

AnTuTu released version 7.2.6 update to prevent benchmark fraud on smartphones

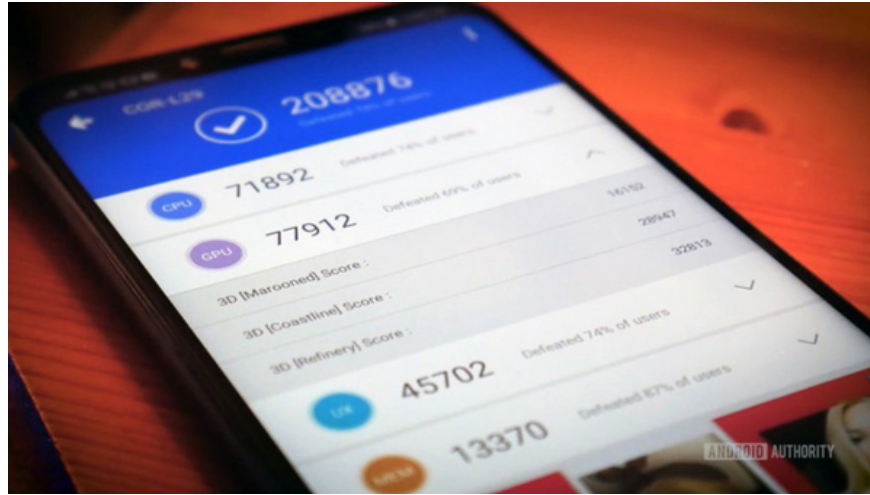

The new AnTuTu 7.2.6 update has just added a few changes to fix the benchmark score fraud, which is being considered as a measure to evaluate the performance of a smartphone. now on.



In the past, many technology firms have been detected performance scores AnTuTu fraud, such as OnePlus, Meizu, OPPO and Huawei. Specifically, manufacturers have used a fraud method called "optimization" performance benchmark. They create and install code devices so that when a benchmark application is found, the smartphone can achieve maximum performance. But this score does not reflect the reality, not the performance that users receive during normal use.



AnTuTu did not explain what they did to the 7.2.6 update that could prevent the fraudulent benchmark scores of smartphone manufacturers.
