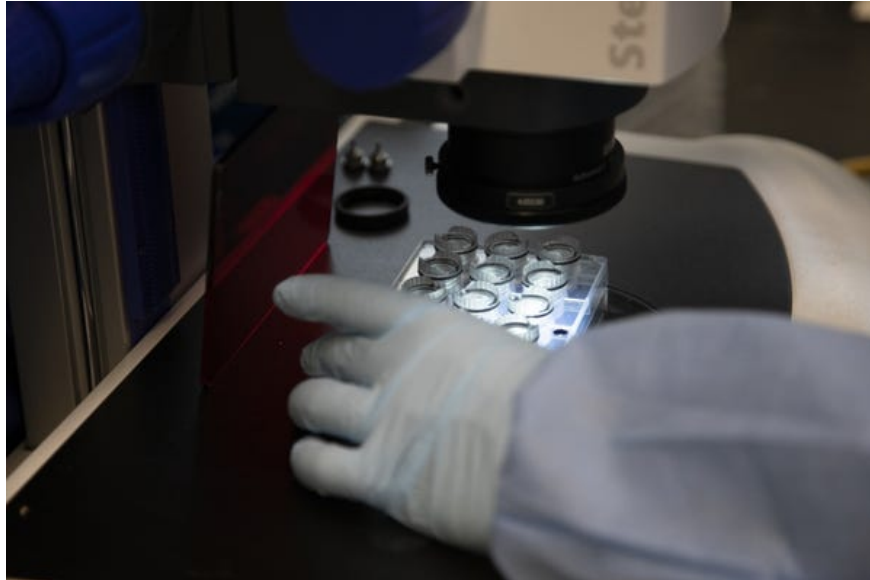


Put 'field hospital on the water' into use
