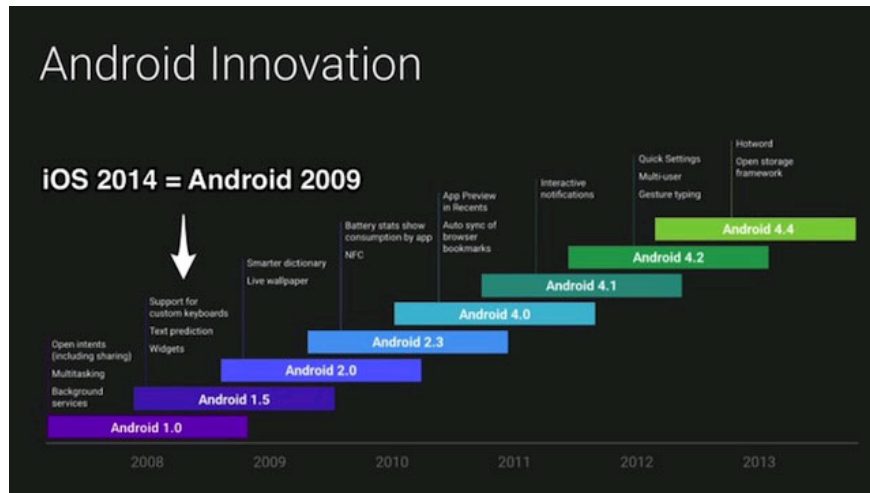

Pichai also said that this would allow Google to "*progress faster than the typical operating system release cycle*" and always seem to surpass Apple in terms of updates.

Android's biggest tease with iOS and Apple is in the " *Android Innovation* " chart, this chart has shown multitasking already in Android 1.0, while custom keyboards and widgets are in *Cupcake* , statistics The battery is already in *Gingerbread* , an interactive notification is available in Jelly Bean, quick custom settings and keyboard input are available from Jelly Bean (4.2) .
