

Among Us: Tips to win in every game

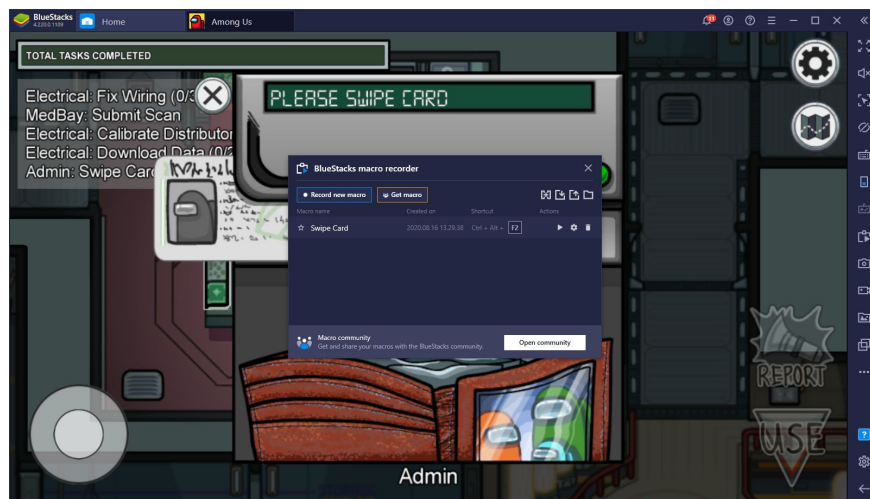
Among Us is a game that emphasizes team play. Whether you're the Crew or the Impostor, working closely with other players is a secret of survival.

It could be completing a mission together, or fooling other gamers to create a false sense of security. It all depends on your integration skills and your own teamwork.

Now, let's go through some useful tips so that you can be a winner in a game Among Us.

Automate repetitive tasks with the Macro Recorder feature

One of the main things to do as a crew while playing is that you need to take on assigned missions. It can be scanning the card into the computer, refueling the engine, dumping the garbage or scanning the biometrics in the medical room, etc. These tasks are mostly very simple, with just the press of a button or two. However, when doing these tasks, there will often be an extra screen for you to manipulate, thereby temporarily making you unable to look around.



At this point, the Macro Recorder feature of BlueStacks will be very useful. This feature records the process of you manipulating a sequence of actions, then automatically re-run that sequence of actions (macros) when you activate.

These macros are especially useful when recording actions that require precision, but by swiping. However, when recording this action, you should pay attention because swiping too fast or too slow will not succeed. If the recording was successful, in the next game you have to perform this task, you just need to press the button assigned to this macro. Very quick!

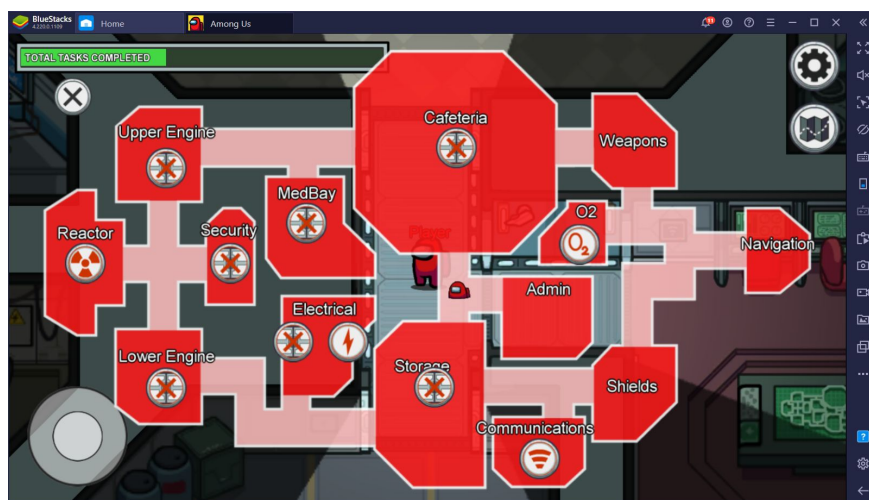
1. It is recommended to follow the yellow arrow pointing to the nearest mission location. So you will move faster because you open the map to search.
2. Try to perform the missions shown in pictures, in the presence of other members to prove you are an alibi, because imposters cannot complete the missions but can only pretend to do. These could be "Clear Asteroids", "Submit Scan", "Prime Shields" or "Empty Garbage".
3. Also, pay attention if someone fails to complete the task even though they are doing it, as it is almost certainly a fake. Call an emergency meeting immediately if you discover a suspicious person.



1. As you can infer, if you see someone completing a task, and that person sees you doing the same thing, immediately pair up. So you can prove each other's innocence to work together against or track down the fake.

If you are impostor

1. Never try to pretend to be performing a visual task. If someone finds out you are very likely to be accused.
2. A good way to build trust for other gamers is to... repair a room that you previously sabotaged (sabotage). For example if you broke the lights, then feel free to go to the electric room and fix them, it's best to have someone witness. The alibi is too good, isn't it?



1. Avoid following the crew for too long, which will get them suspicious.
2. Try to blame other members to drive the suspicion away from you. For example, accuse them of having closed doors or just wandering around the rooms doing nothing. But be careful, this can backfire against you if someone else witnesses your counter-argument. It's important to stay calm and "fake the deer" as best you can.
3. If possible, destroy the oxygen room or the reactor, and ambush the crew that are coming to fix them. These two rooms are very important because if you don't fix them in time, the crew will lose (and you win, of course!), So there will inevitably be at least one member trying to run to fix them as quickly as possible.
