

AMD unveils Radeon RX 6900 XT liquid cooling version

AMD has just officially launched the 'last boss' of the flagship Radeon RX 6900 XT product line, which is receiving a lot of attention from the market.

AMD has officially launched the 'final boss' of the flagship Radeon RX 6900 XT product line, which is receiving a lot of attention from the market, which is the Radeon RX 6900 XT GPU model equipped with a cooling system. closed-loop fluids (LCS). The entire system will be cooled by a rad fan attached to the liquid conductor, promising for efficient heat dissipation as well as 'uncompromising' overall performance.

Notably, besides the high-performance liquid cooling system, AMD's upgraded Radeon RX 6900 XT Liquid Cooled is talking about memory frequency and GPU compared to the regular version, which is also very powerful. Specifically, Radeon RX 6900 XT Liquid Cooled has a Navi 21 GPU with 5120 stream processors that can clock up to 2250MHz (compared to 2015Mhz on the regular version), accompanied by 16GB 18Gbps GDDR6 memory. It should be added that there are several Radeon RX 6900 XT variants on the market from third-party manufacturers with higher GPU clocks, but basically AMD's RX 6900 XT Liquid Cooled is the only model that has a higher GPU clock speed. 18Gbps DRAM so far. This is clearly a big competitive advantage.



Increased power means higher power consumption. Radeon RX 6900 XT Liquid Edition has a TDP of 330W, an increase of 30W compared to the regular version. To solve the problem of thermal efficiency, AMD equips this flagship GPU model with a new custom liquid cooling system with a 120mm radiator combined with a fan. It's clearly not the most powerful cooler out there for AMD's Big Navi design, however, it's well-regarded for its fit, with good compatibility on almost all systems. Today's high-end desktop computers.

In terms of connectivity, unlike the high-end Radeon RX 6900 XT variants from AMD's partners, which are equipped with three eight-pin auxiliary PCIe power connectors, the Radeon RX 6900 XT Liquid Cooled has two, enough for provides up to 300W of power to the board. In addition, the two connectors also mean that the GPU

will be able to work well with almost any high-performance PSU.

AMD's Radeon RX 6900 XT Liquid Cooled is clearly one of the world's fastest graphics cards based on AMD's Big Navi GPU. However, it's not clear why AMD won't retail this GPU model, instead offering it exclusively to manufacturers of built-in PCs. In addition, the specific selling price of the product has not been disclosed, but with the current global GPU supply crisis, the estimated number will not be comfortable, much more certain than the level of 1402 USD. of Radeon RX 6900 XT
