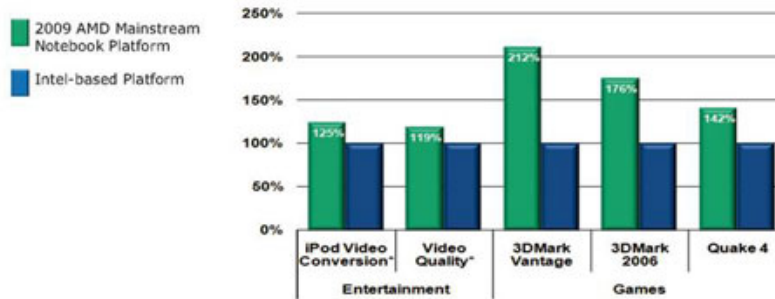

AMD Vision Premium - in addition to the basic features, laptops with AMD Vision Premium are powerful enough to implement in-depth applications like image editing, video editing or watching high definition HD and Blu-ray movies. This processor platform is compatible with most popular video applications and can speed up the conversion time to 43% video format. According to Notebookcheck, with media editing software like Sony Movie Studio 9 Platinum, the AMD Media Coder plug-in can compress and decode video 75% faster.
