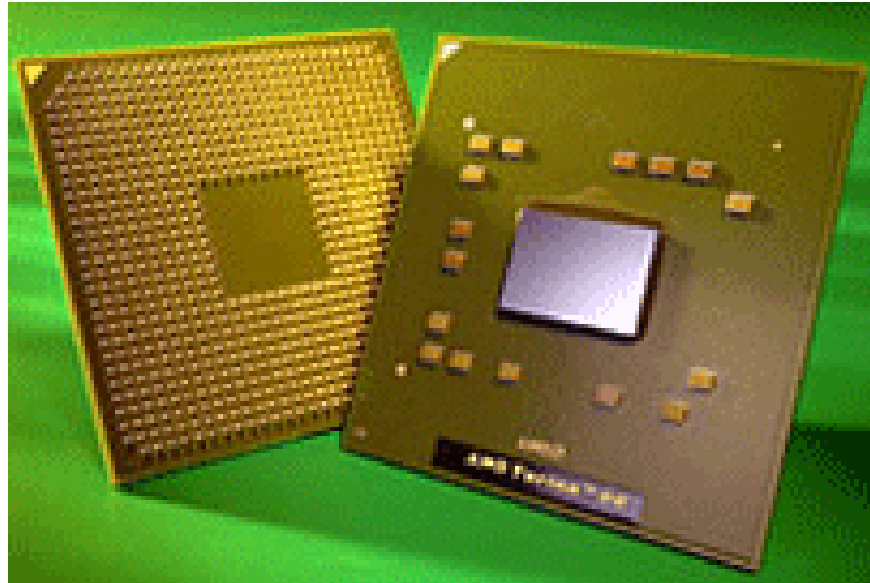


AMD released gaming chips for notebooks

The world's second-largest processing equipment manufacturer believes that gamers will be eager to buy laptops with 2 new chips that they introduced yesterday.

The world's second-largest processing equipment manufacturer believes that gamers will be eager to buy laptops with 2 new chips that they introduced yesterday.

A large number of Turion MT-40 and MT-37 went to PC manufacturers for the same price of \$ 359 and \$ 268. VoodooPC, AMD's long-term partner, announced that it will use the chip in two new laptop versions for video game enthusiasts. Some other manufacturers, including Acer, also promise to continue cooperation.

Currently, there are 12 AMD Turion 64-bit chips for light and thin laptops, including 3 ML series and 7 MT lines. The company built a Turion processor to reduce battery consumption compared to the Athlon.

Not surprisingly, two AMD chips were released just before Intel's Developer Forum in San Francisco this week. Despite knowing that new products cannot immediately replace the Centrino line for laptops, the world No. 2 chip maker wants to put pressure on the competitor and reduce Intel's echo in the session. launches new processing equipment and related technologies.

AMD recently recorded an important development milestone when its server market share increased to 11.2% for the first time, surpassing 10%.

In early August, both chipmakers also announced significant discounts on popular processing equipment to boost sales during the start of the school year and before the biggest shopping period of the year (Christmas season).
