

Android 11 will finally have an important feature, which the iPhone has had for nearly 10 years

It takes a long time for Google to realize that this is an important and necessary feature.

When Steve Jobs first introduced an iPhone to the public, he said that Apple had created a technology device five years ahead of its competitors. And it is true that the iPhone has done that.

For years, the iPhone easily outperformed its Android rivals. However, Android smartphone manufacturers like Samsung, powered by Google, have begun creating devices that can rival the iPhone. Now, the difference between iPhone and Android flagship is almost gone.



But some of the features are really useful on iPhone, but not yet on Android, such as AirDrop is a typical example. First launched with iOS 7 in 2013, AirDrop allows users to easily share photos, videos or large files with their neighbors in a short time.

The good news for Android smartphone users is that Google will also update an AirDrop-like feature on Android 11. This new feature, called Fast Share, will basically have the same mechanism as Apple's AirDrop. .

A few months ago, the XDA forum introduced this feature in an Android 11 beta. The video shows the ability to send data between Pixel 4 and Pixel 2 XL smartphones.

A feature that Apple had launched many years ago, but until now, Google has just launched on Android 11. However, due to the event Google I / O has been canceled, so we do not know when will Android 11 be released.
